Expanded Flat File Format:

- Provide Facility NPI information to COMPdata prior to submitting new format to Test or Production
- Do not add Header or Trailer Records Will cause file to fail
- □ File must be 2500 bytes long
- Line Feed must be entered after the 2500th byte between each record in a file
- Procedures must appear in BOTH the Procedure Code/Date fields AND the Service Line Item/Date fields
- □ All single character fields should be submitted in uppercase.
- Every Outpatient CPT/HCPC Service Line Item must have a corresponding Revenue Code listed
- □ If Payer ID is Self Pay (98918), then Payer Name should be "Self Pay"

837 4010A1 File Format:

- Provide Facility NPI information to COMPdata prior to submitting new format to Test or Production
- Based upon Institutional version
- □ ISA Segment use Facility ID as Submitter ID and "COMPdata" as Receiver ID
- □ End of ISA Segment must contain usage indicator: T = Test, P = Production
- GS Segment must designate the 837 version being used. Example: 004010X096A1
- □ NM1*85 Segment must contain Facility NPI. (Existing COMPdata ID allowed until 05/23/08.)
- For Outpatient services, CPT codes must appear in the HI Segments:
 - Qualifier BP (Principal Procedure) or BO (Other Procedure)
 - Also exists in SV2 Segment
 - Procedures must appear in BOTH the Procedure Code/Date fields AND the Service Line Item/Date fields
- Every Outpatient CPT/HCPC Service Line Item must have a corresponding Revenue Code listed
- □ Race and Ethnicity codes must be separated by a colon. E.g. R3:E1
- □ If Payer ID is Self Pay (98918), then Payer Name should be "Self Pay"
