Scholarship Program

Partial Scholarship:

OR
2. Hotel reimbursement for one night
(not to exceed \$60 per night for room) + tax.

Scholarship Eligibility

1. Oregon residents only
2. Non-profit, for profit and government employees
3. One scholarship per individual
4. Must be involved in brownfields redevelopment efforts within an Oregon community
