Subject: Business Transformation Agency Organizational Changes


The Business Transformation Agency (BTA) has successfully completed its first year with several significant accomplishments including the publication and delivery to Congress of the 2<sup>nd</sup> Enterprise Transition Plan, the realignment of the Defense Integrated Military Human Resource System, and the publication of version 4.0 of the Business Enterprise Architecture.

While we have initiated the process to hire a permanent director, this process may take several more months before a director is selected and available to report for duty. In the interim, it is important to establish a more permanent, long-term reporting structure for the BTA. As a result, the following organizational changes are directed:


- Effective immediately, and until a permanent director is hired, Mr. David Fisher is appointed Acting Director of the BTA. All directorships within the BTA will report directly to Mr. Fisher.
- Effective November 27, 2006, Ms. Radha Sekar will assume her new duties in the Office of the Under Secretary of Defense (Comptroller) as the Assistant Deputy Chief Financial Officer (ADCFO). As ADCFO, Ms. Sekar will serve as the functional sponsor of the Business Enterprise Information Systems (BEIS), Intragovernmental Value Added Network (IVAN), and Strategic Resource Decision System (SRDS) initiatives.
- The Priority Projects directorate will be realigned to report directly to the Defense Business Systems Acquisition Executive. Ms. Cindy Beck will assume BTA leadership responsibility for the BEIS, IVAN, and SRDS initiatives.



Please congratulate Ms. Radha Sekar and Ms. Cindy Beck on their new assignments and give Mr. David Fisher your full support as he assumes operating responsibility for the BTA. We have made great strides in the past year and we intend to continue this progress in the agency's second year and beyond.
