Dear Ms. Smith DeWaal:

This is in response to your letter of July 26, 2001, to the Food and Drug Administration (FDA) regarding the safe handling statement requirement for shell eggs. We apologize for the delay in our response.

You stated in your letter that, while the recently finalized requirements for safe handling instructions on shell eggs (65 FR 76092, December 5, 2000) offer a useful reminder to consumers about the risks associated with *Salmonella* Enteritidis, the type size allowed for the statement is too small. You contended that the instructions may be illegible, particularly for elderly consumers. You requested that, if FDA proposes to amend the final rule on the safe handling statement, we reevaluate the type size and readability of the safe handling instructions.

Thank you for your interest in this matter. We will forward a copy of your letter to our Dockets Management Branch to be included with other comments on the safe handling instructions on shell eggs (Docket numbers 98N-1230, 96P-0418, and 97P-0197). If FDA initiates rulemaking to amend its final rule, we will take your comments into consideration.
