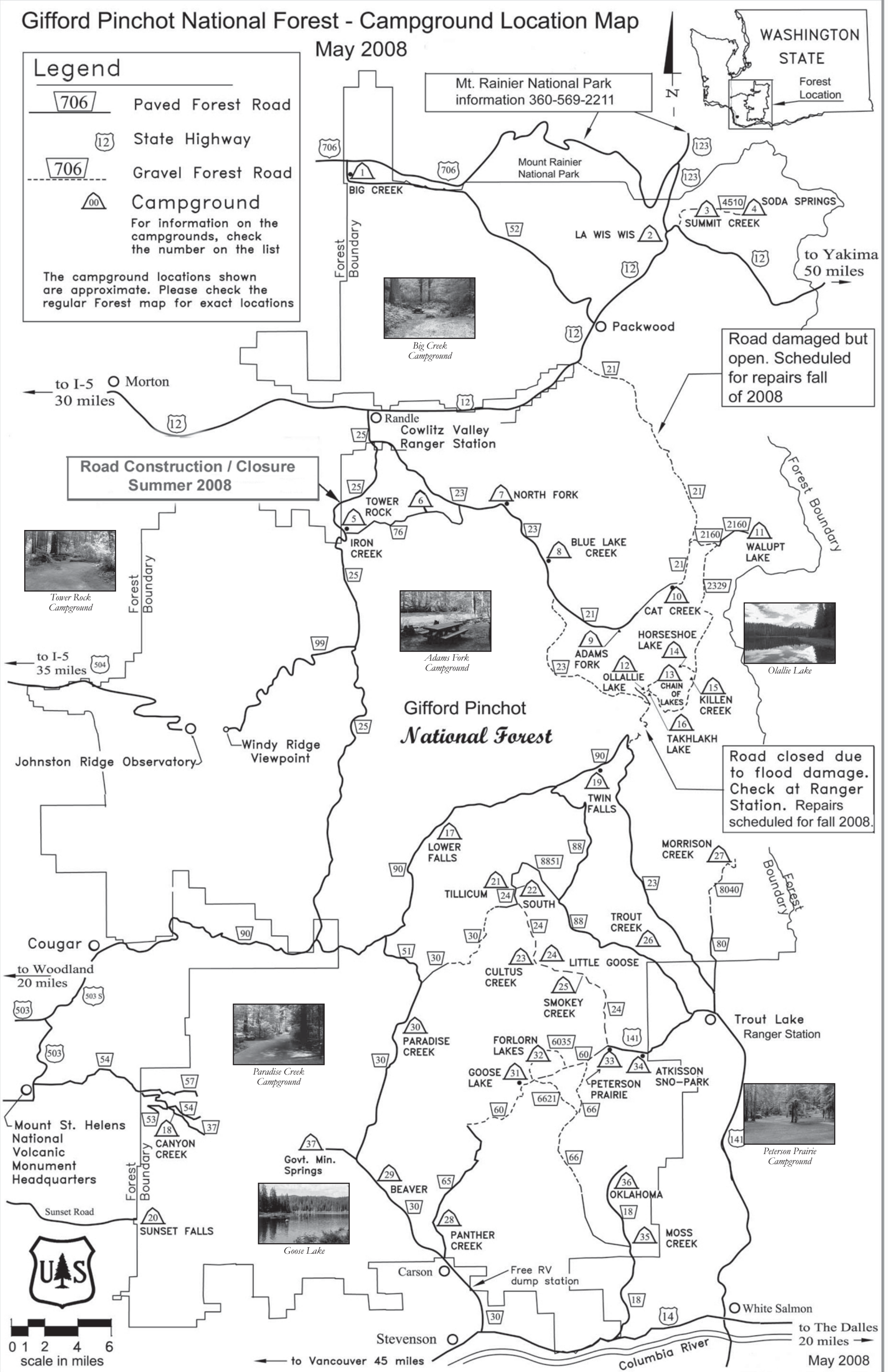

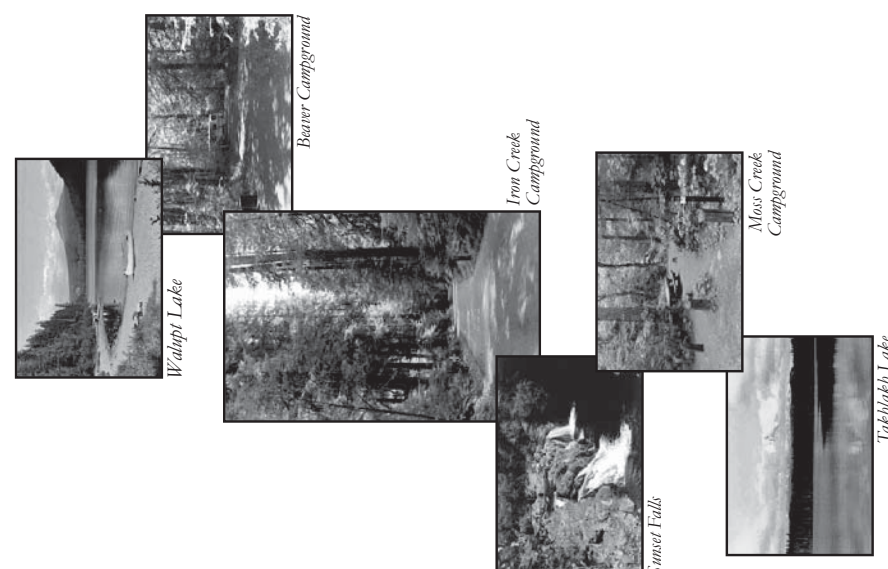

### Answers to frequently asked questions about Gifford Pinchot National Forest Campgrounds:

- None of the campgrounds have showers.
- None of the campgrounds have RV holding tank dump stations. There are stations available at some local RV parks.
- Reservations of specific campsites by number are available at:
  - ▲ Beaver
  - ▲ Iron Creek
  - ▲ La Wis Wis
  - ▲ Panther Creek
  - ▲ Paradise Creek
  - ▲ Takhlakh Lake

At other campgrounds, reservations are by the type of site (for example: single, double, or premium) but are not by the specific site number.

When you make a reservation by the type of site, a site number of that type will be given to you when you arrive at the campground.

In the future, more campgrounds will be reservable by the site number.
