

- Bicycles are permitted on all roads and trails in areas open to deer hunting.
- Use of wheeled non-motorized game retrieval carts may be used except in the Wilderness Area.;

- Âll injuries or accidents occurring on the refuge must be reported immediately to the Refuge Headquarters.
- Shooting from gravel road surface. • Entry into the closed area for any
- reason is prohibited. Parking, blocking, or in any manner restricting access to roads and gates.
- Use of Snowmobiles and ATVs.
- Target, skeet, trap and indiscriminate shooting.
- Use or possession of alcoholic beverages while hunting.
- Overnight camping, parking and open fires. Primitive camping is available in designated areas on nearby State Wildlife Management Areas.
