CUSTER NATIONAL FOREST BEAROOTH RANGER DISTRICT ROAD/TRAIL CLOSURES

Pursuant to Title 36 Code of Federal Regulation 261.50(a) and (b), the following restrictions are in effect on the Beartooth Ranger District, Custer National Forest. These restrictions are in addition to those enumerated in Subpart A, Part 261, Title 36, Code of Federal Regulations, and become effective at 12:00 pm Mountain Daylight Time September 2, 2008 when signed and will remain in effect until rescinded.

36 CR 261.50 - ORDERS

Forest Service Road # 71 (West Fork of Rock Creek) beginning at section 35, T8S, R18E at the lower turnoff the Senia Summer Home Tract west to the end of the road.

Forest Trail # 1 (West Fork of Rock Creek) to Sundance Pass. Forest Trail # 12 (Timberline Trail) to Timberline Lake and from the intersection of Trail #12 and Trail #8 over Silver Run Plateau to the intersection of Silver Run Trail # 64 and Beartrack Trail #8. Forest Trail #13 (Senia Creek Trail) where the trail comes to section 34 in T8S, R18E. See attached map. These roads are closed due to erosion control work as well as trail and trailhead work being completed (Burned Area Emergency Rehab) from the Cascade Fire.

Exemptions:

Pursuant to Title 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following are exempt from this order:

- 1. Persons with a permit specifically issued by a Forest Officer specially authorizing prohibitive act;
- 2. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.
