

Instructions for implementing DRVS 7.1

DRVS 7.1 is an upgrade to the current version of DRVS 7.0. For states that already have the current version, we recommend reinstalling DRVS 7.0 on a clean machine that has not housed a prior version of the DRVS. States that elect to implement version 7.1 on the same machine as a prior version of the DRVS should first create backups of the databases currently housed on the machine. After database backups have been stored in a safe location, we recommend uninstalling and reinstalling version 7.0 by following steps 1 and 2 below.

Steps for implementing DRVS version 7.1:

1. Install DRVS 7.0

DRVS 7.0 is available on the ETA performance website at http://www.doleta.gov/performance/reporting/tools_datavalidation.cfm. The link to the software can be found in the “In This Section” box under “Version 7.0 WIA.” Download the zip file, extract the software executable file to a known location, and begin the installation by double-clicking the DRVS.exe and following the installation prompts. Be sure to select “I want to create a DRVS database” during the installation.

2. Apply the DRVS 7.0 Upgrade Script

Download the DRVS_7.0_Upgrade.zip file from the ETA website and extract the sql script to a known location. After installing version 7.0, run the DRVS_7.0_Upgrade.sql script. Instructions for implementing the script are posted separately in the same section of the website. (Note: this script is the same as the DRVS 6.3 to 7.0 Upgrade.sql script previously posted under Version 7.0 WIA)

3. Apply the DRVS 7.1 Upgrade Script

Download the DRVS_7.1_Upgrade.zip file from the ETA website and extract the sql script to a known location. Once a clean version of DRVS 7.0 and the 7.0 upgrade script have been installed, run the DRVS_7.1_Upgrade.sql script. Instructions for implementing the script are posted separately on the website.

4. Copy WIANLX files into the DRVS directory

Download the WIANLX.zip file to a known location. Double-click the file, extract the 3 zipped files, and copy them to the C:\Program Files\DRVS\WIANLX\bin folder. Click “Yes to all” if asked whether you want to replace already existing files in that folder.

5. Copy format files into the DRVS directory

Download the FormatFiles.zip file to a known location. Double-click the file, extract the 27 zipped files, and copy them to the C:\Program Files\DRVS\FormatFiles folder. Click “Yes to all” if asked whether you want to replace already existing files in that folder.

6. Copy database BAK files into the DRVS directory

Download the DB_BAK.zip file to a known location. Double-click the file, extract the 6 zipped files, and copy them to the C:\Program Files\DRVS\WIANLX\bin\DBBackups folder. Click “Yes to all” if asked whether you want to replace already existing files in that folder.
