STATE LAND BOARD SPECIAL MEETING NOTICE

The Oregon State Land Board will meet in a special session on Wednesday, March 19, 2008, 10:00 a.m. to noon, at the Ramada Medford and Convention Center, 2250 Biddle Road, Medford.

The purpose of this meeting is to hear public testimony in response to the following two questions concerning the Rogue River navigability study:

- Does the factual evidence presented in the second draft of the Rogue River navigability study meet the federal test for title navigability?
- Should the Land Board, based on the factual evidence contained in the second draft of this study, make a declaration of public ownership of the 89-mile segment of the Rogue River from Grave Creek (RM 68.5) to Lost Creek Dam (RM 157.5)?

The Land Board will not make any decisions at this meeting concerning the navigability of the Rogue River and will only listen to testimony presented on these two questions. DSL staff expects the Land Board to make a final decision on this issue at a regularly scheduled board meeting later this year.

How to Provide Comments

You may provide input to the Land Board at its Medford meeting either orally or in writing.

If you want to present your input orally, you must sign in when you arrive at the meeting before it begins. The Land Board will take oral public comment in the order that persons wanting to give input have signed in. A maximum of 3 minutes will be given to each person. However, because of the 2-hour length of this meeting, it is possible that a shorter time will be given to each person wanting to speak in order to accommodate more speakers. Due to time limitations, not everyone who wants to speak may be able to do so. Therefore, you are encouraged to bring written copies of your input to give to the Land Board in the event you are not given the opportunity to speak.
