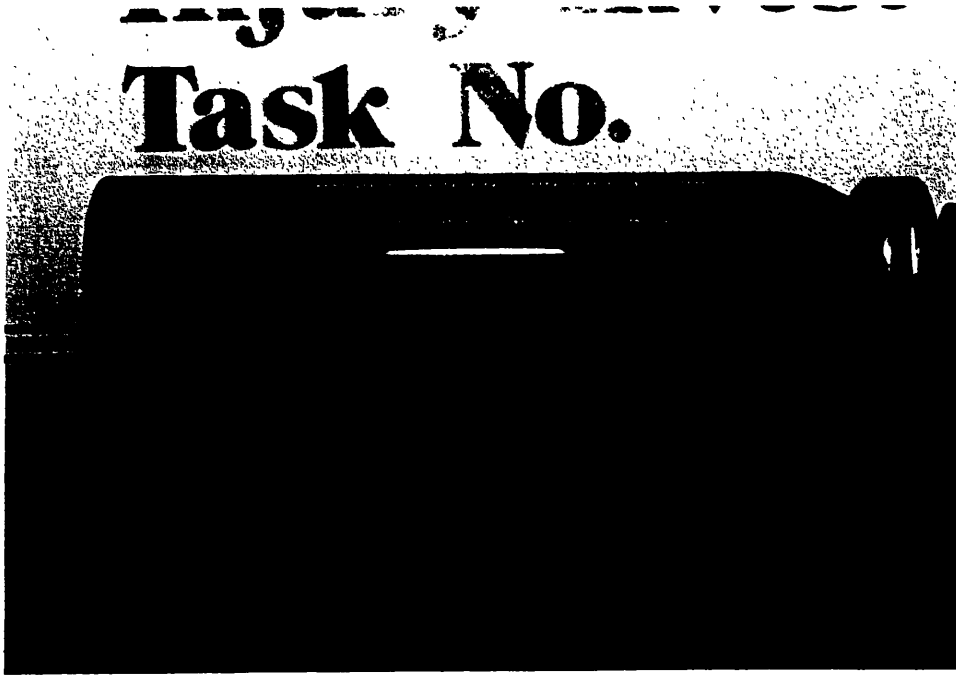

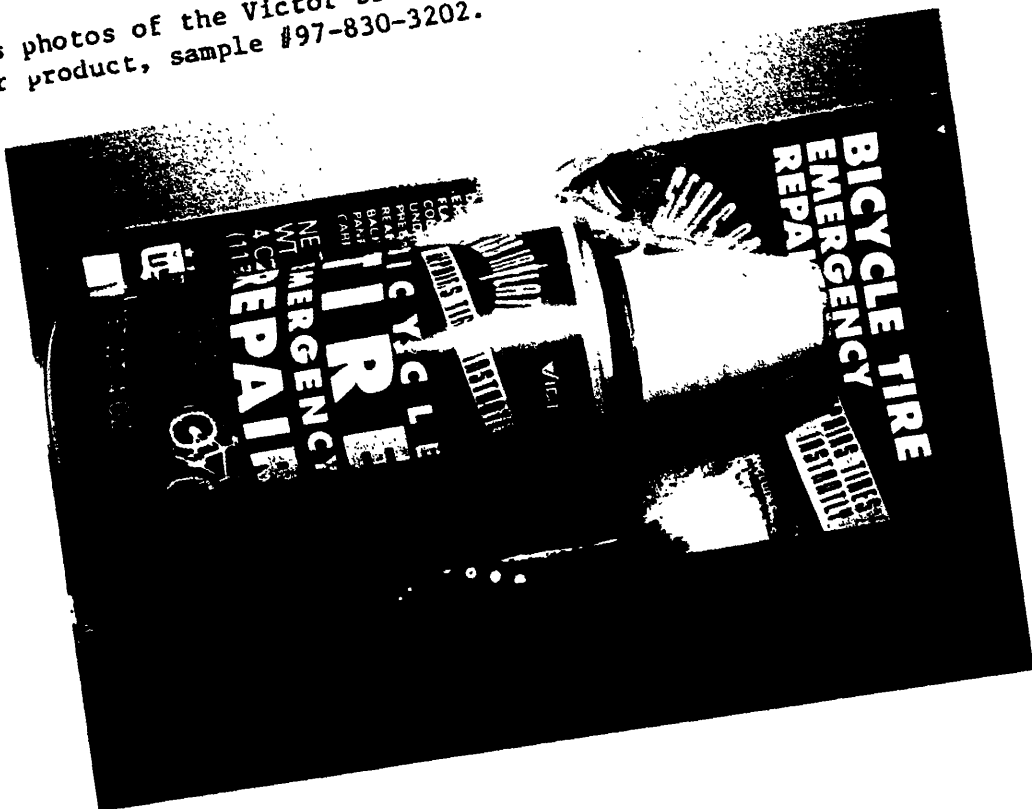

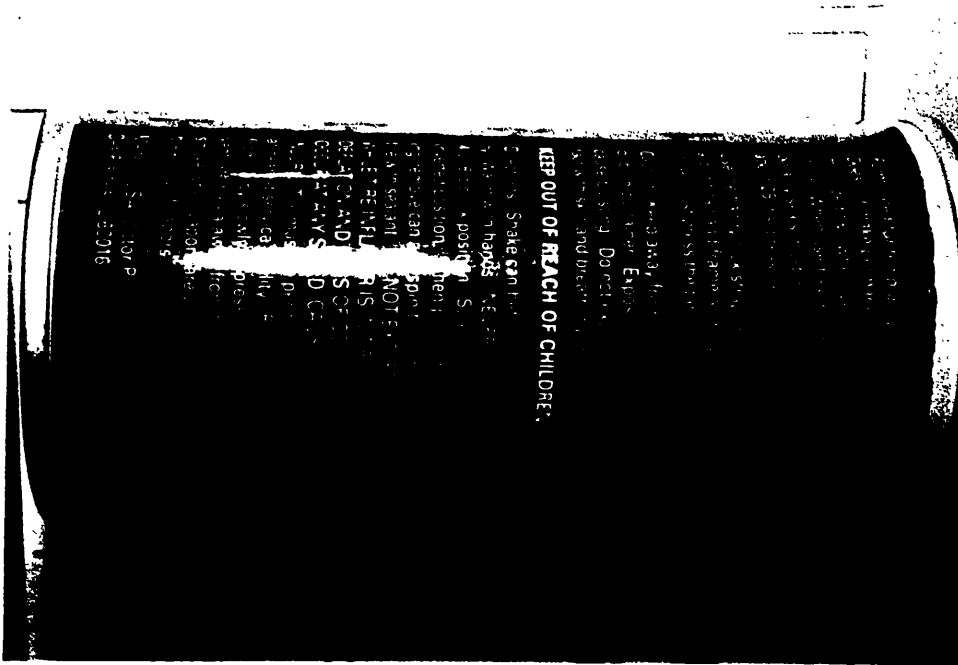


Various photos of the Victor brand model #VB-58 Bicycle Tire Emergency Repair product, sample #97-830-3202.

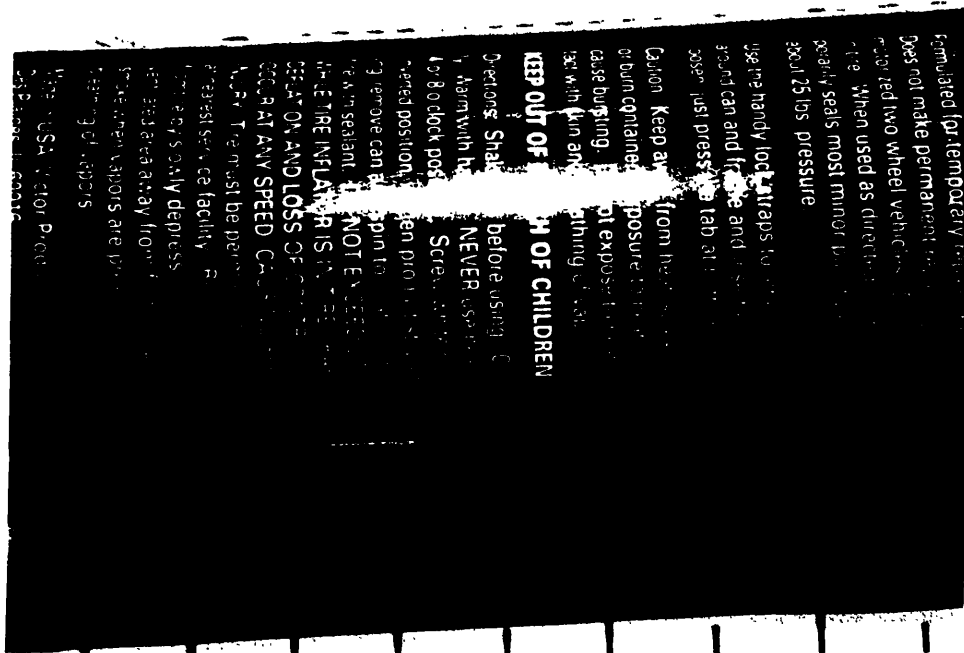

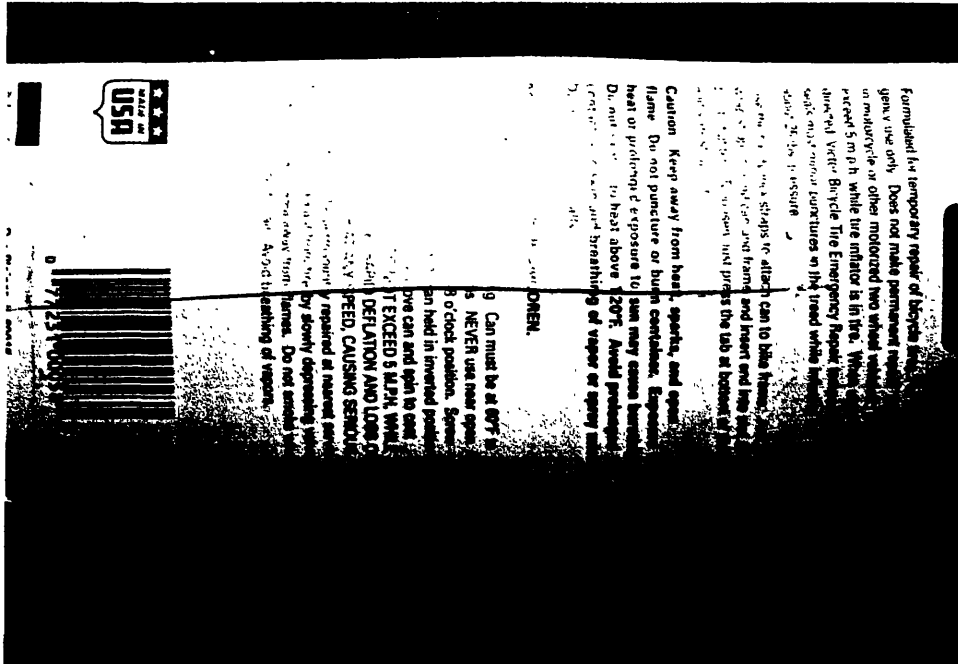


Various photos of the Victor brand model #VB-58 Bicycle Tire Emergency Repair product, sample #97-830-3202.

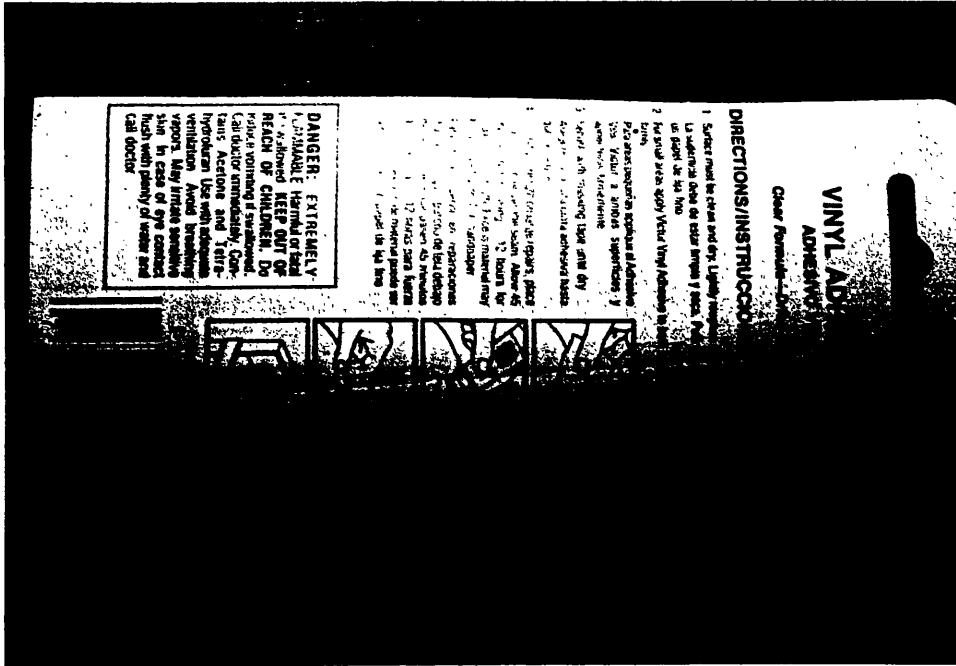
