Rule 469. Sulfuric Acid Units

A person shall not discharge into the atmosphere from any sulfuric acid unit, effluent process gas containing more than:

- (a) 500 ppm of sulfur compounds averaged over a minimum of 15 consecutive minutes and calculated as sulfur dioxide on a dry basis.
- (b) 90 kilograms (198.5 pounds) per hour of sulfur compounds calculated as sulfur dioxide.
