To Prevent Unsolicited Emails

Tip 1: When buying tickets, don't give out your email address

How? Your company has a relationship with Plum Benefits to provide you with established, valuable entertainment offers. If you are required to use an email address to purchase tickets, use your personal account. This will help ensure that you only get emails your company allows at your workplace.

Tip 2: Opt out of unwanted emails

How? Many times when ordering online, you are asked if you want to receive various newsletters and additional offers. If you do not wish to receive additional information, be sure to uncheck any area where you may be putting yourself on a distribution list.

To Save Money When Ordering

Tip 3: Pick up your tickets at Will Call

How? If you pick up your tickets at the Box Office (typically referred to as Will Call) instead of having them mailed to you, you will save money AND won't have to worry about leaving them at home! Just be sure to bring the credit card you used to buy the tickets and a photo ID when picking up your tickets.

Tip 4: Buy your tickets at the Box Office

How? Although Plum Benefits does not charge you per ticket, when you buy tickets over the phone a service fee is added by the ticketing agency. If possible, you can bring the Entertainment Guides directly to the Box Office to buy your tickets and will avoid these extra charges. For most Broadway shows the Box Office hours are usually 12pm-8pm. It is best to avoid the Box Office the hour before a show is scheduled to begin.
