UPDATE TO LES REPORT

1. Revise paragraph 090203.A to read as follows:

090203. Biweekly Reports.

A. <u>LES</u>. A Leave and Earnings Statement (LES) shall show gross pay, current earnings, deductions, and net pay for the current pay period and cumulative totals for the current year. The LES will reflect the accrued and used leave balances for the pay period and year-to-date values. The LES shall be made available to employees through accessing myPay, or mailed to the employee's nonwork address every pay period.
