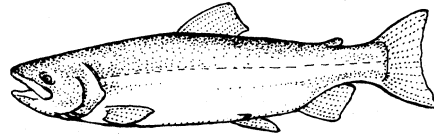

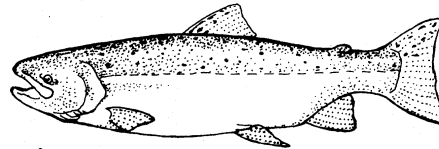
Pink Salmon



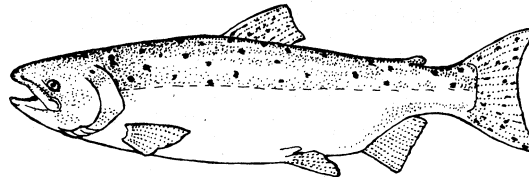
Chum Salmon
