Subj: COMMUNITY CORRECTIONS OUTCOME MEASURES FOR 1st HALF 2003

Enclosed are the 1st Half 2003 performance outcome measure results for the state. Meeting these outcomes is part of the intergovernmental agreement between the state and the county. The outcome measures are:

1. Reduce recidivism, as measured by felony convictions from initial admission to probation, tracking for three years from admission.
2. Reduce recidivism, as measured by felony convictions from first release to parole/post-prison supervision, tracking for three years from release.
3. Increase the percentage of positive case closures for offenders on probation.
4. Increase the percentage of positive case closures for offenders on parole/post-prison supervision.
5. Reduce the rate of high-risk offenders on abscond status.
6. Increase the percentage of restitution and compensatory fines collected that is owed to victims (this outcome is in development and is not being reported out on at this time).

More detail, as well as historical data for each county, can be found on the Department of Corrections website at www.doc.state.or.us/community_corrections. For comparison purposes, we have included tables and charts showing each county's outcome for the 1st Half 2003. If you do not see certain charts specific to your county's performance, it is because the number of offenders in the category was very small, making the results too much subject to chance to present.

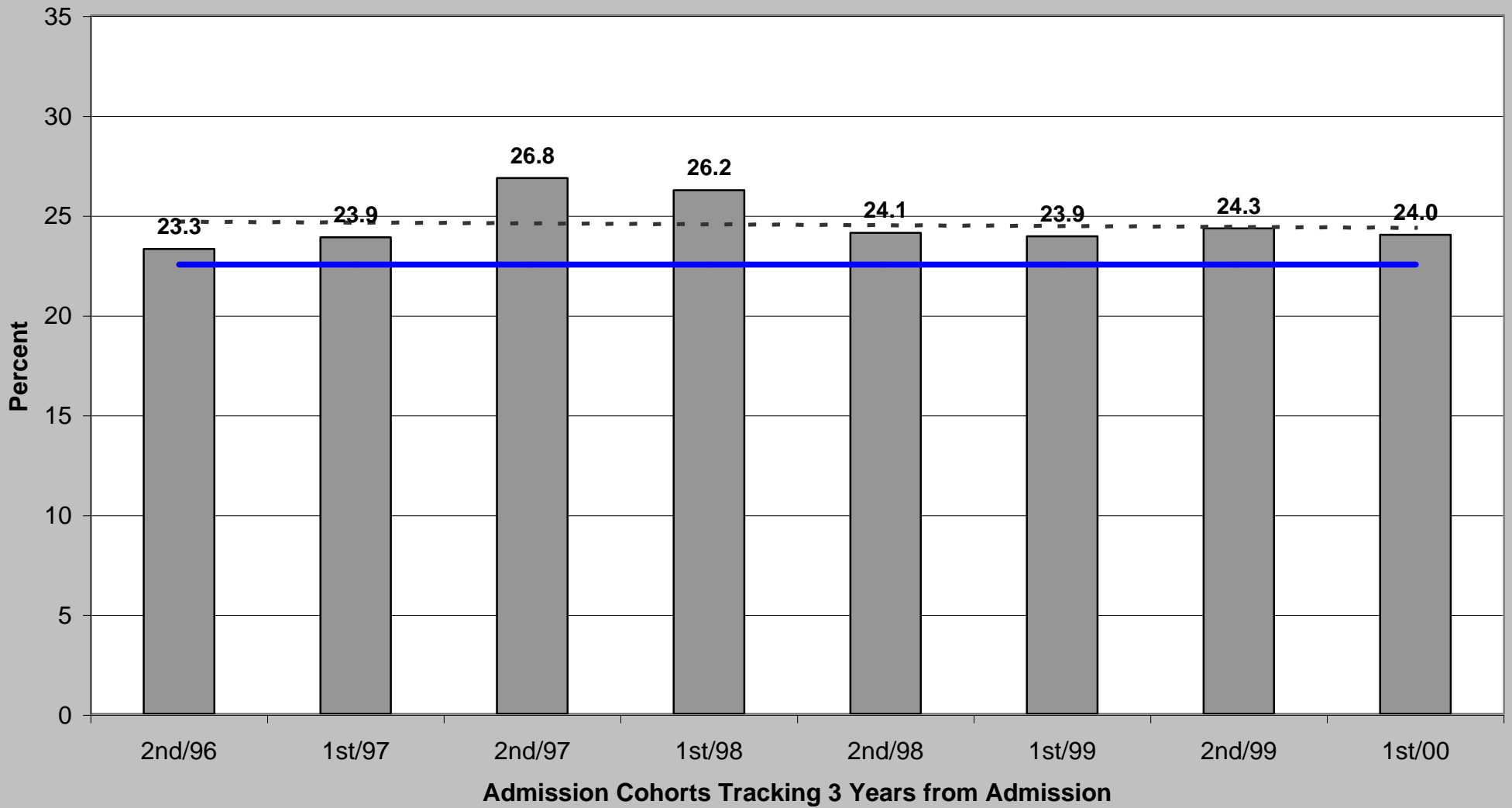

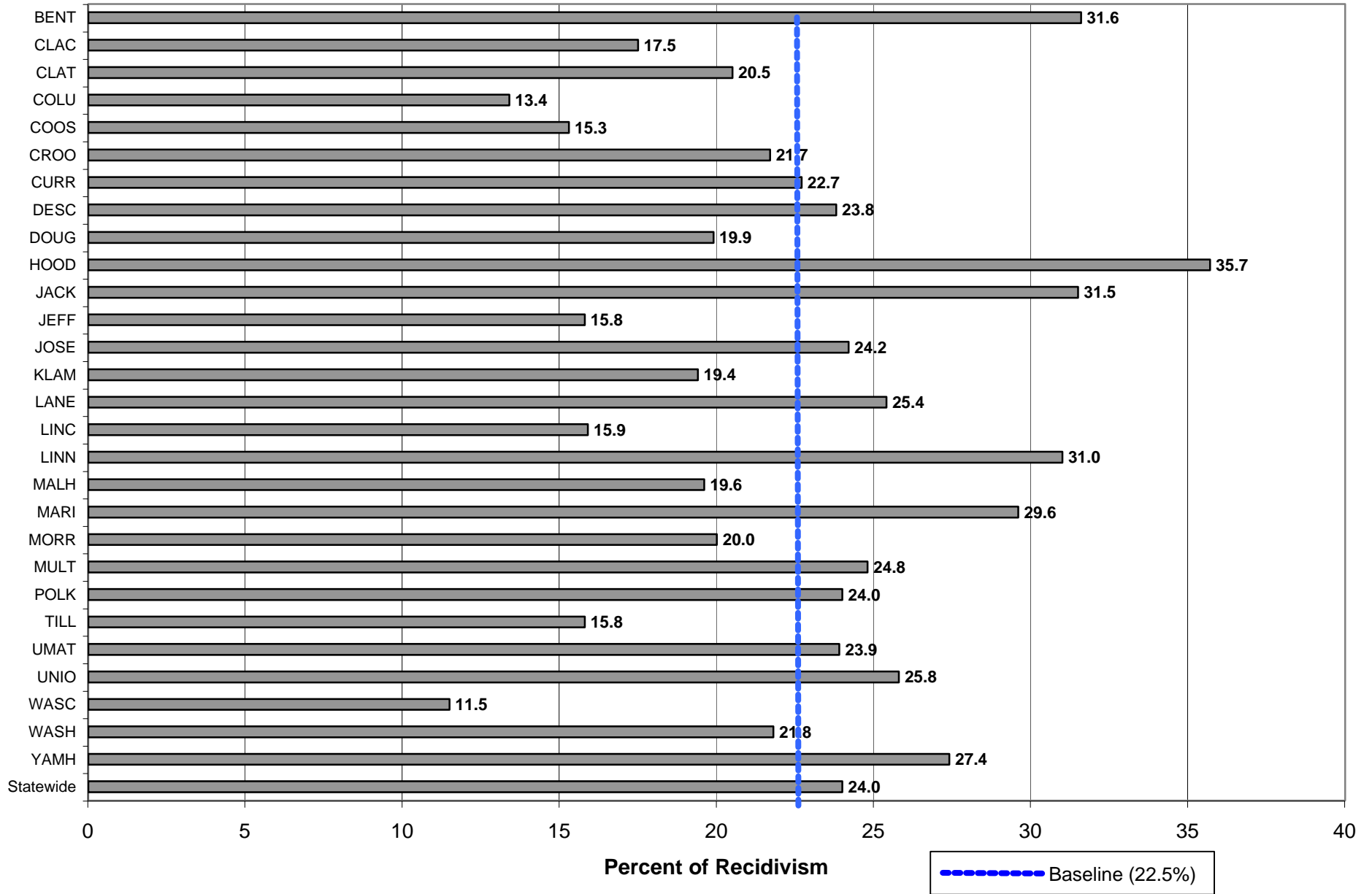

Statewide Probation Recidivism Rates through 1st Half 2003

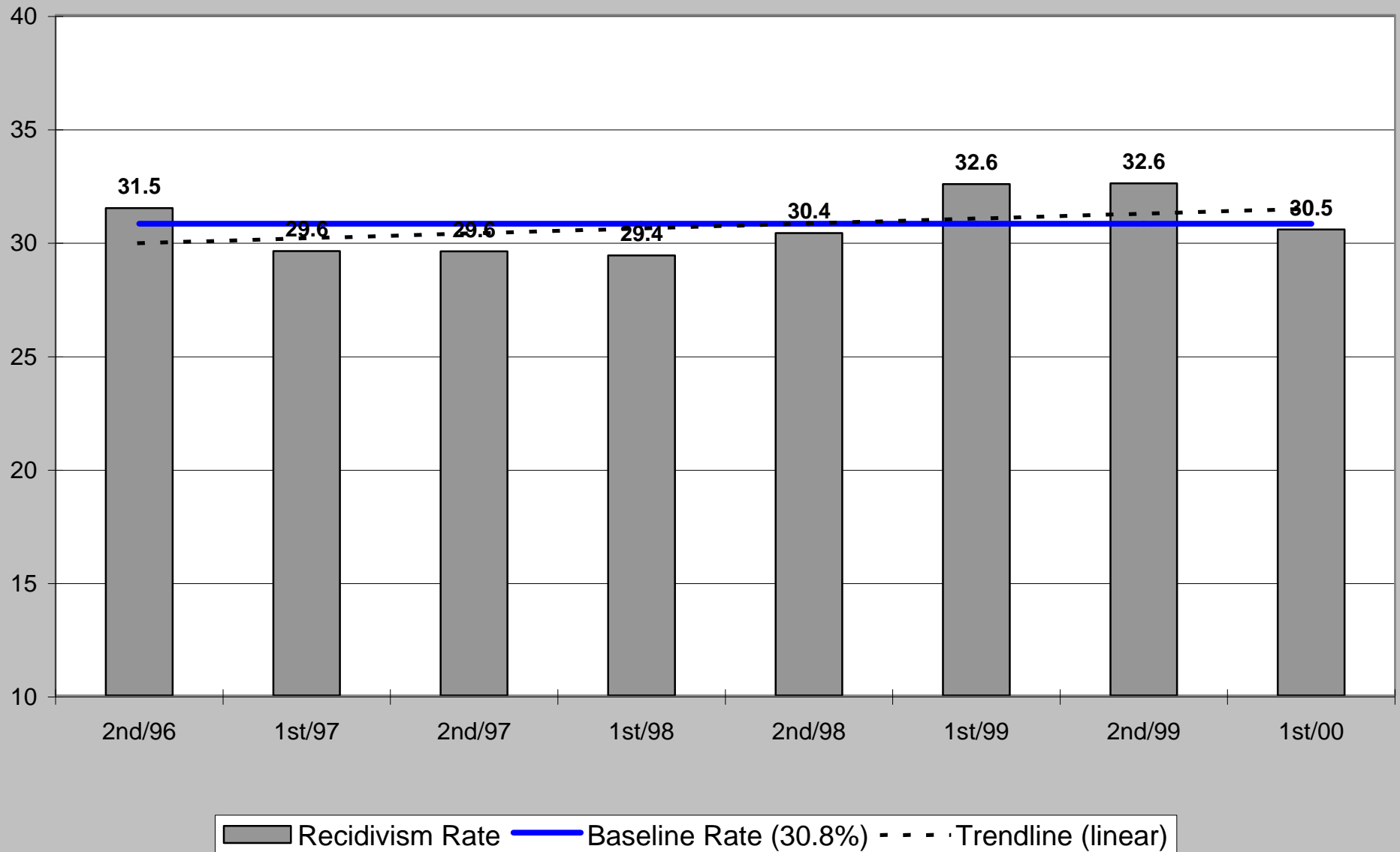


■ Recidivism Rate — Baseline Rate (22.5%) - - - Trend (Linear)

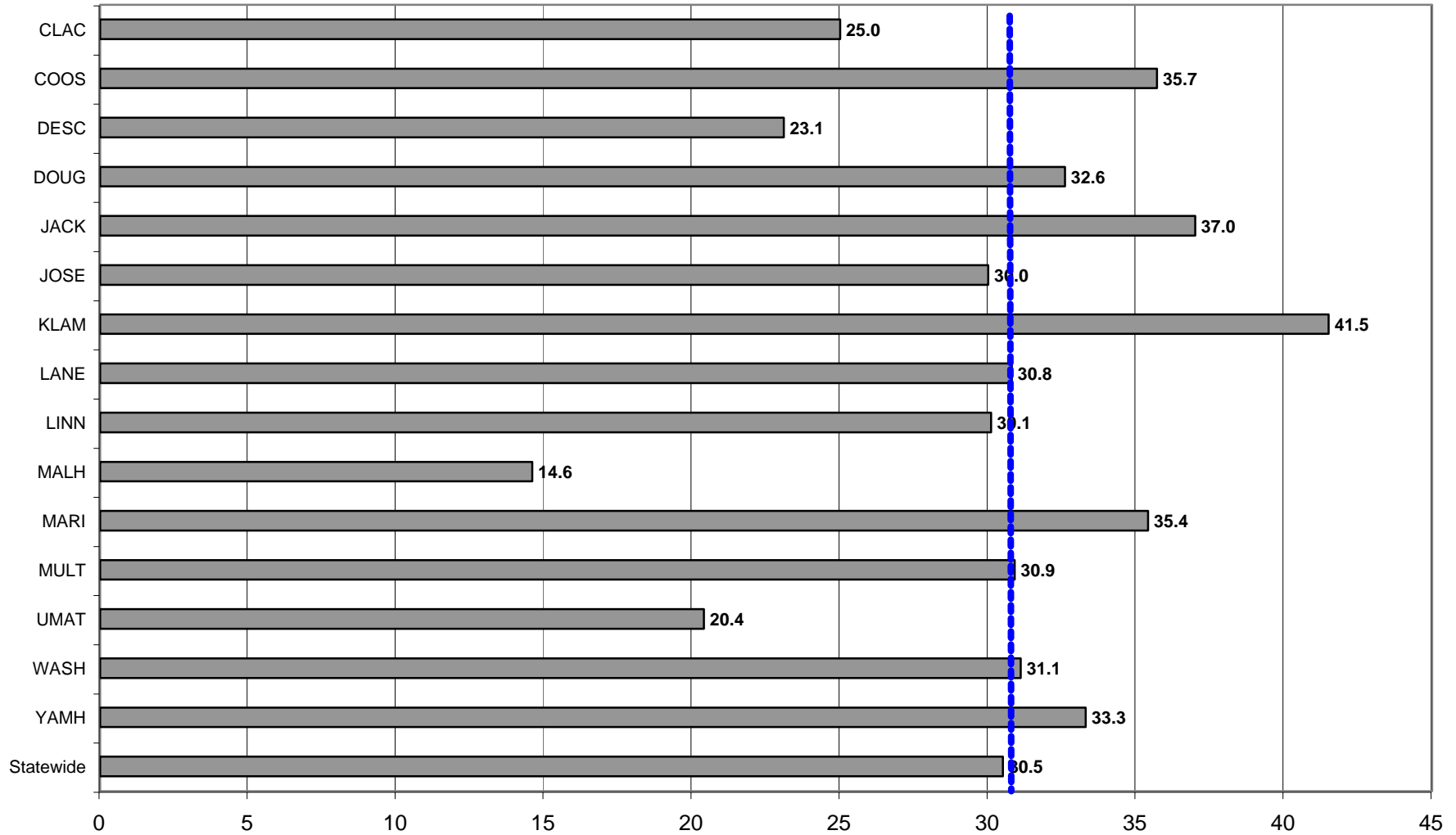
Probation Recidivism by County for 1st Half 2003 (Number of Closures >30)

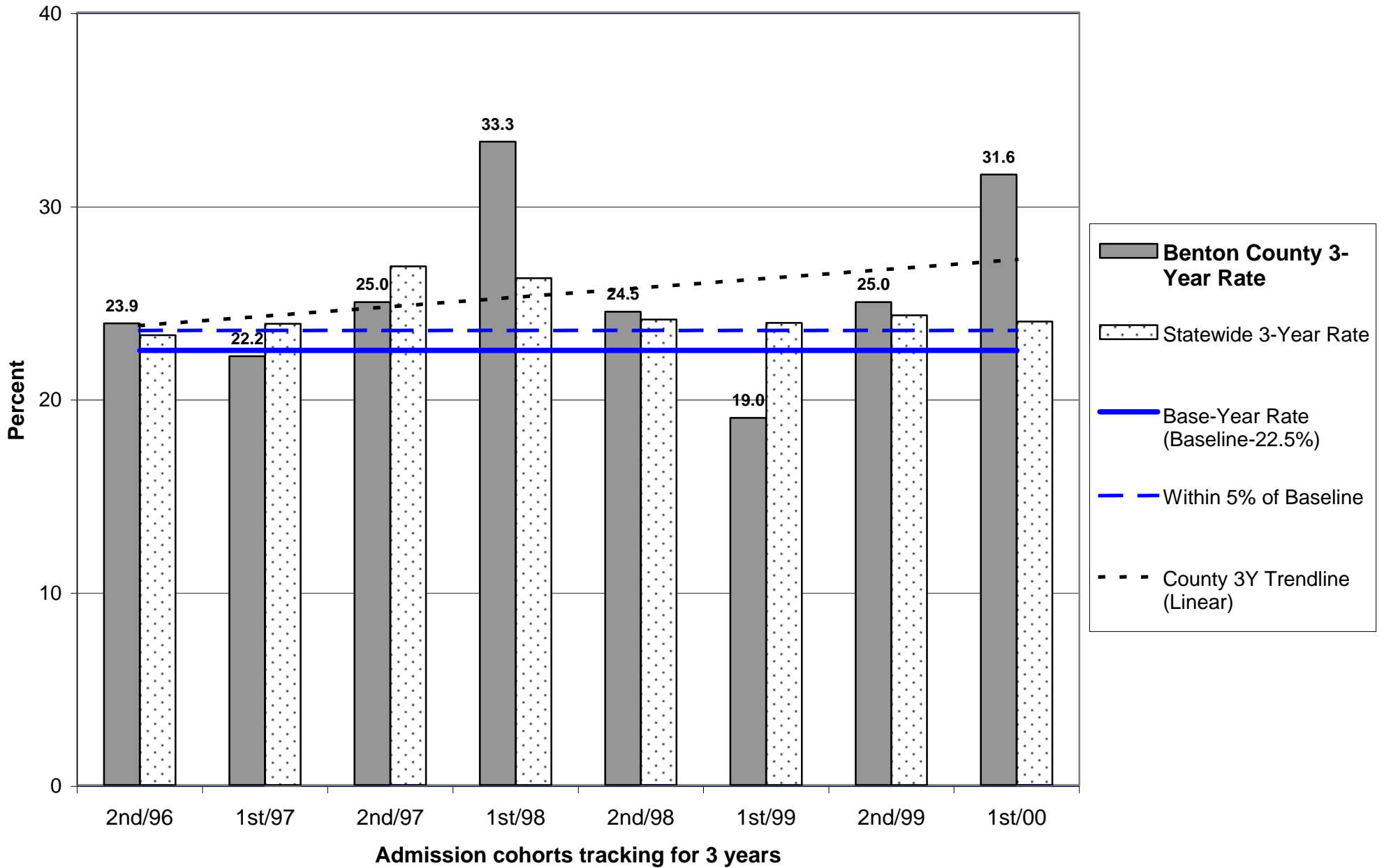

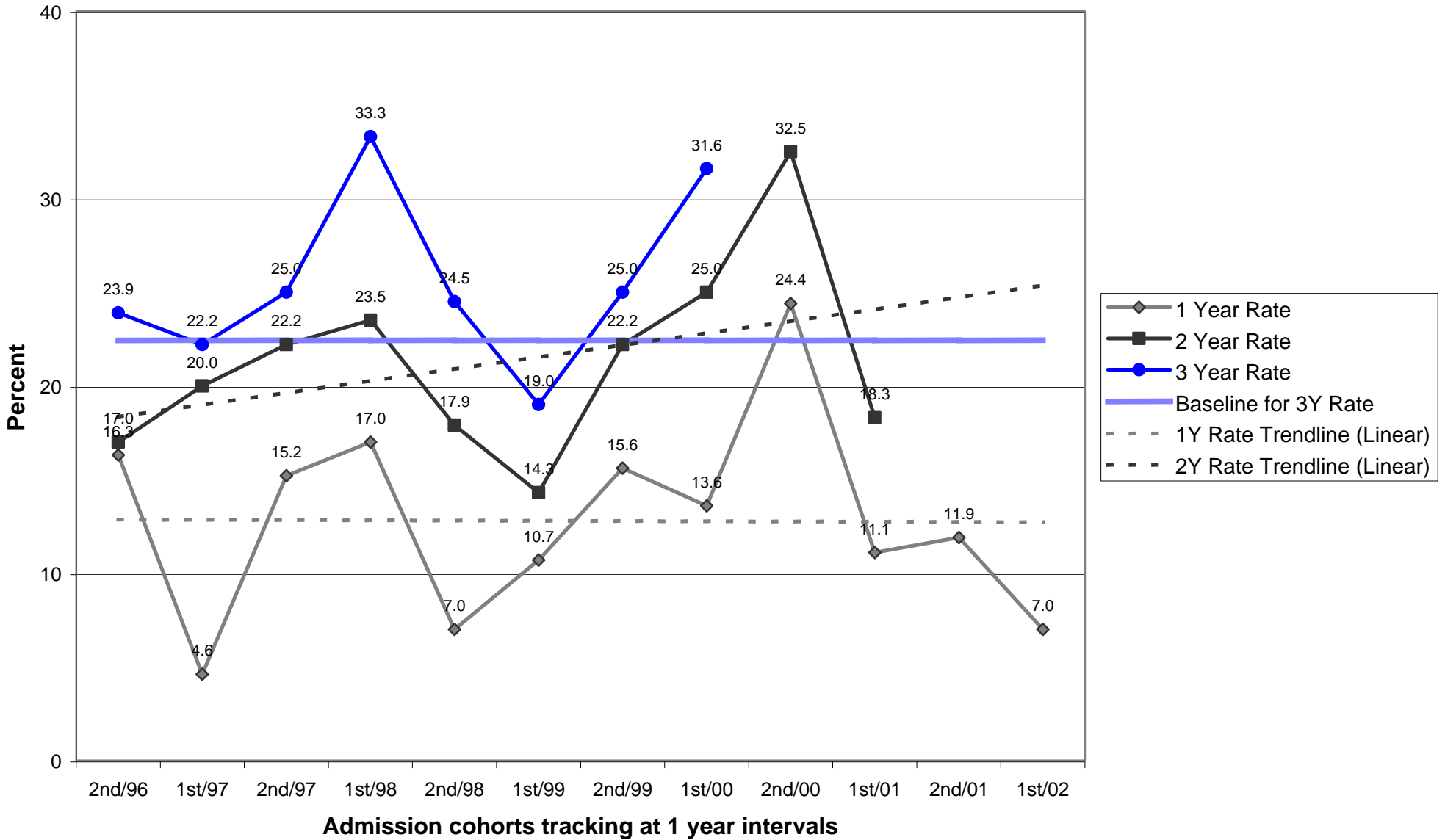

Probation Recidivism Rates - 1st Half 2003

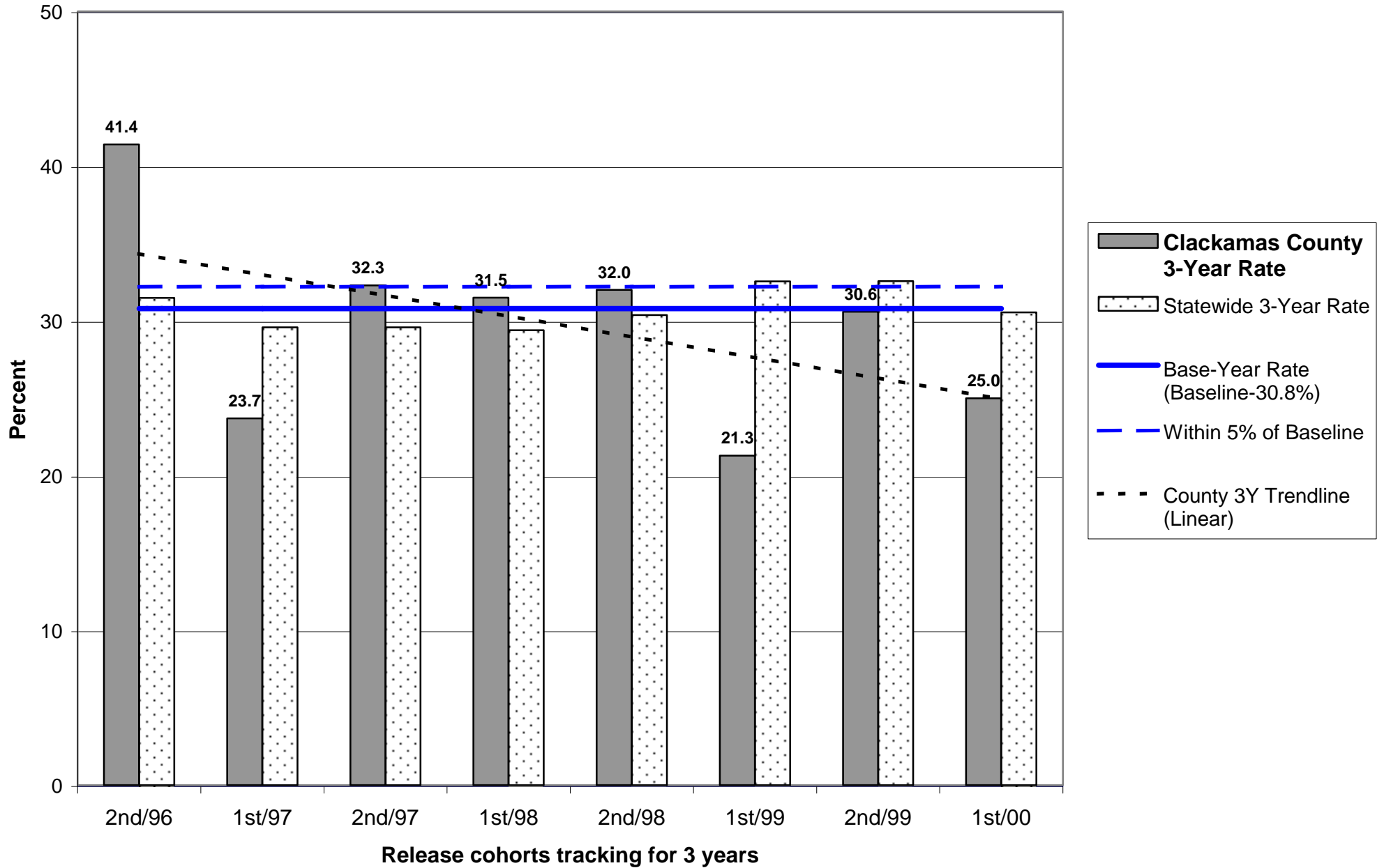


Probation Recidivism Rates - 1st Half 2003

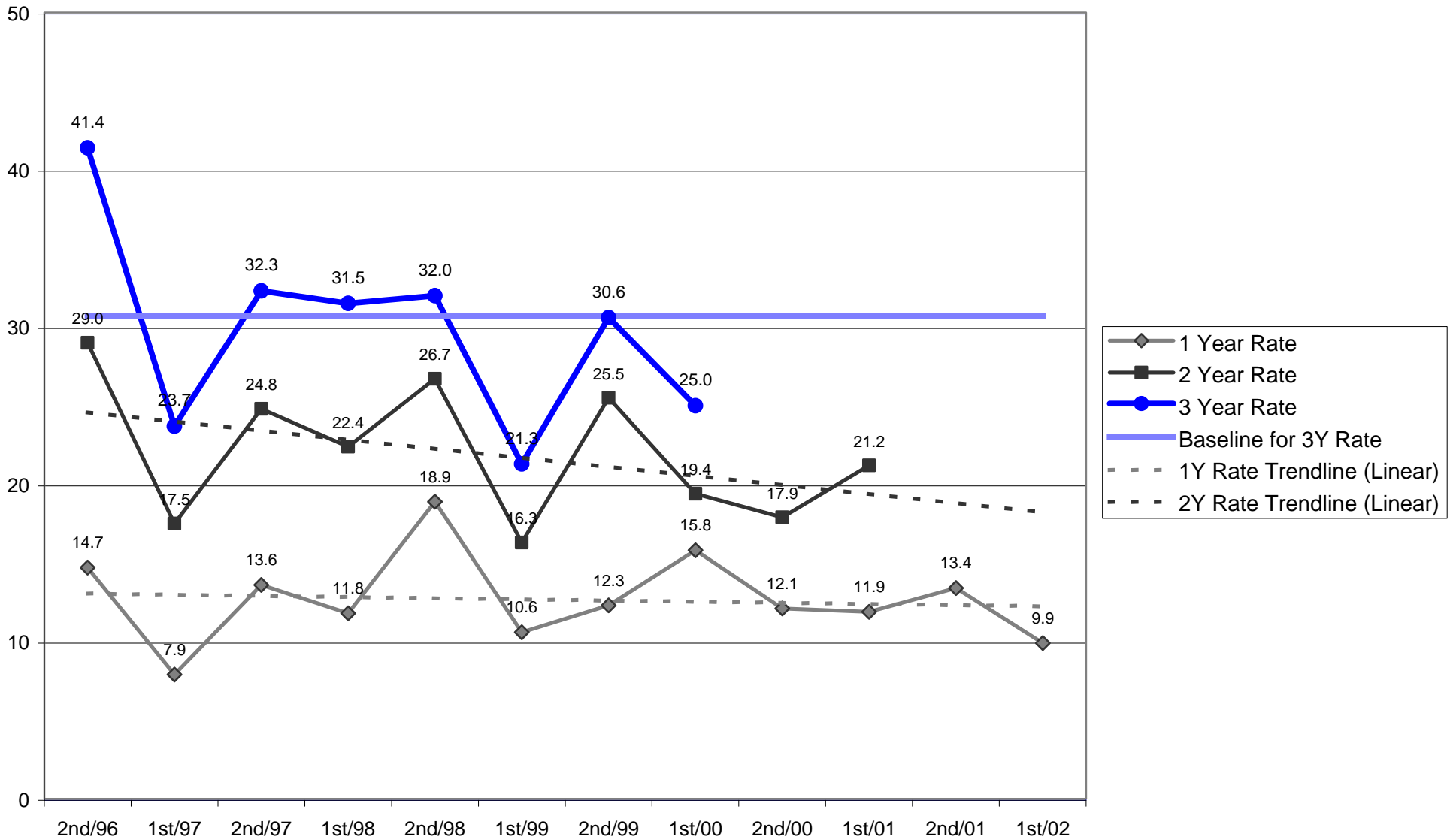


Parole/Post-Prison Supervision Recidivism Rates - 1st Half 2003

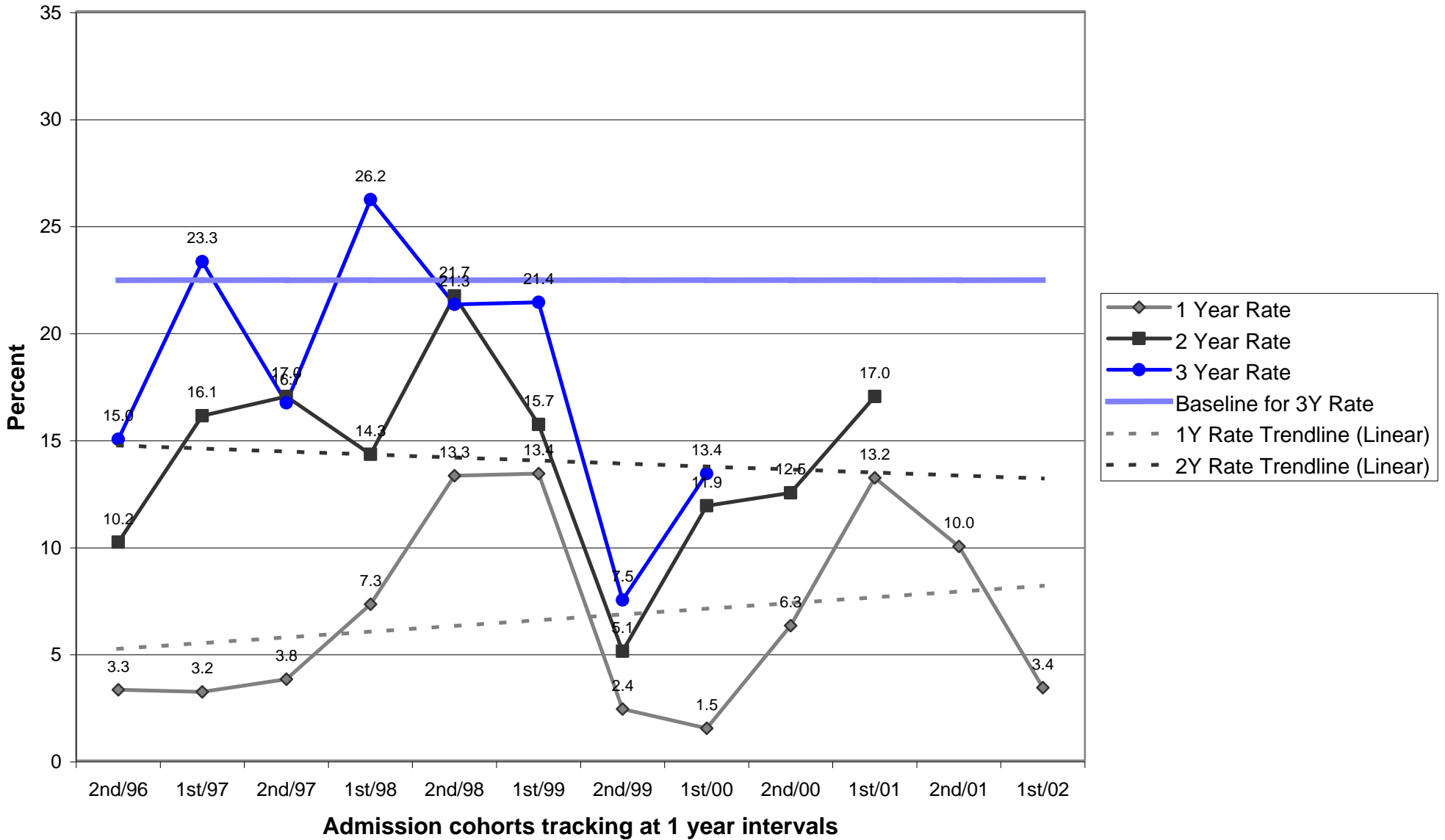

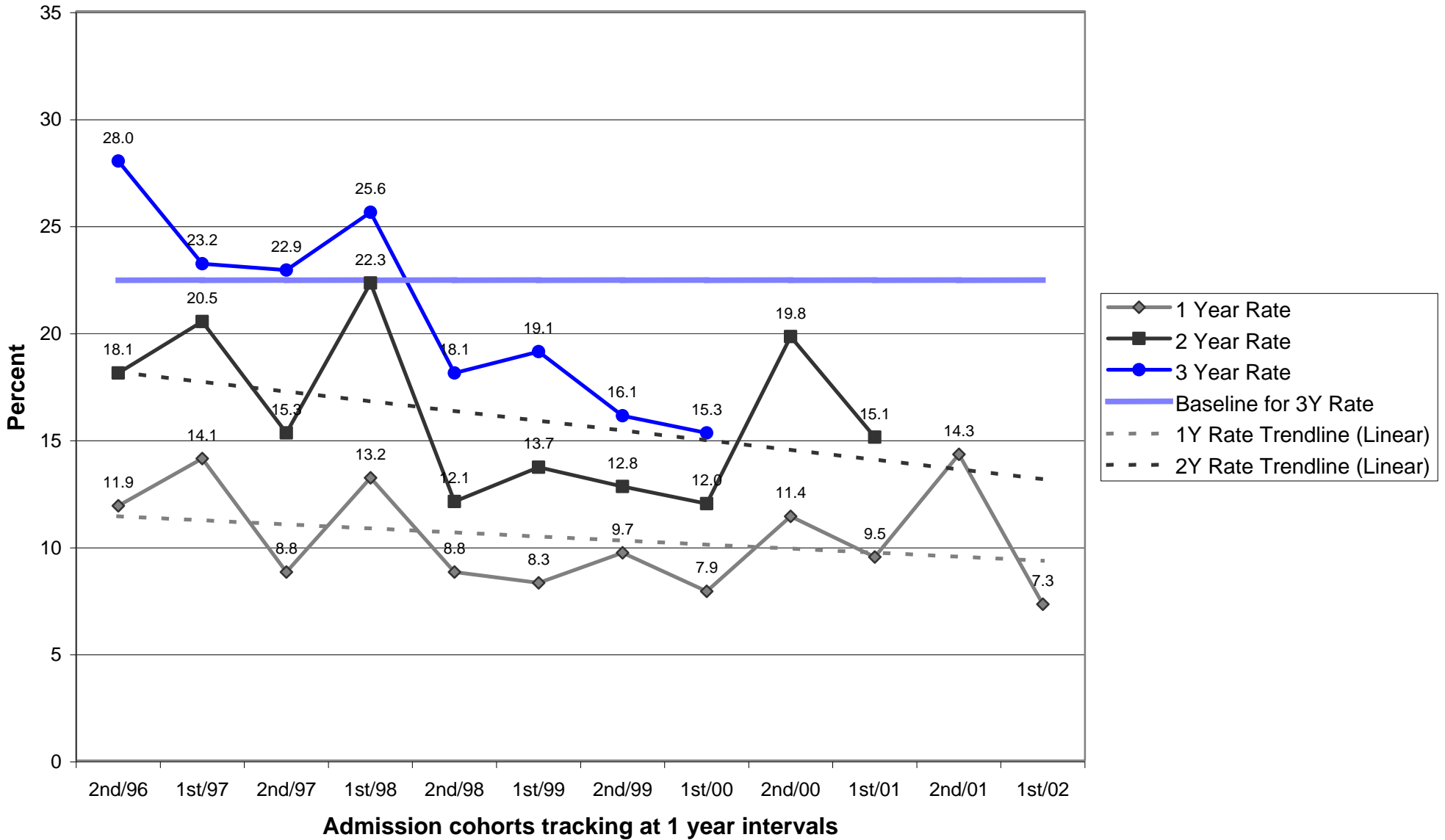

Probation Recidivism Rates - 1st Half 2003

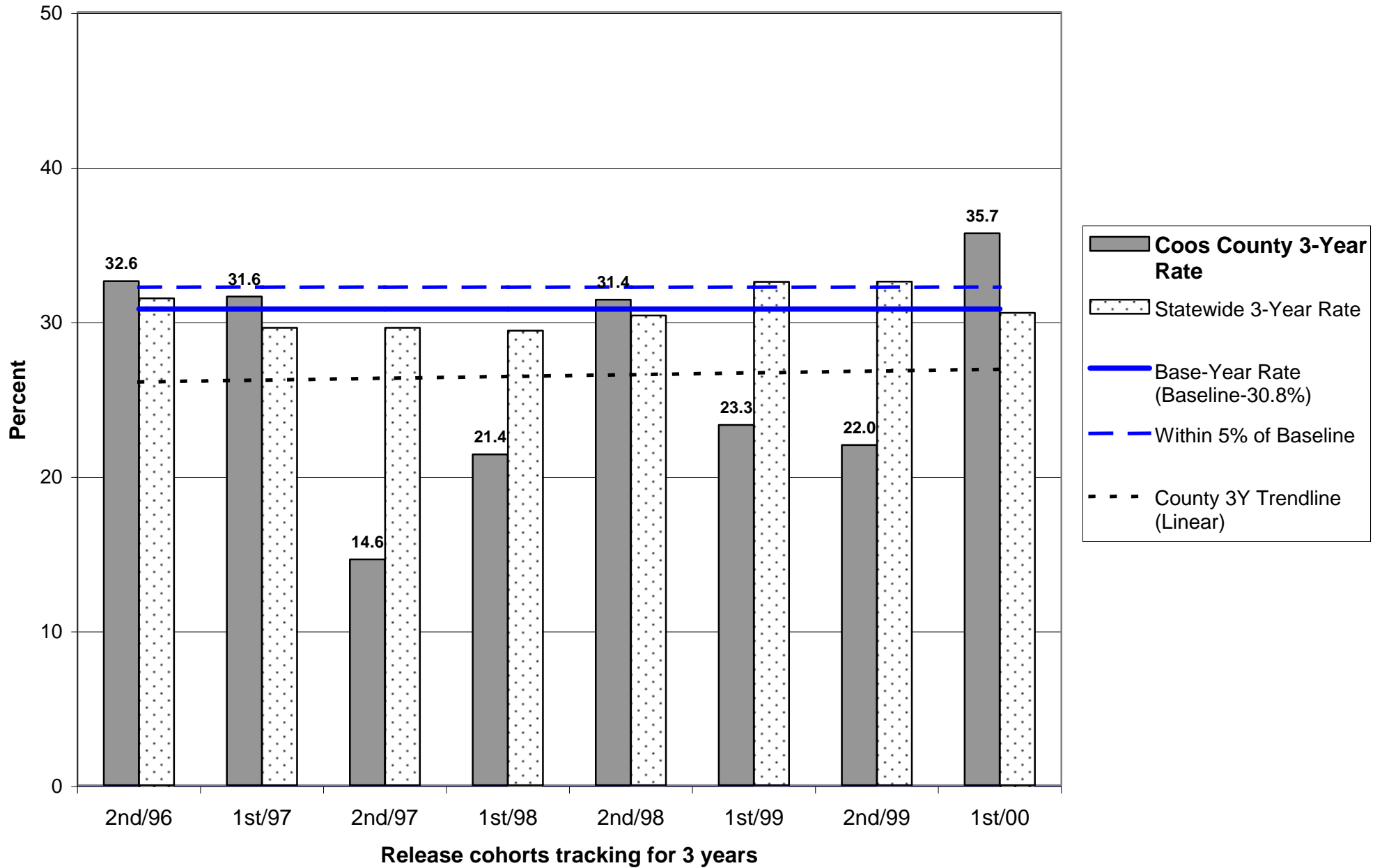


Probation Recidivism Rates - 1st Half 2003

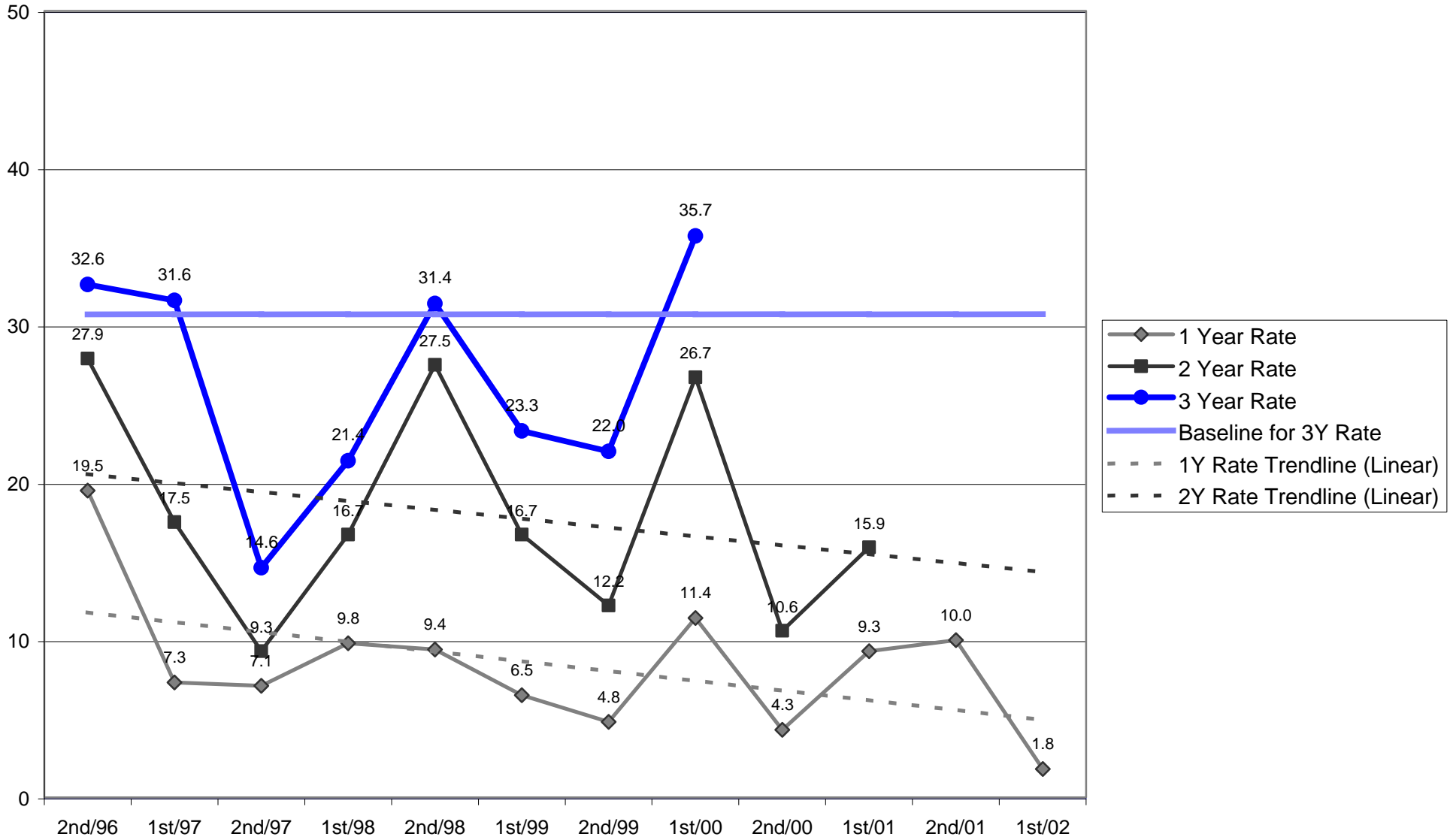


Parole/Post-Prison Supervision Recidivism Rates - 1st Half 2003

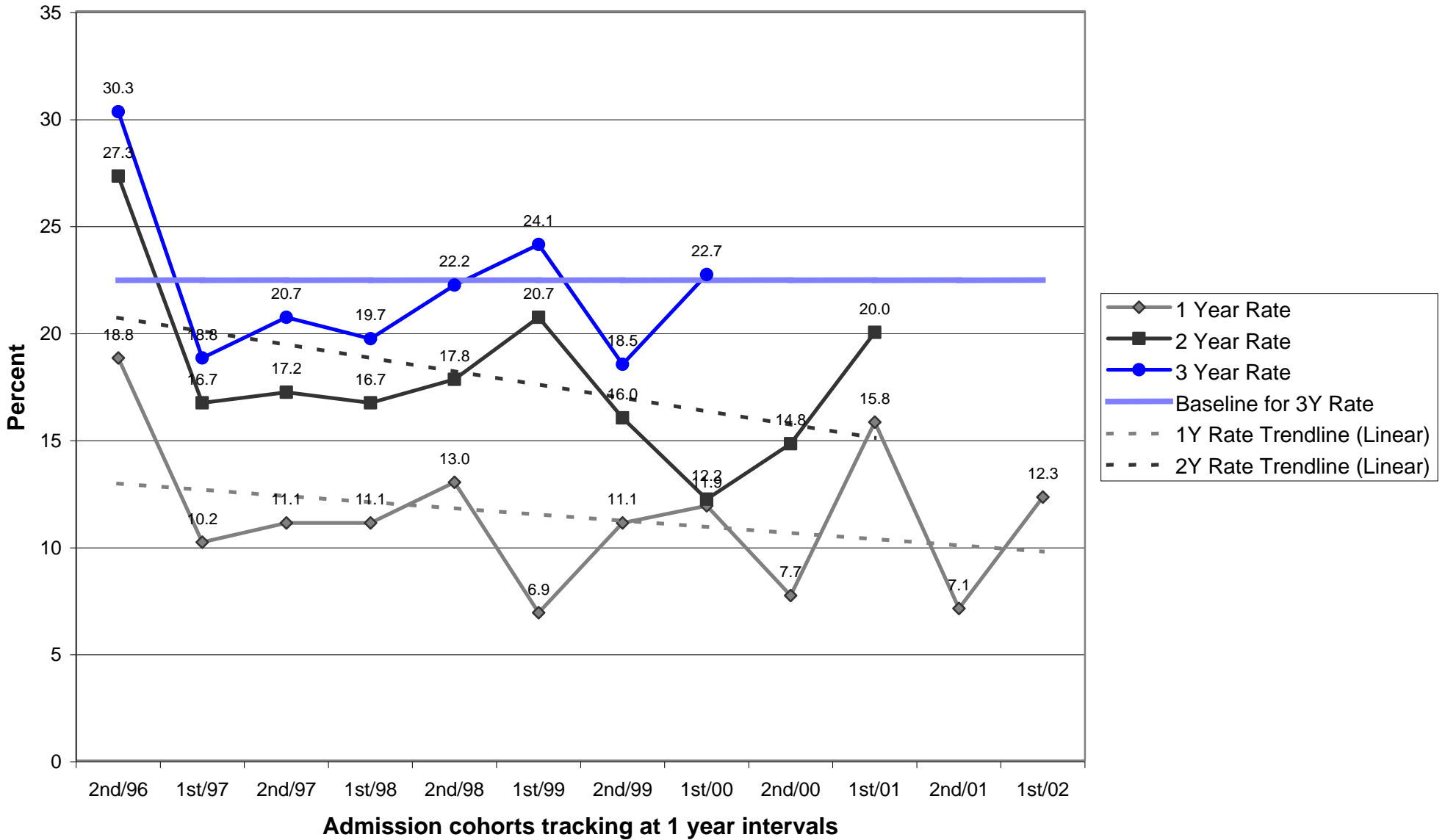

Probation Recidivism Rates - 1st Half 2003

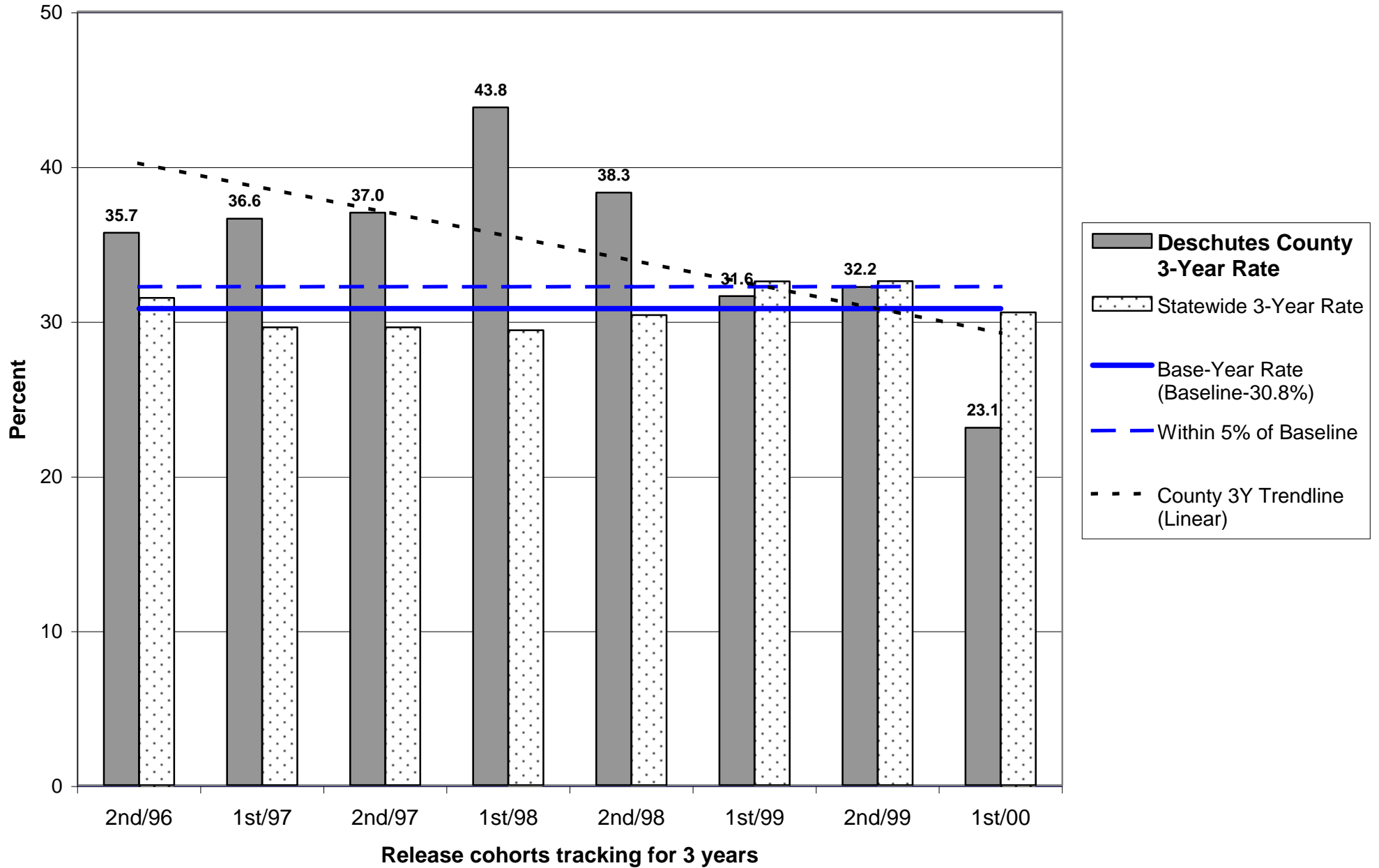


Probation Recidivism Rates - 1st Half 2003

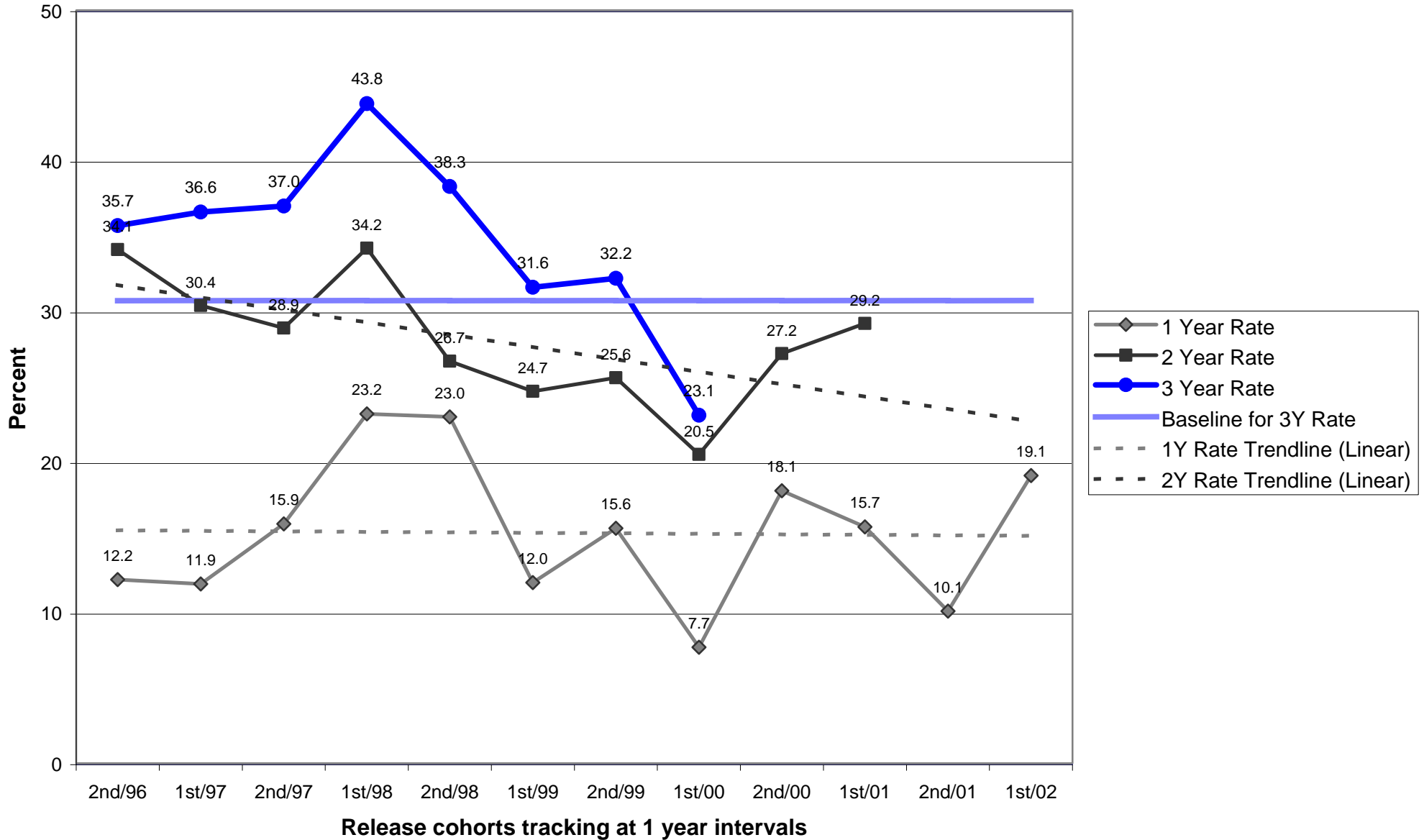


Parole/Post-Prison Supervision Recidivism Rates - 1st Half 2003

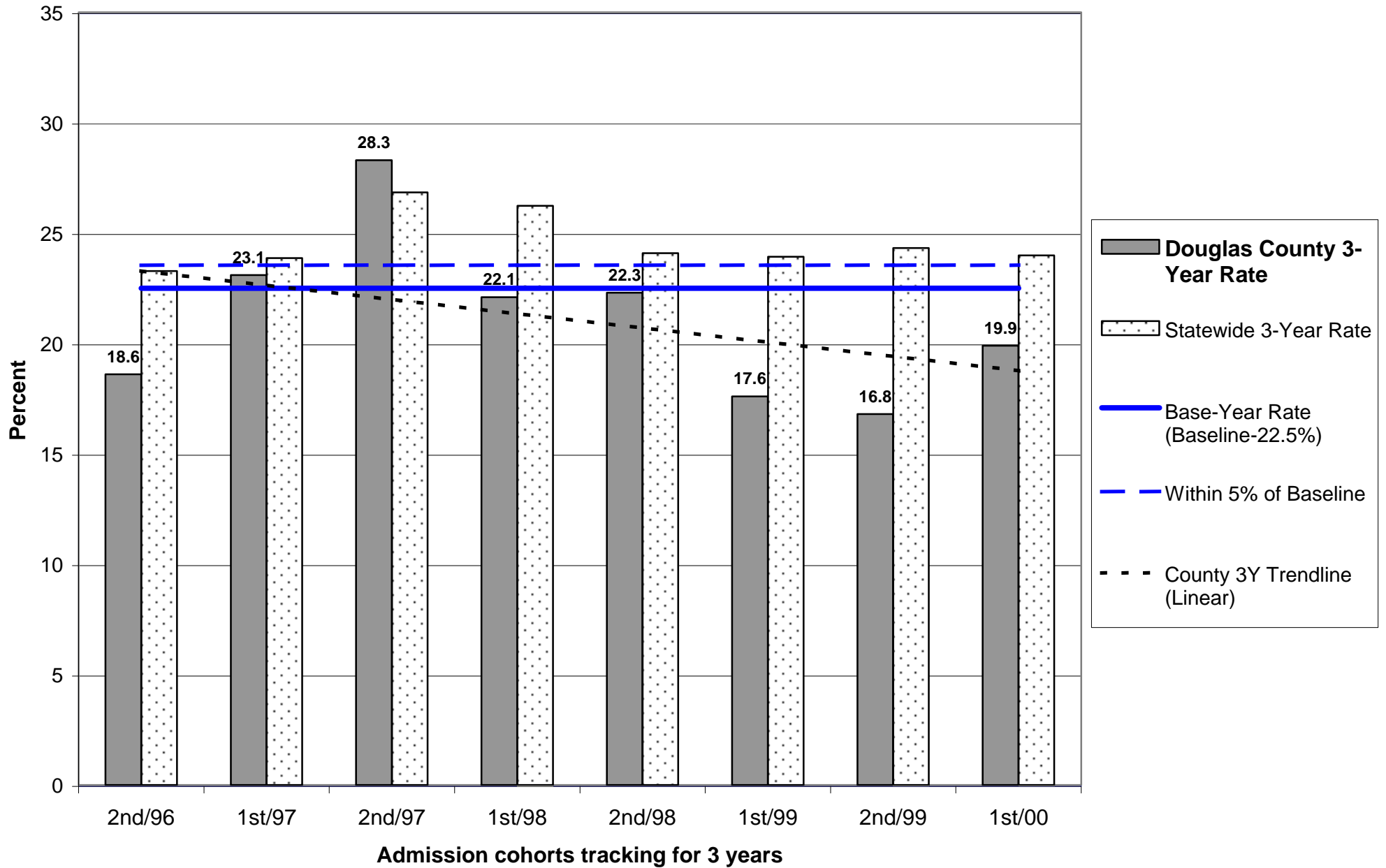

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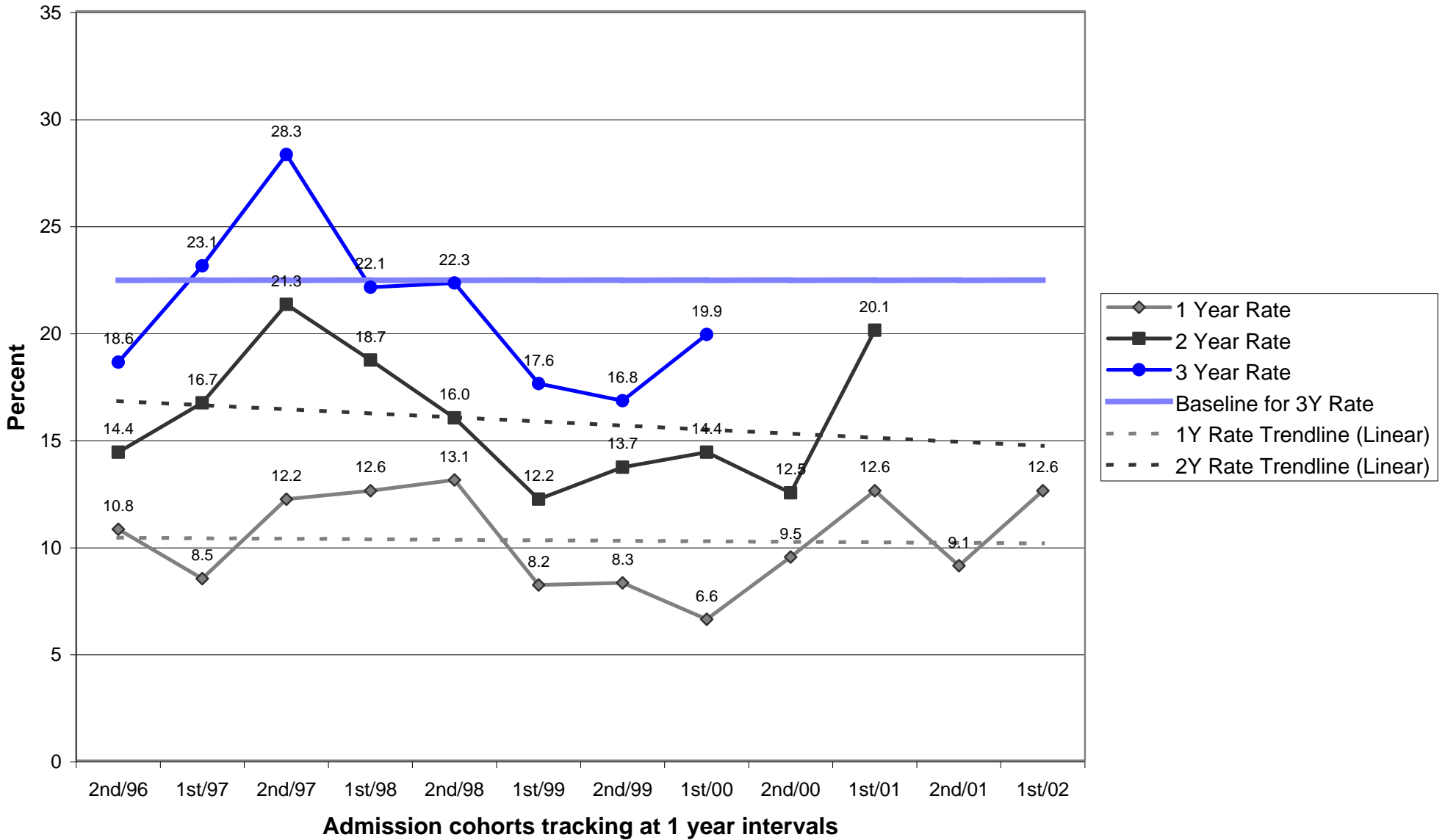

Probation Recidivism Rates - 1st Half 2003

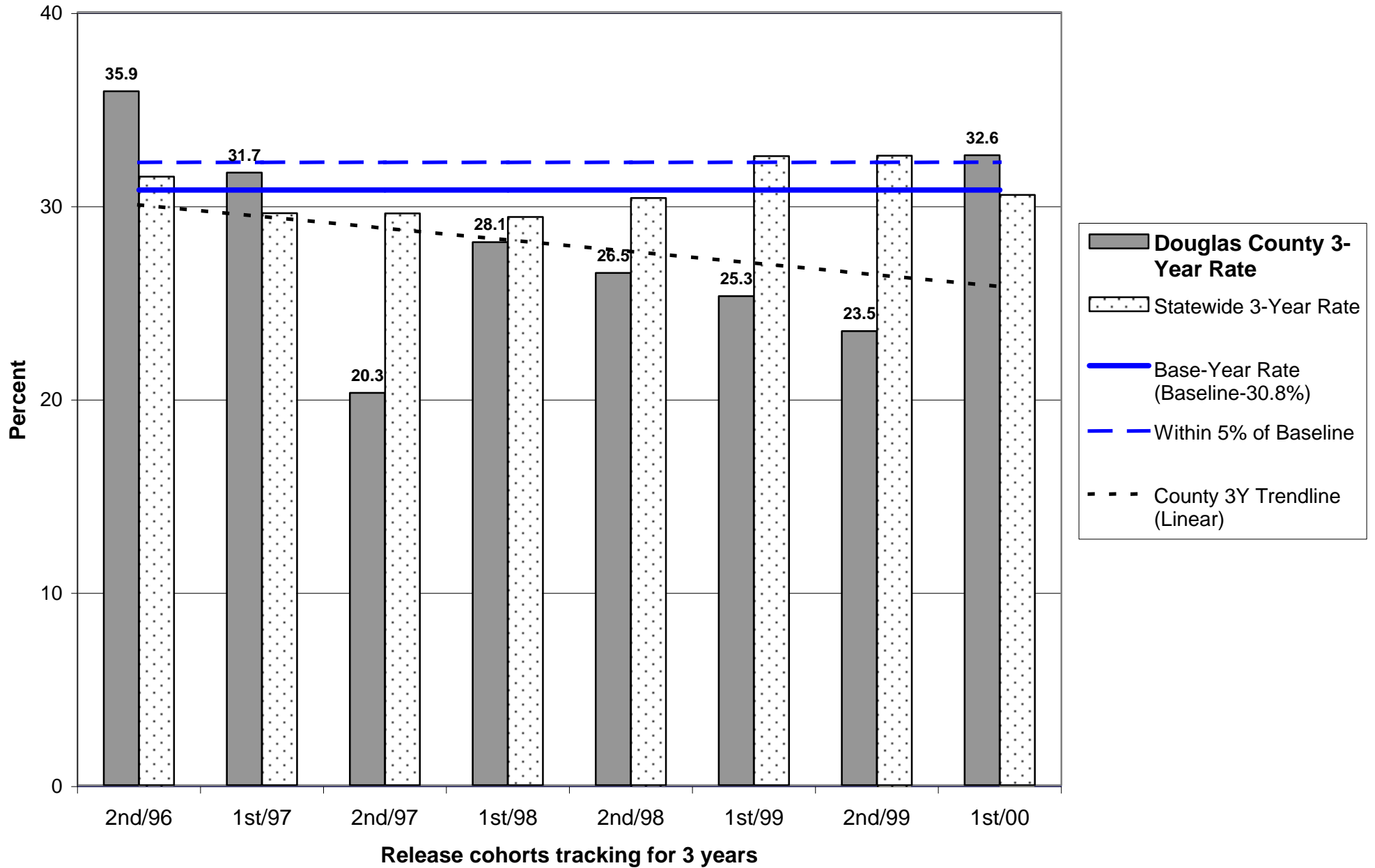


Probation Recidivism Rates - 1st Half 2003

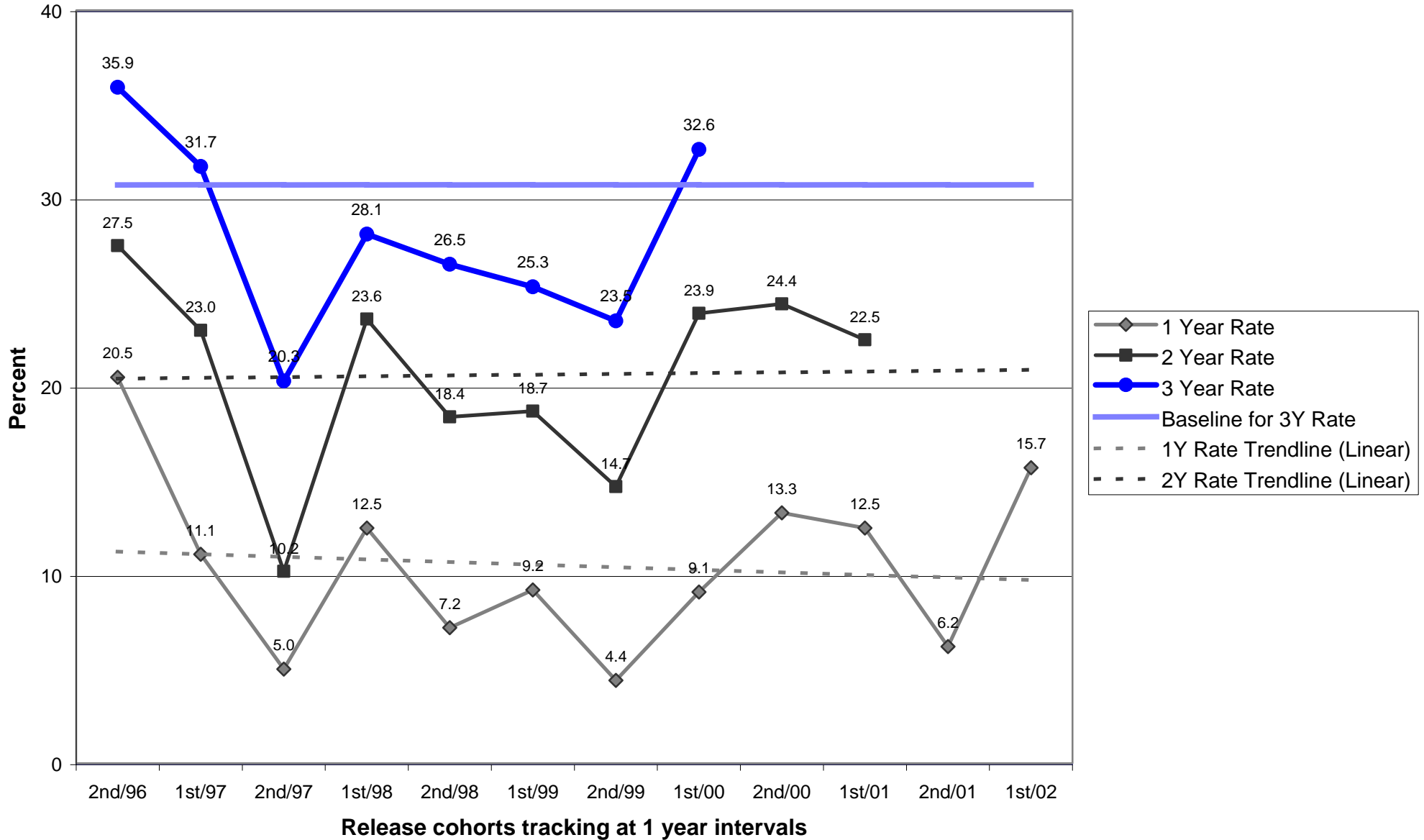


Parole/Post-Prison Supervision Recidivism Rates - 1st Half 2003

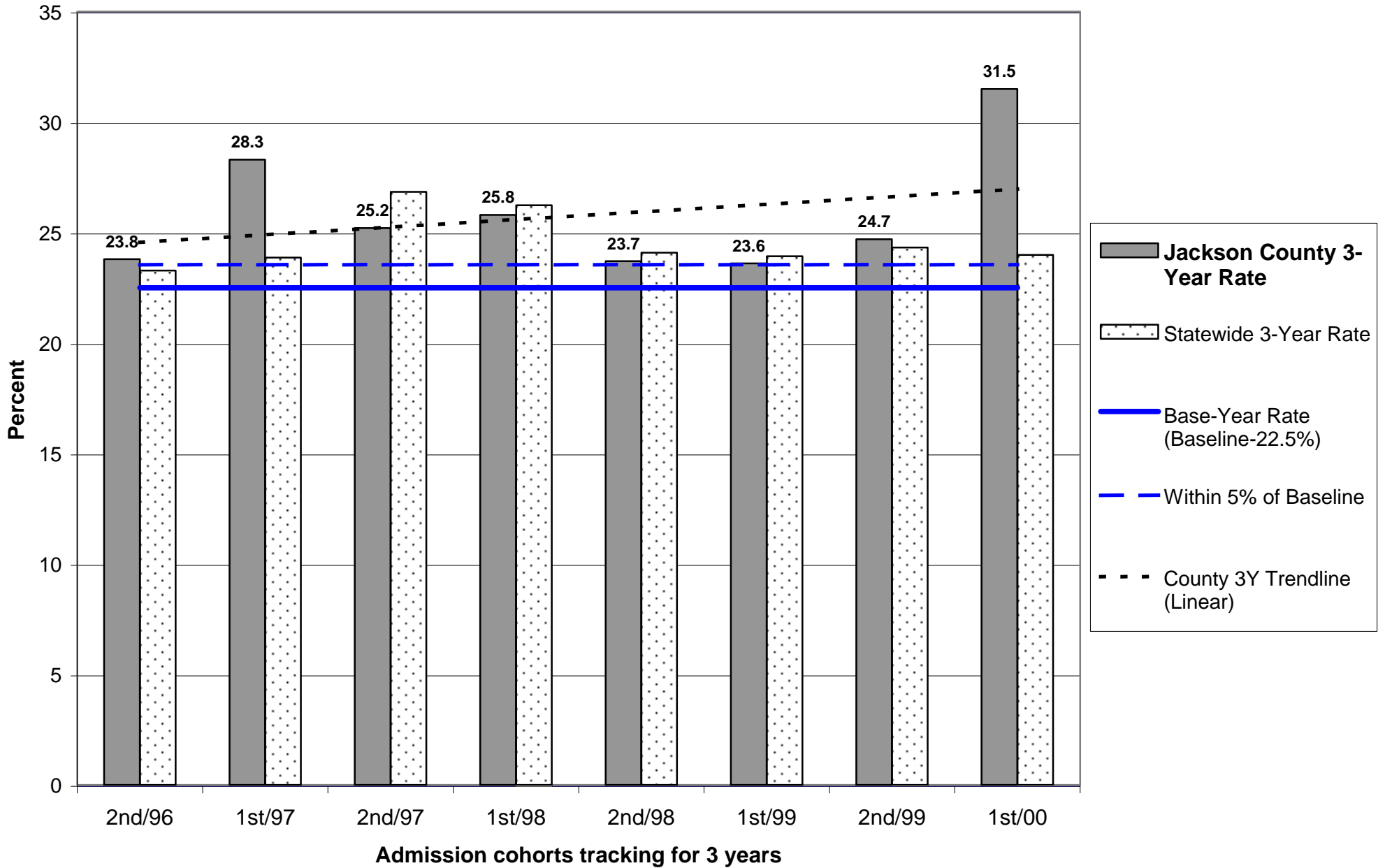

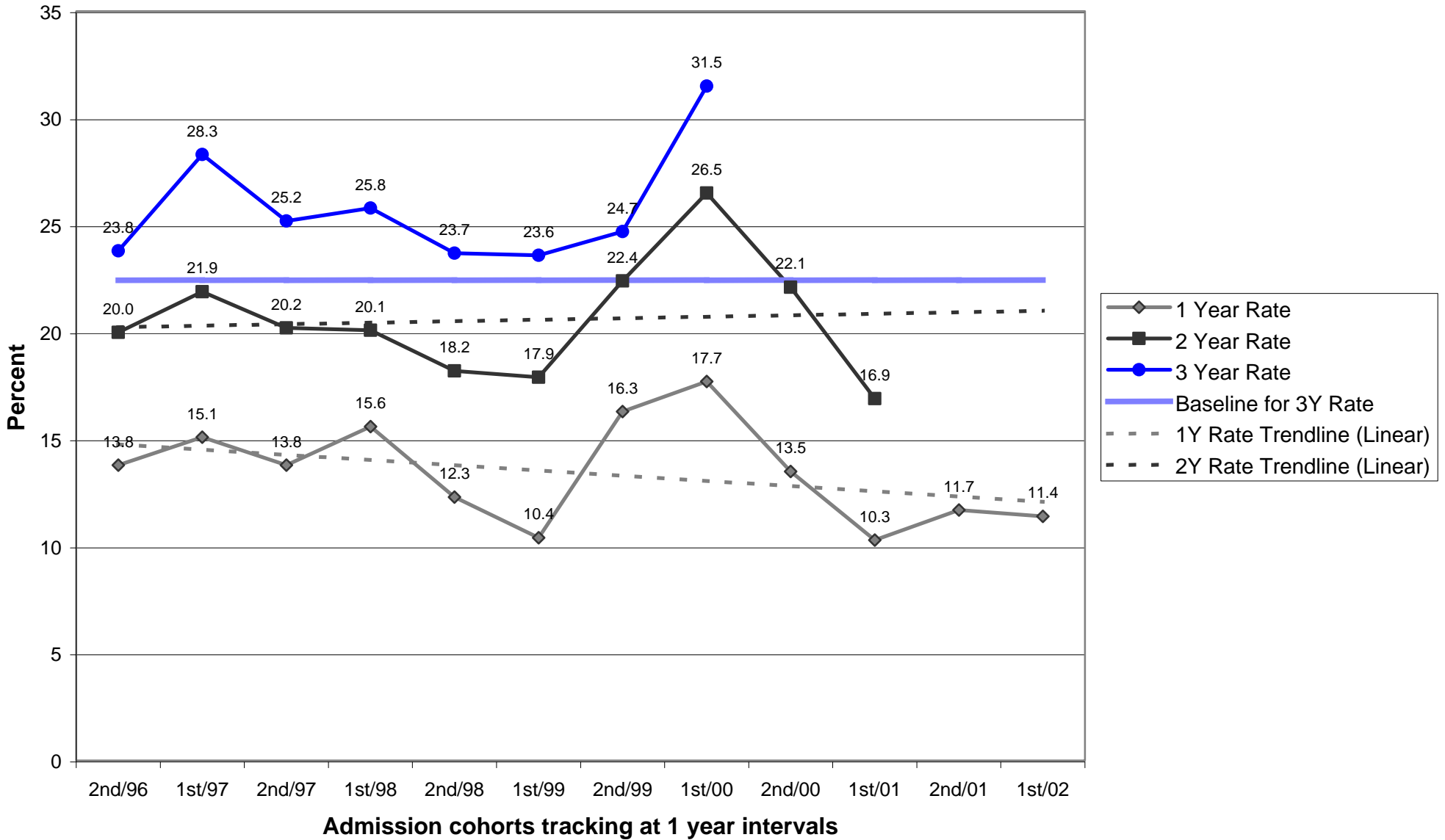

Probation Recidivism Rates - 1st Half 2003

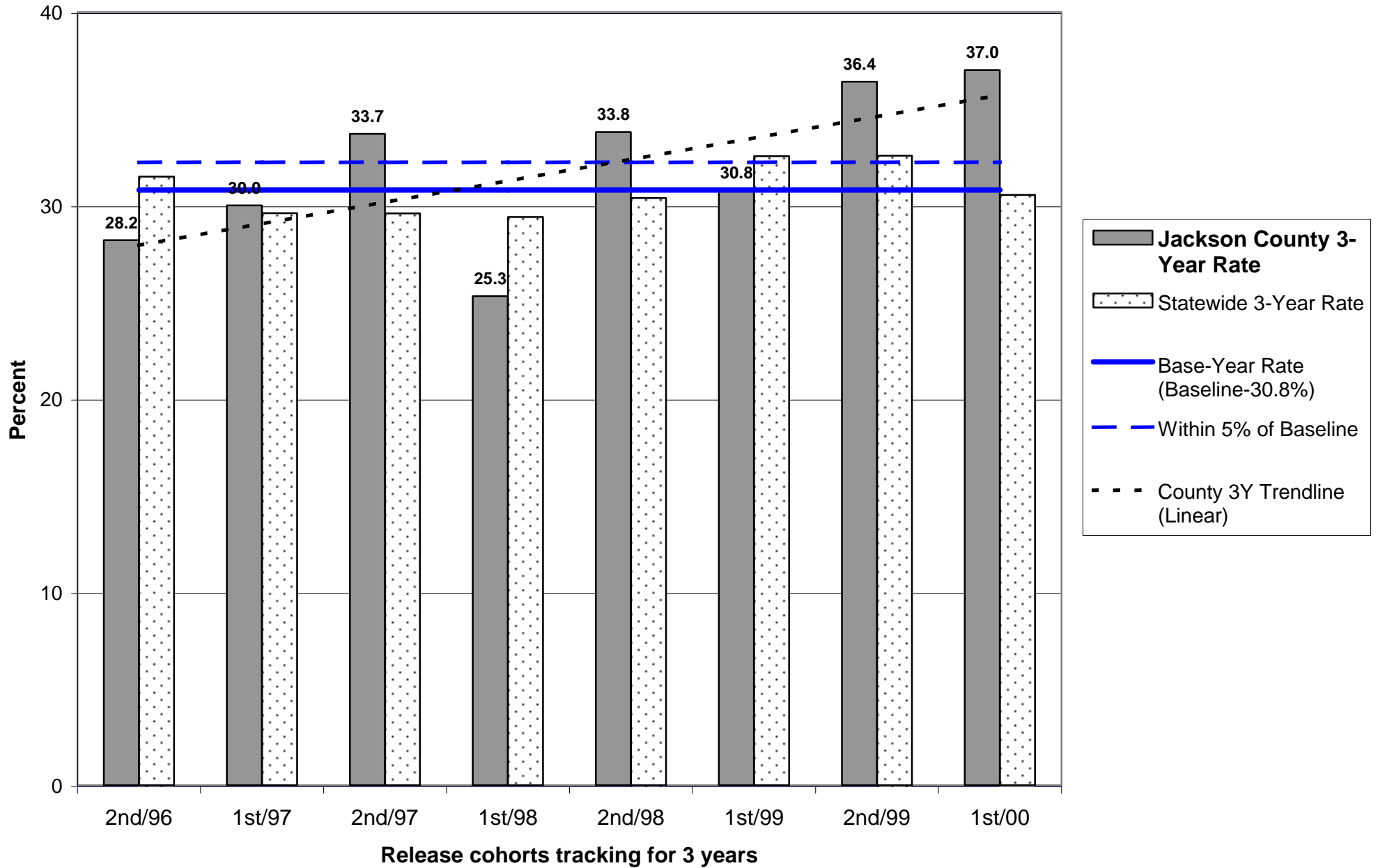

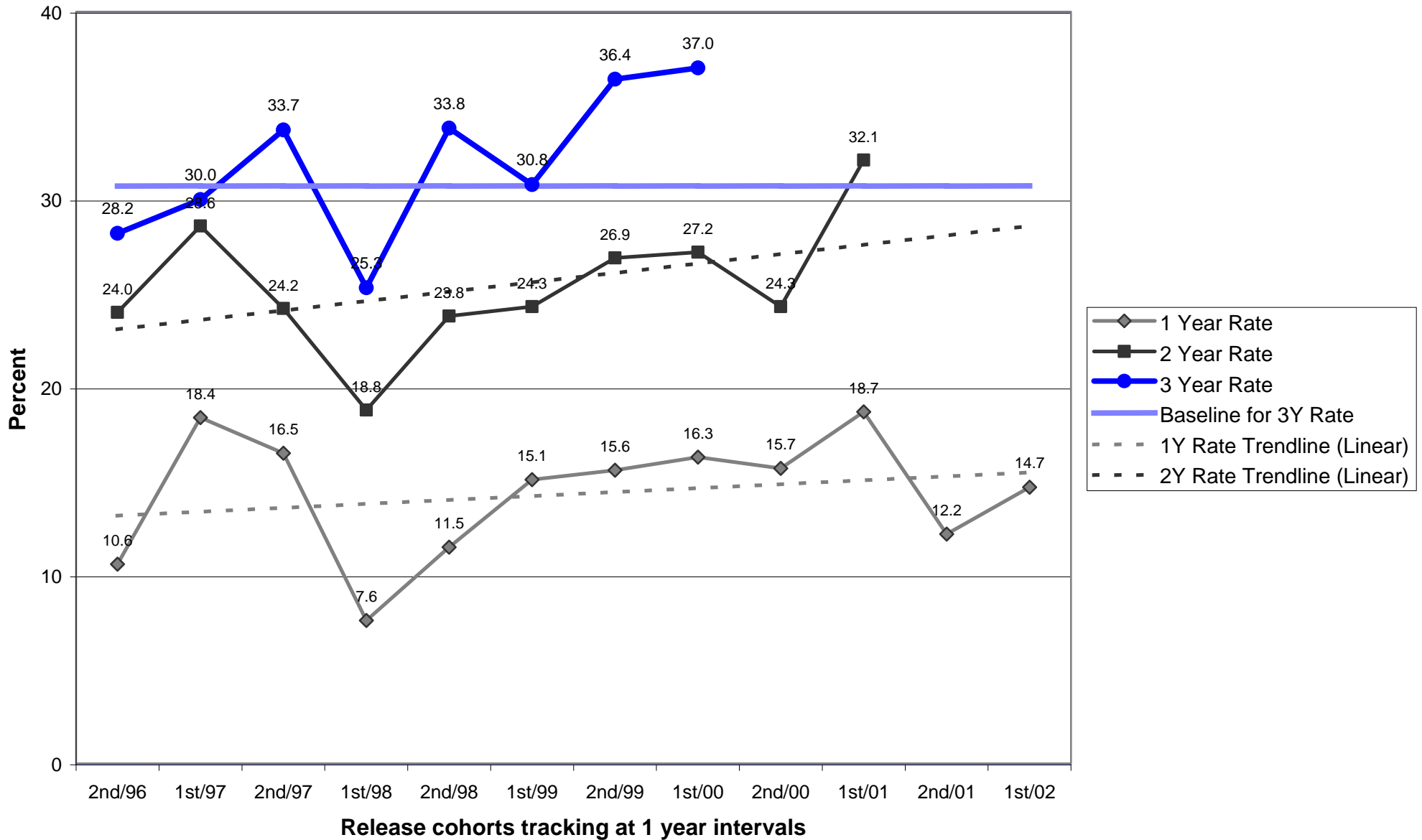


Parole/Post-Prison Supervision Recidivism Rates - 1st Half 2003

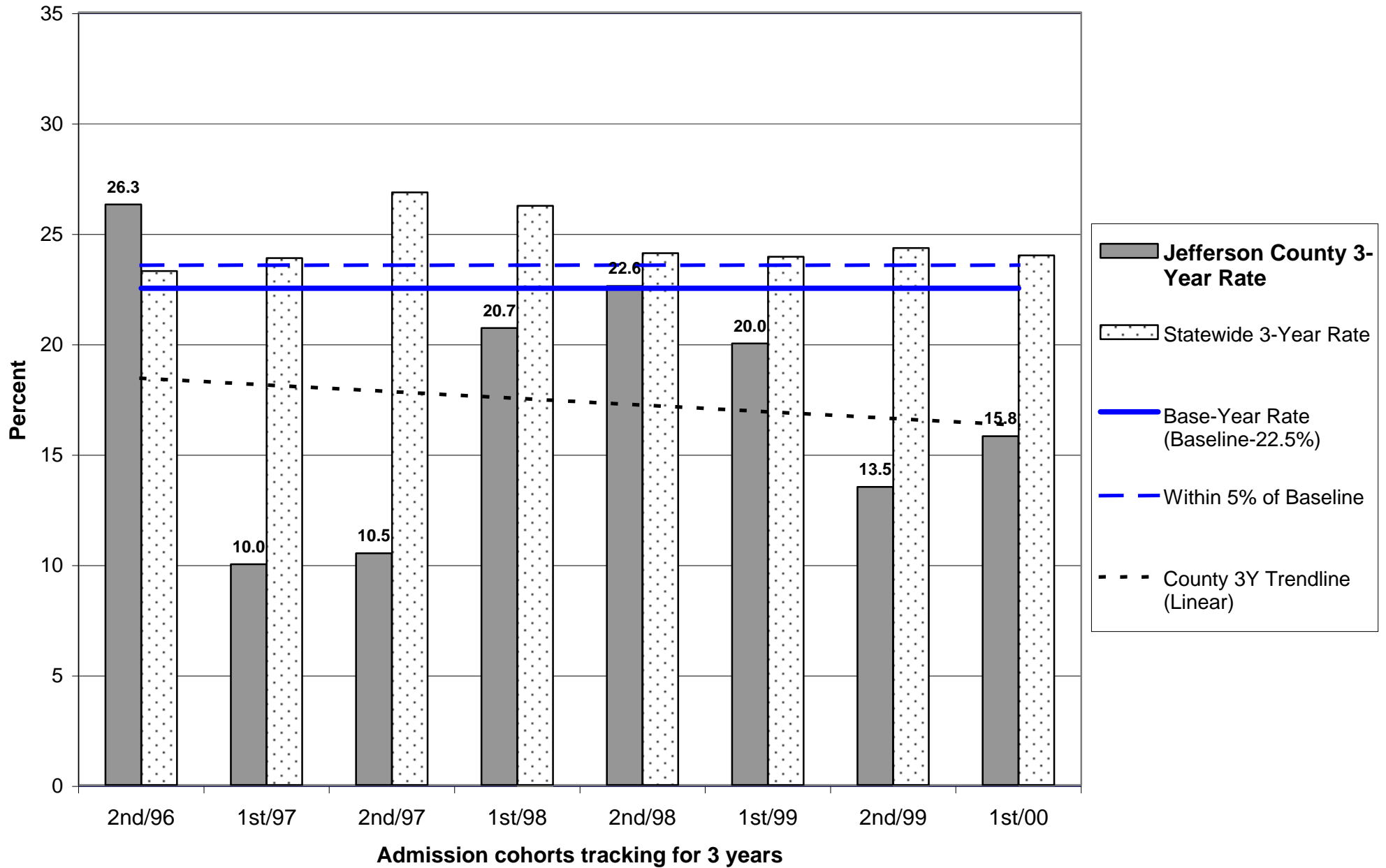

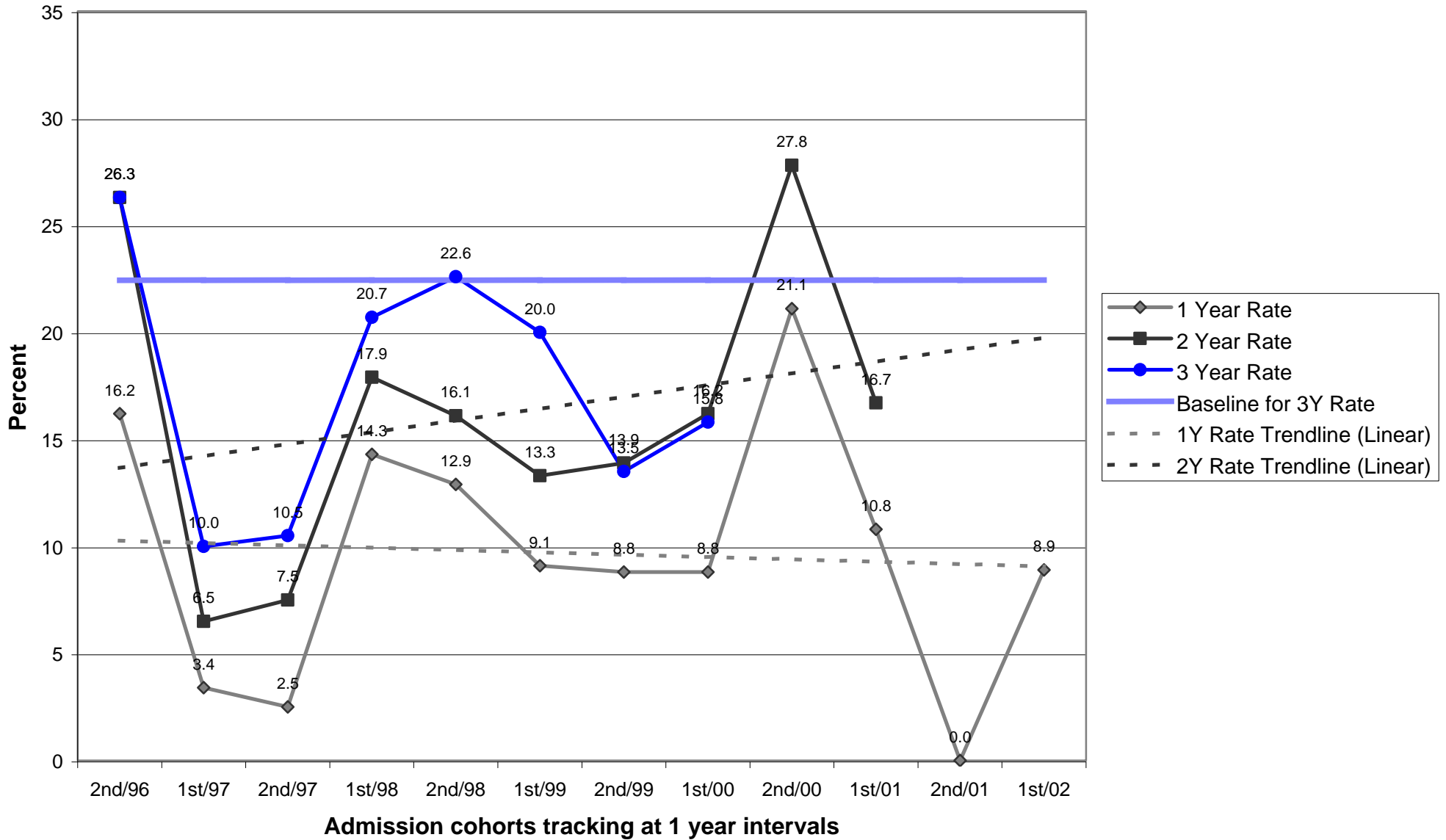
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Probation Recidivism Rates - 1st Half 2003

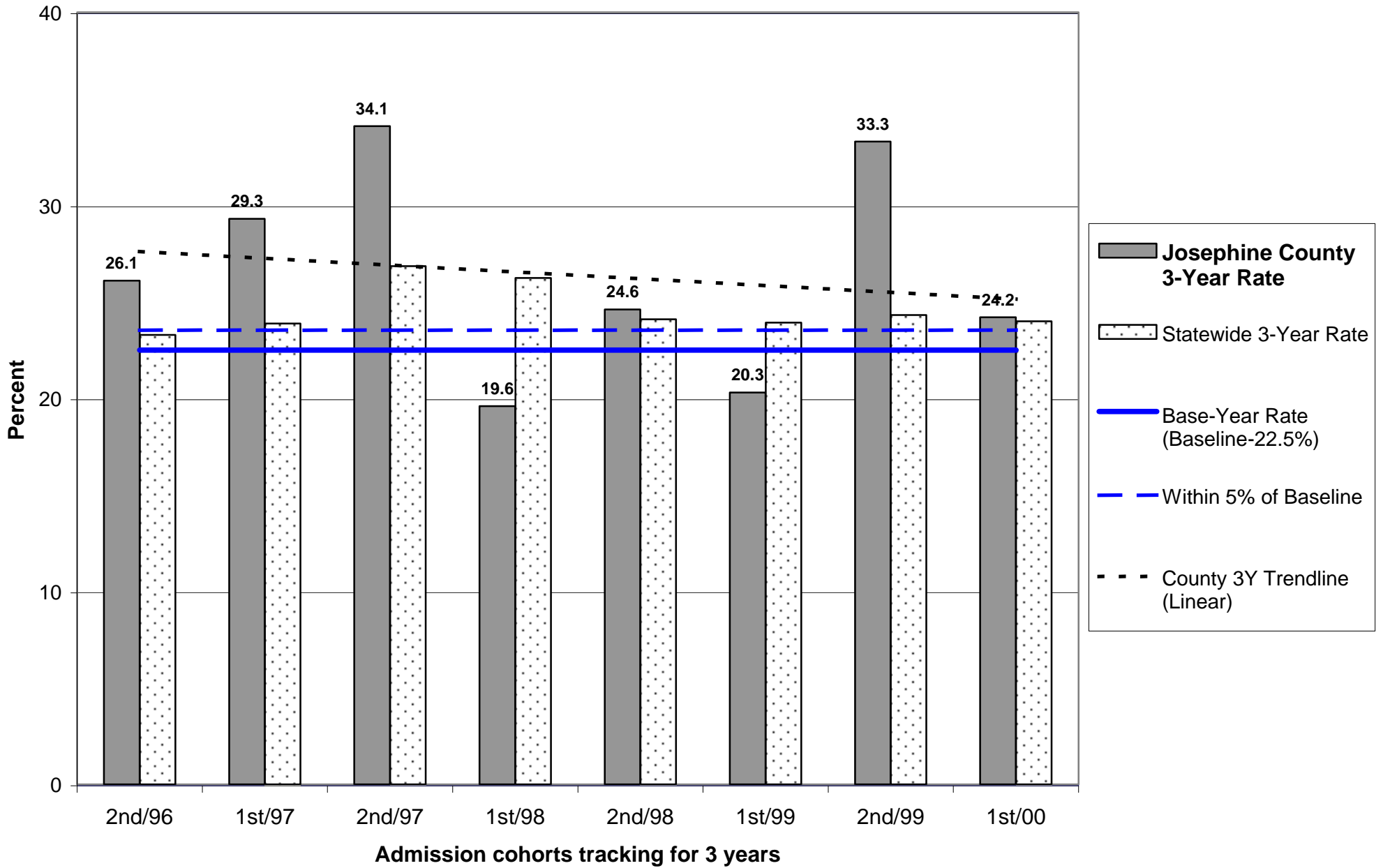
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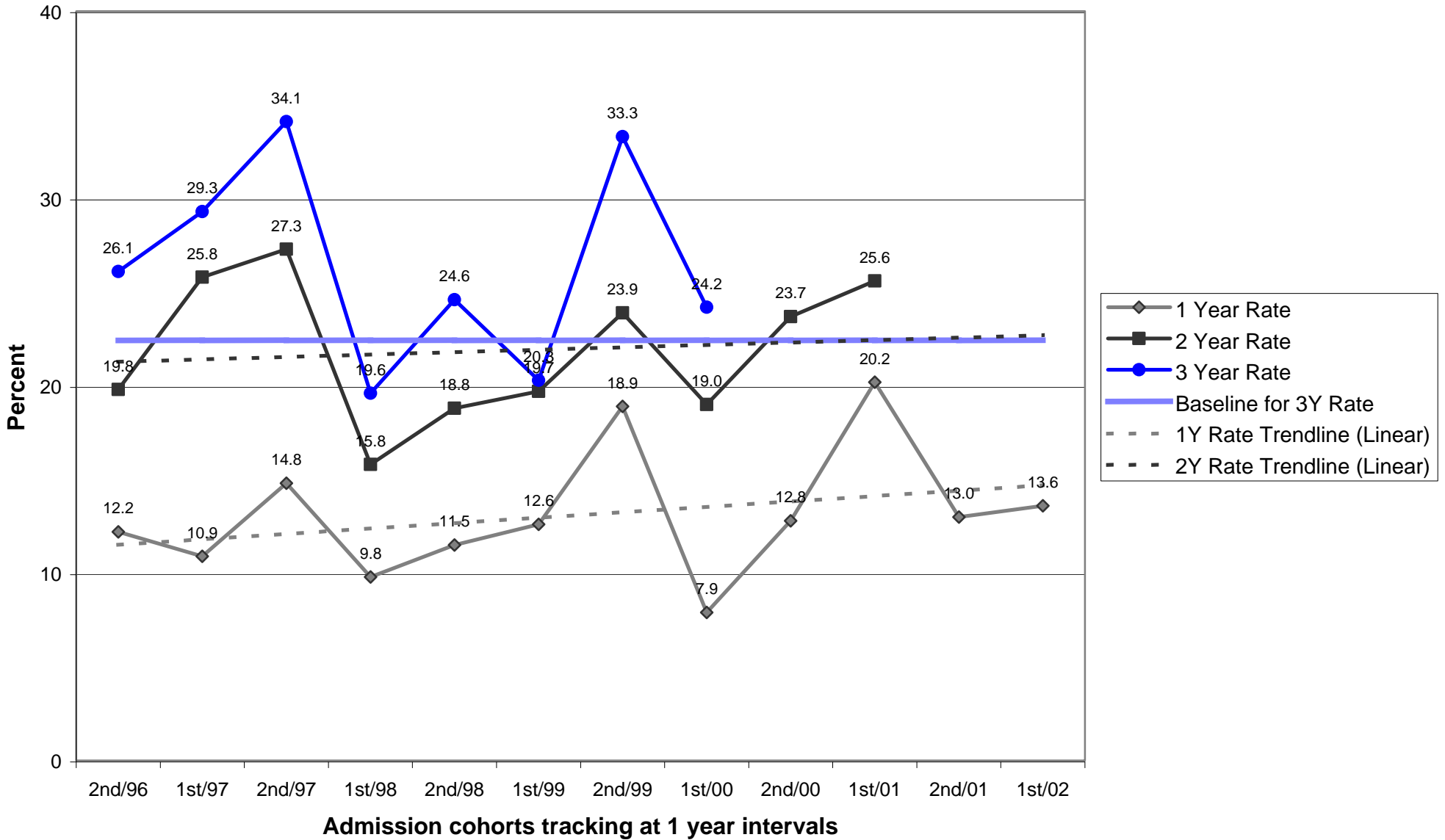

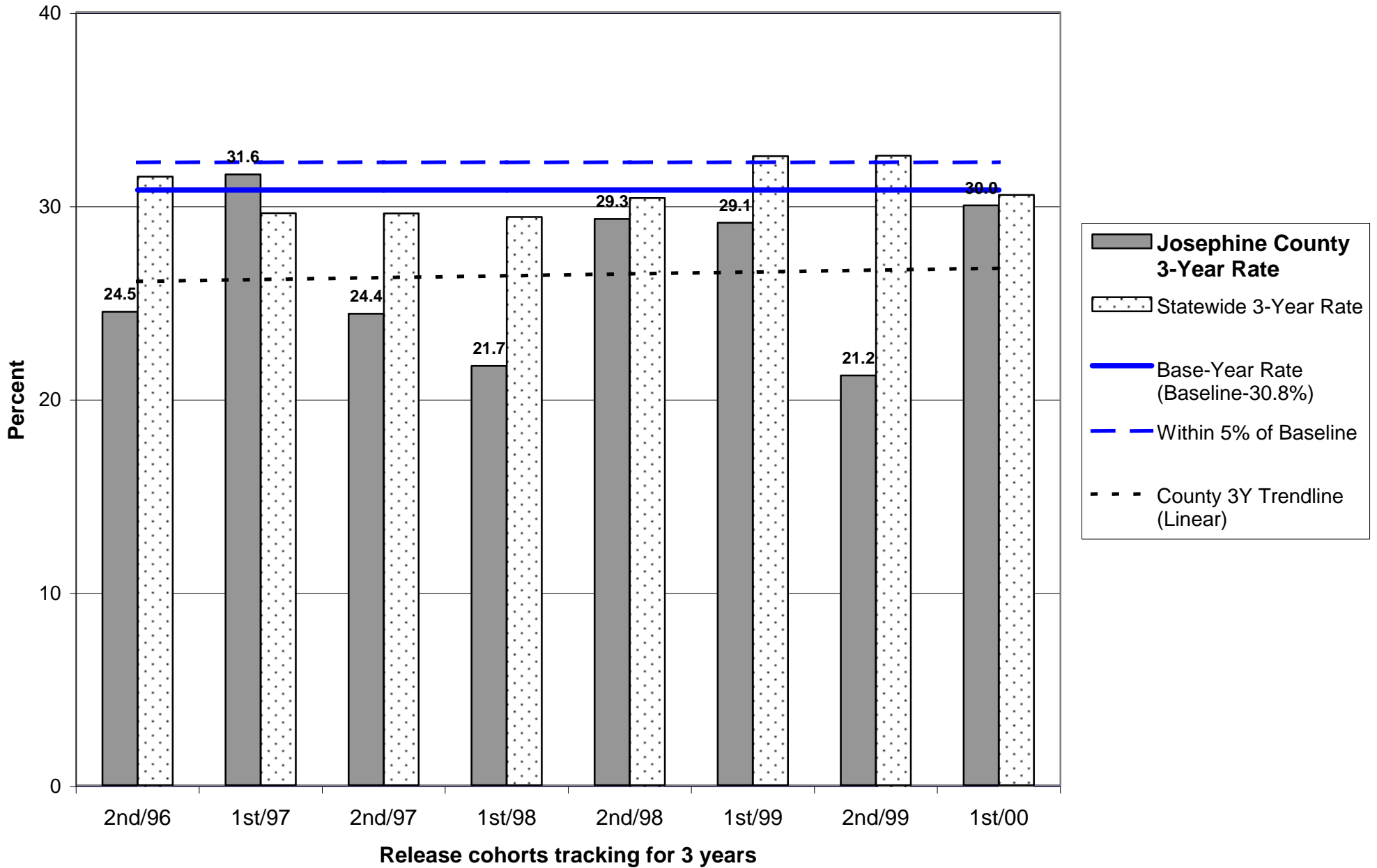


Probation Recidivism Rates - 1st Half 2003

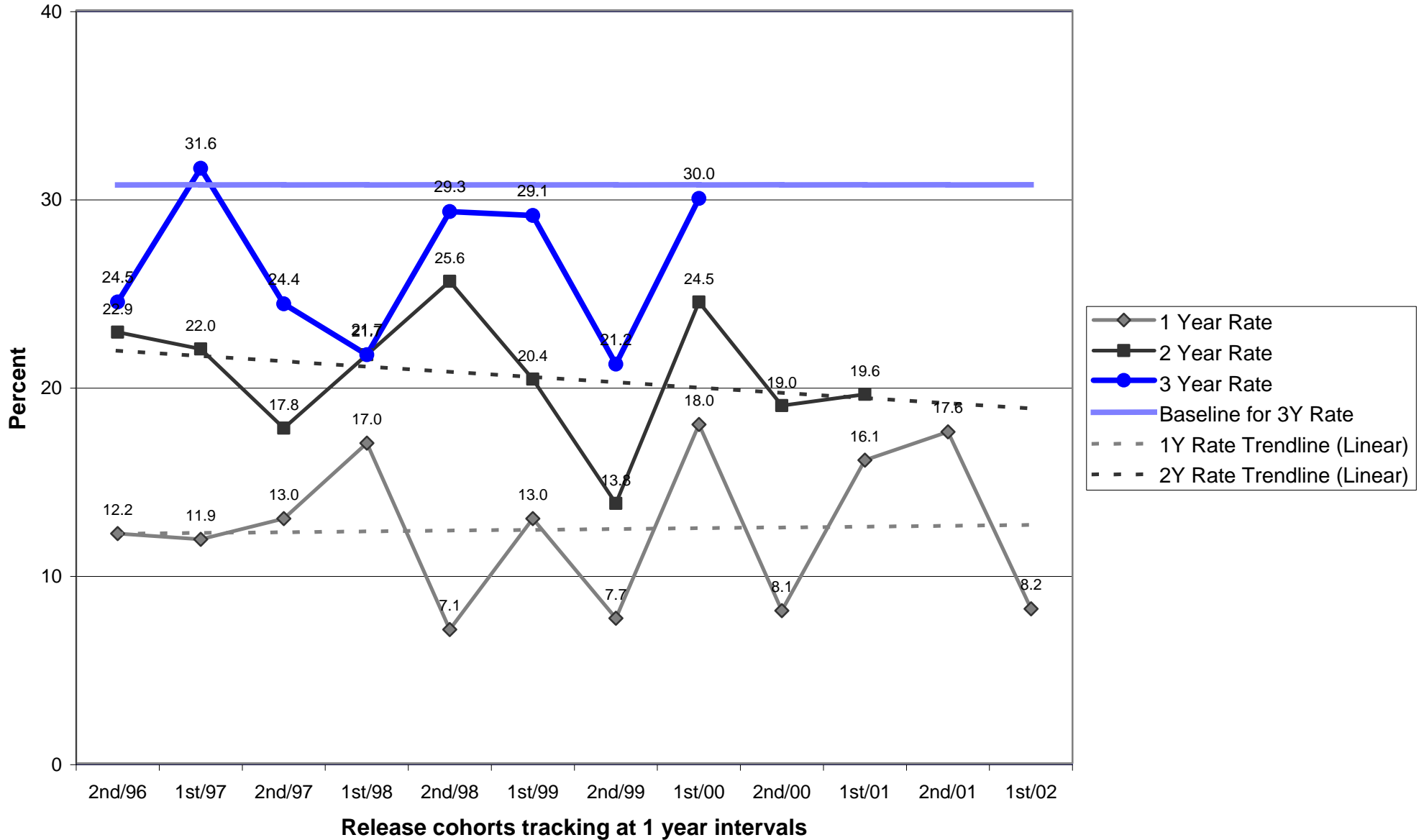


Parole/Post-Prison Supervision Recidivism Rates - 1st Half 2003

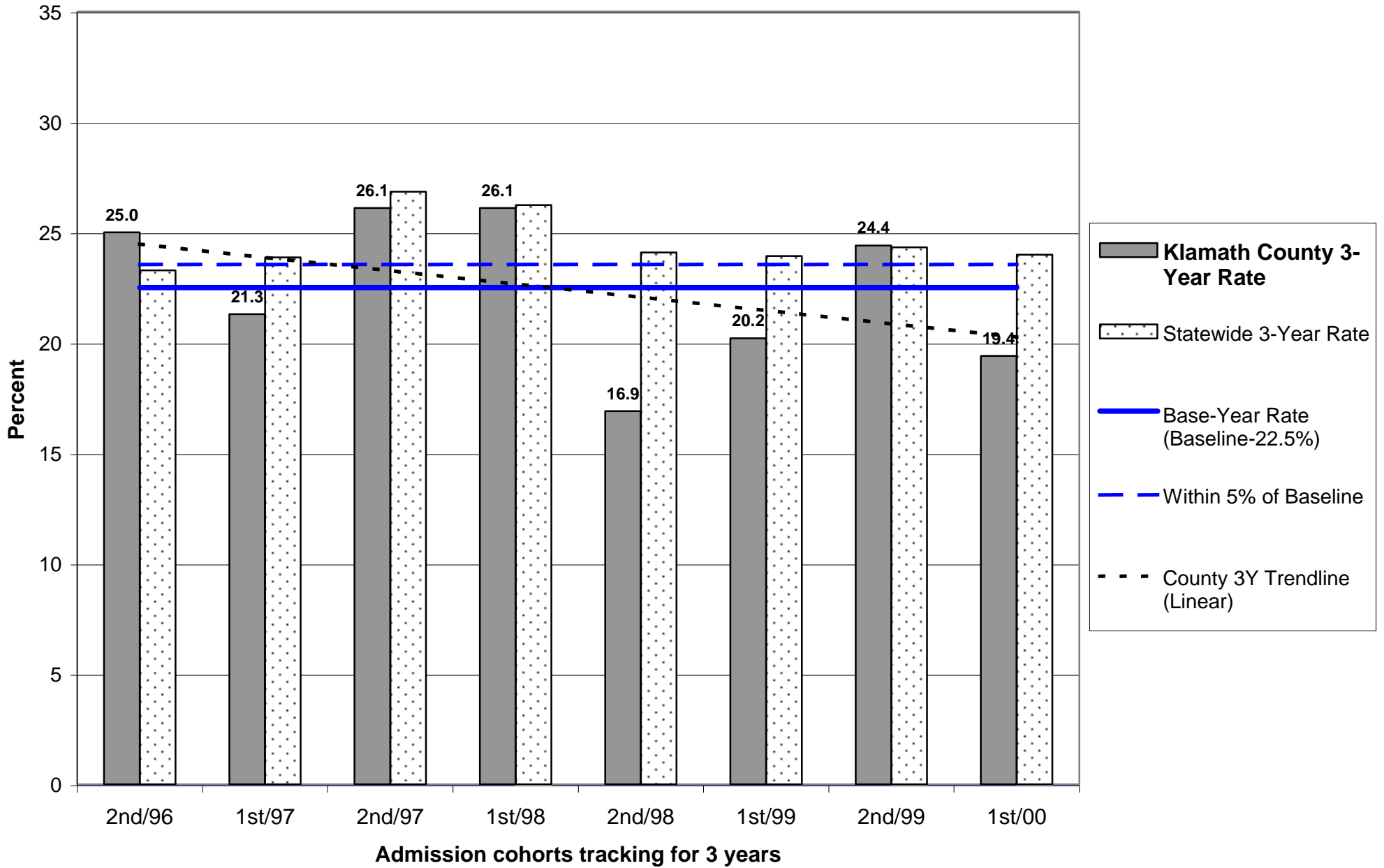

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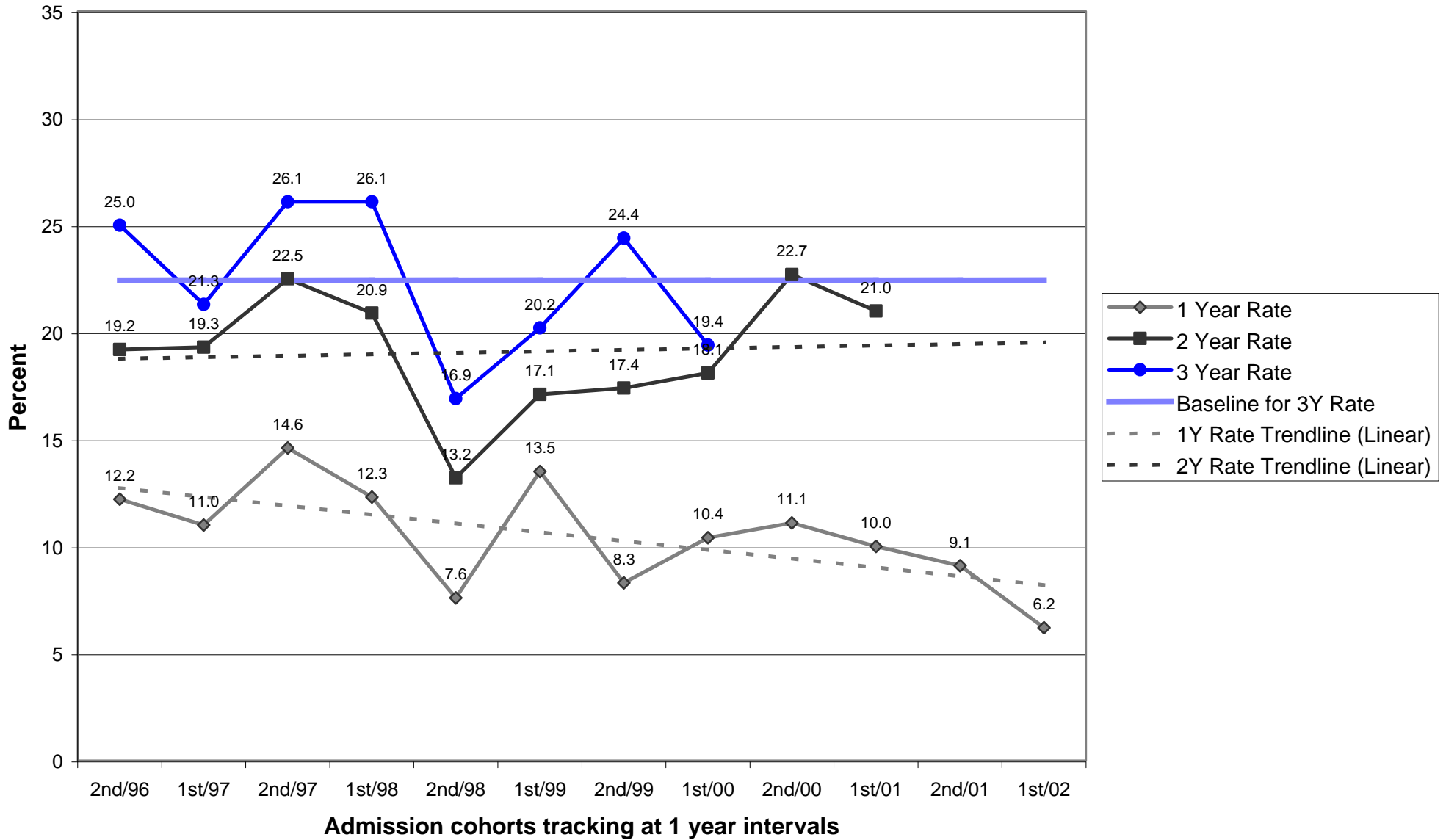
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Probation Recidivism Rates - 1st Half 2003

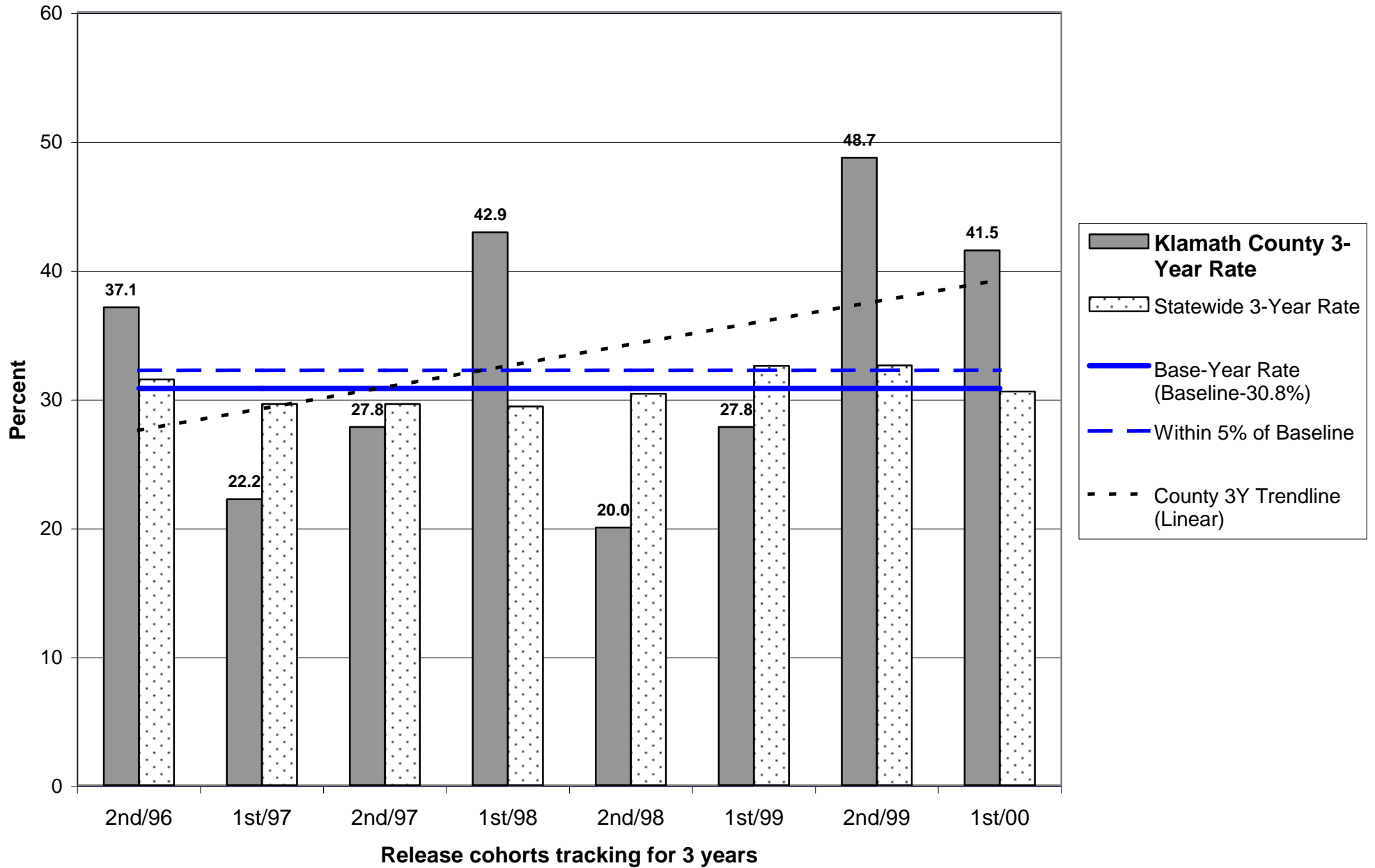


Probation Recidivism Rates - 1st Half 2003

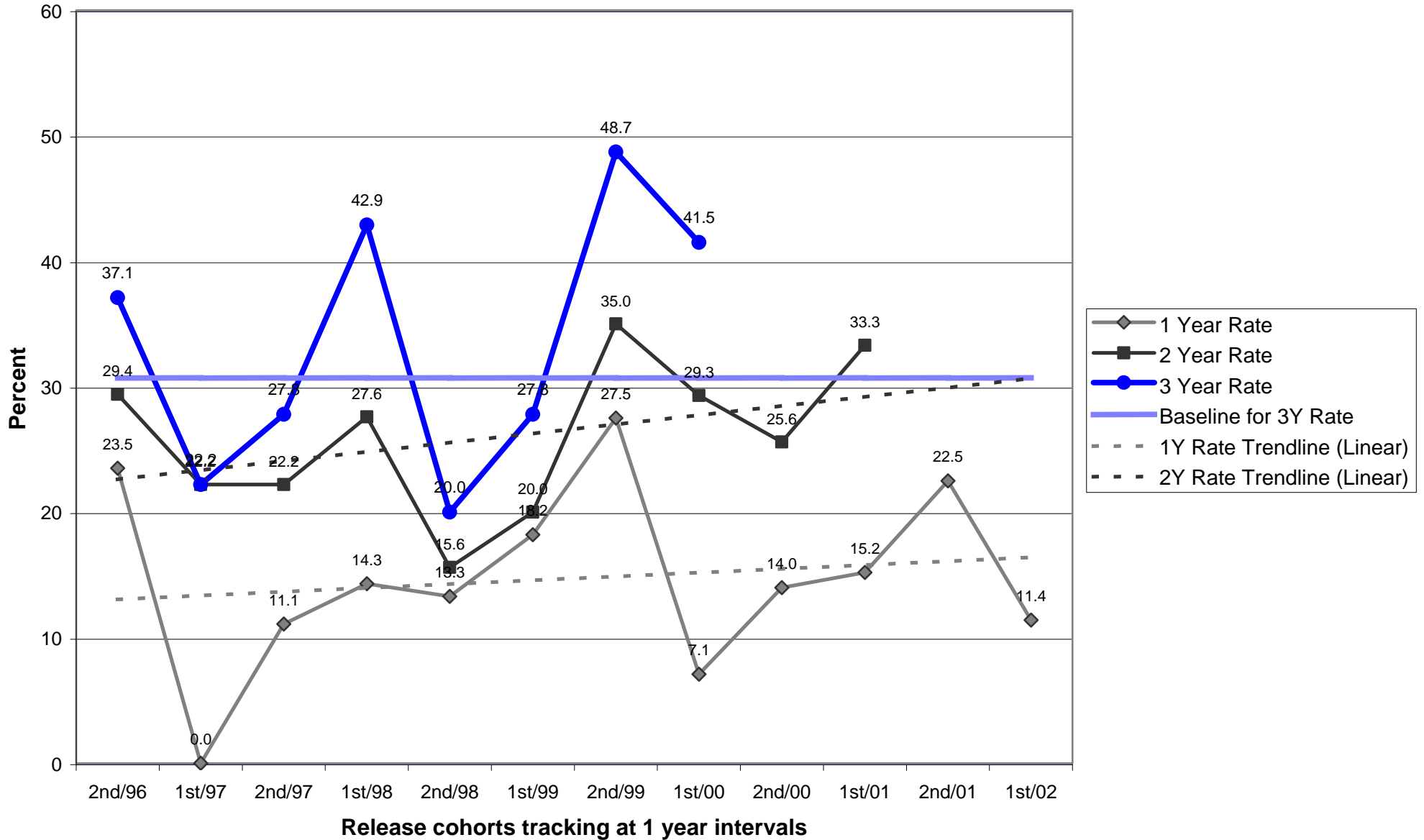


Parole/Post-Prison Supervision Recidivism Rates - 1st Half 2003

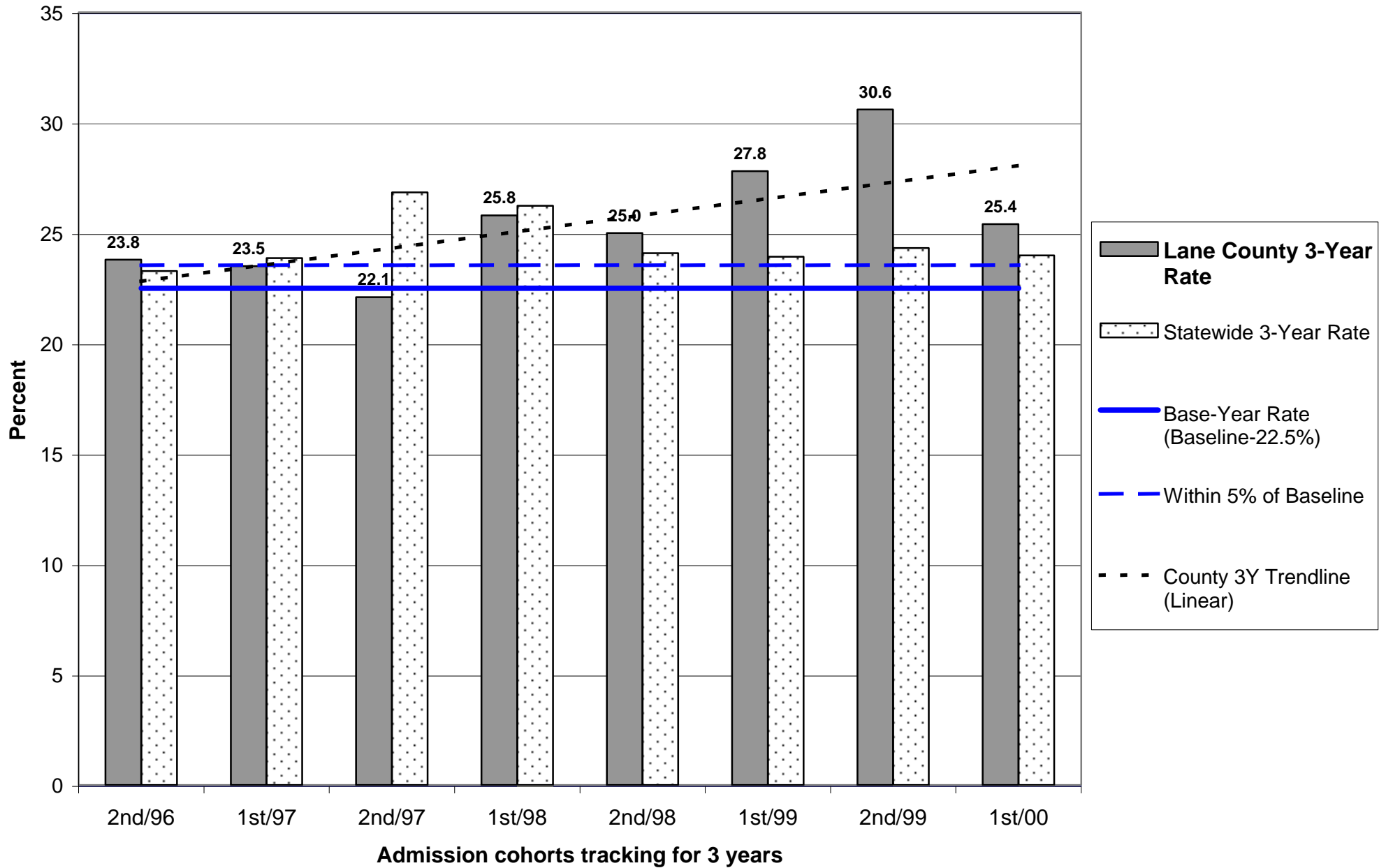
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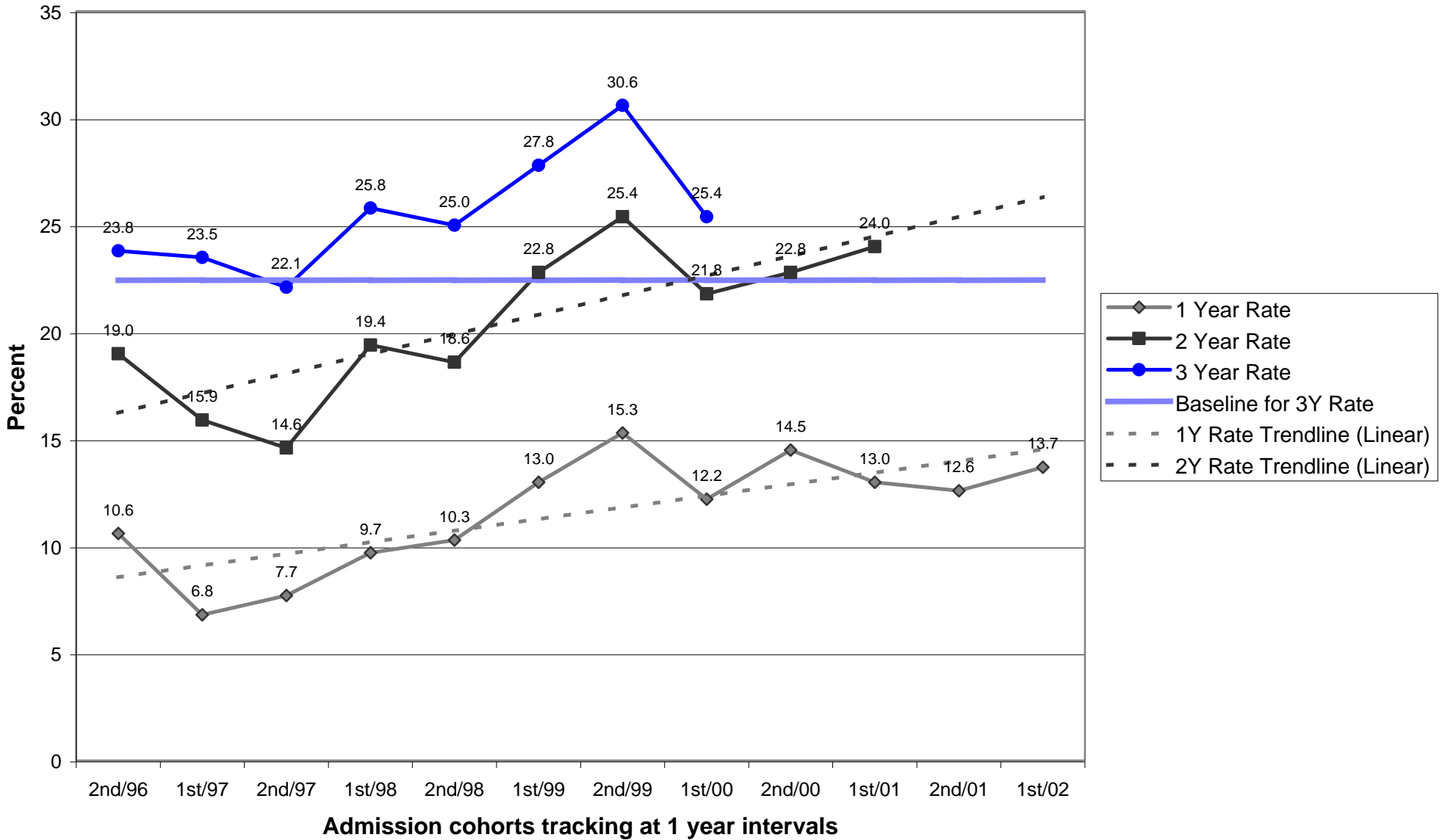

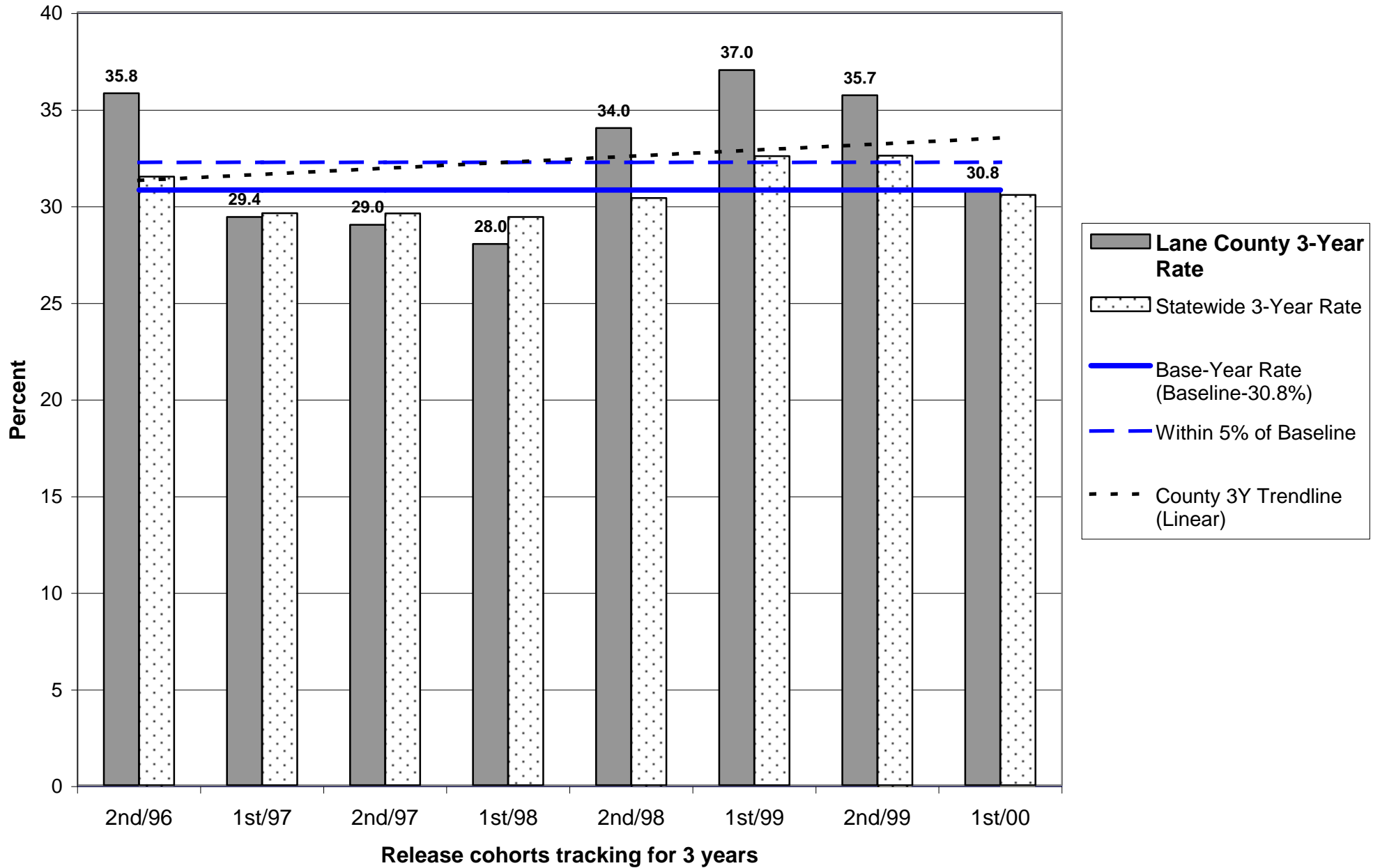


Probation Recidivism Rates - 1st Half 2003

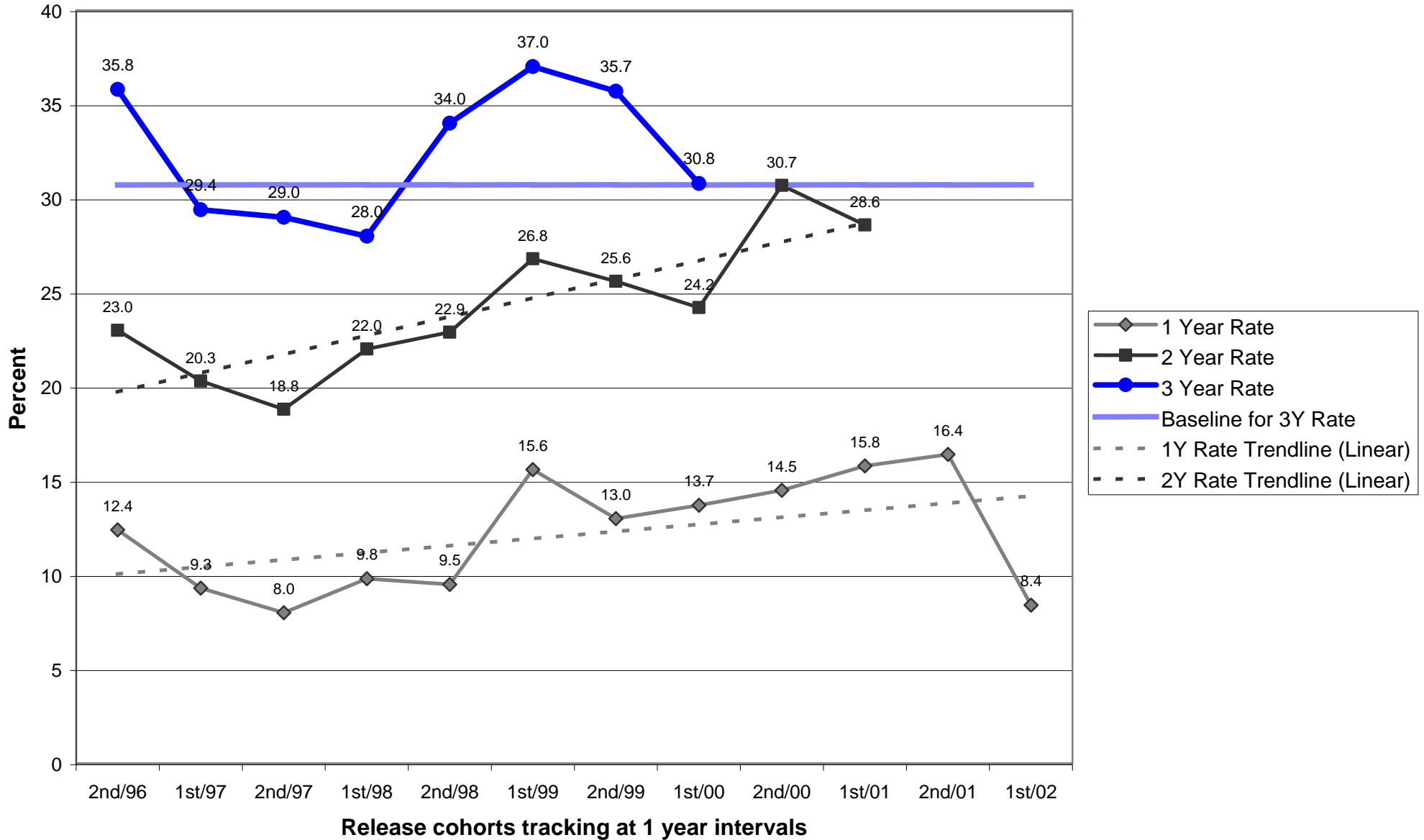


Parole/Post-Prison Supervision Recidivism Rates - 1st Half 2003

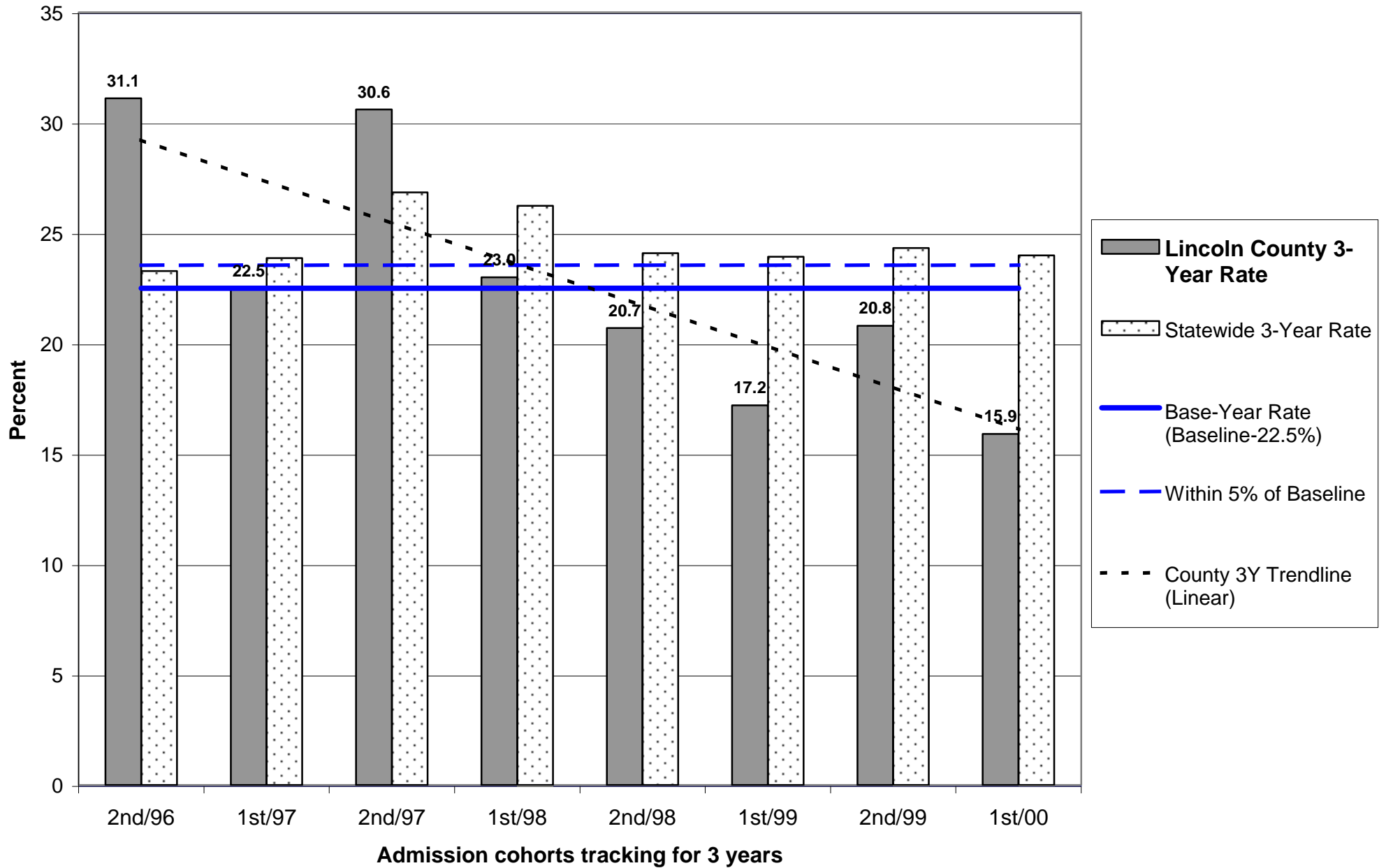
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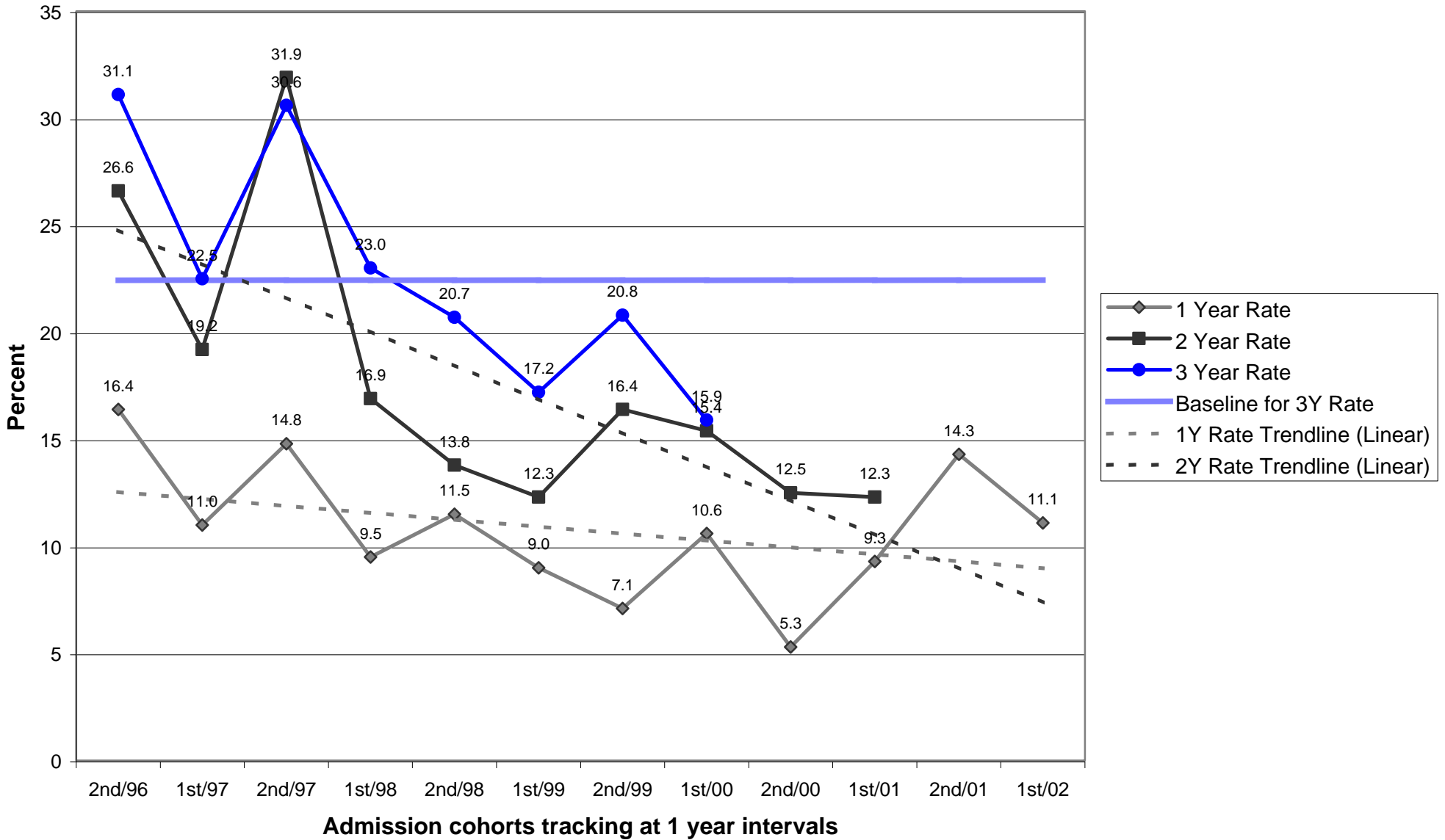
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Probation Recidivism Rates - 1st Half 2003

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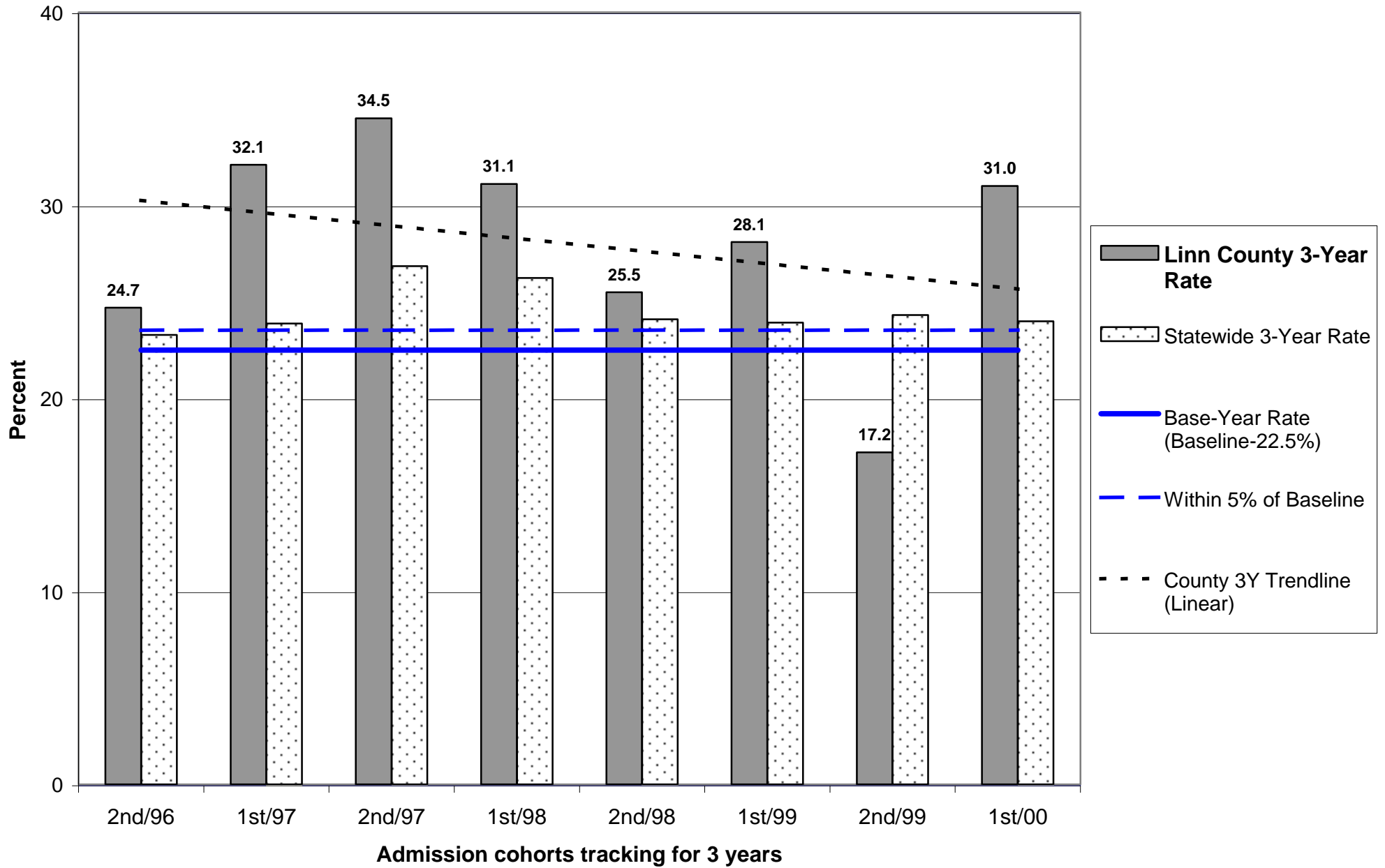
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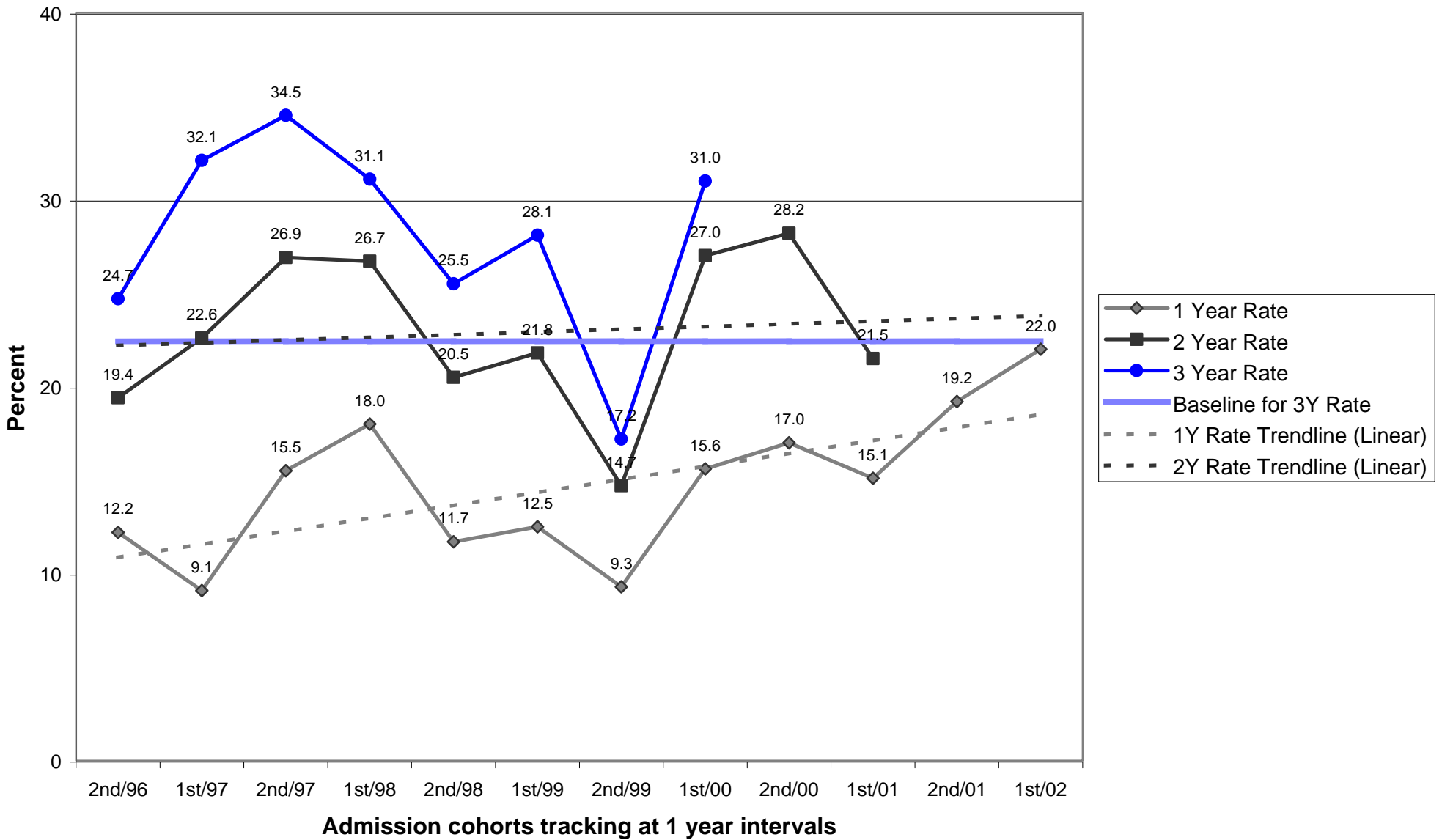

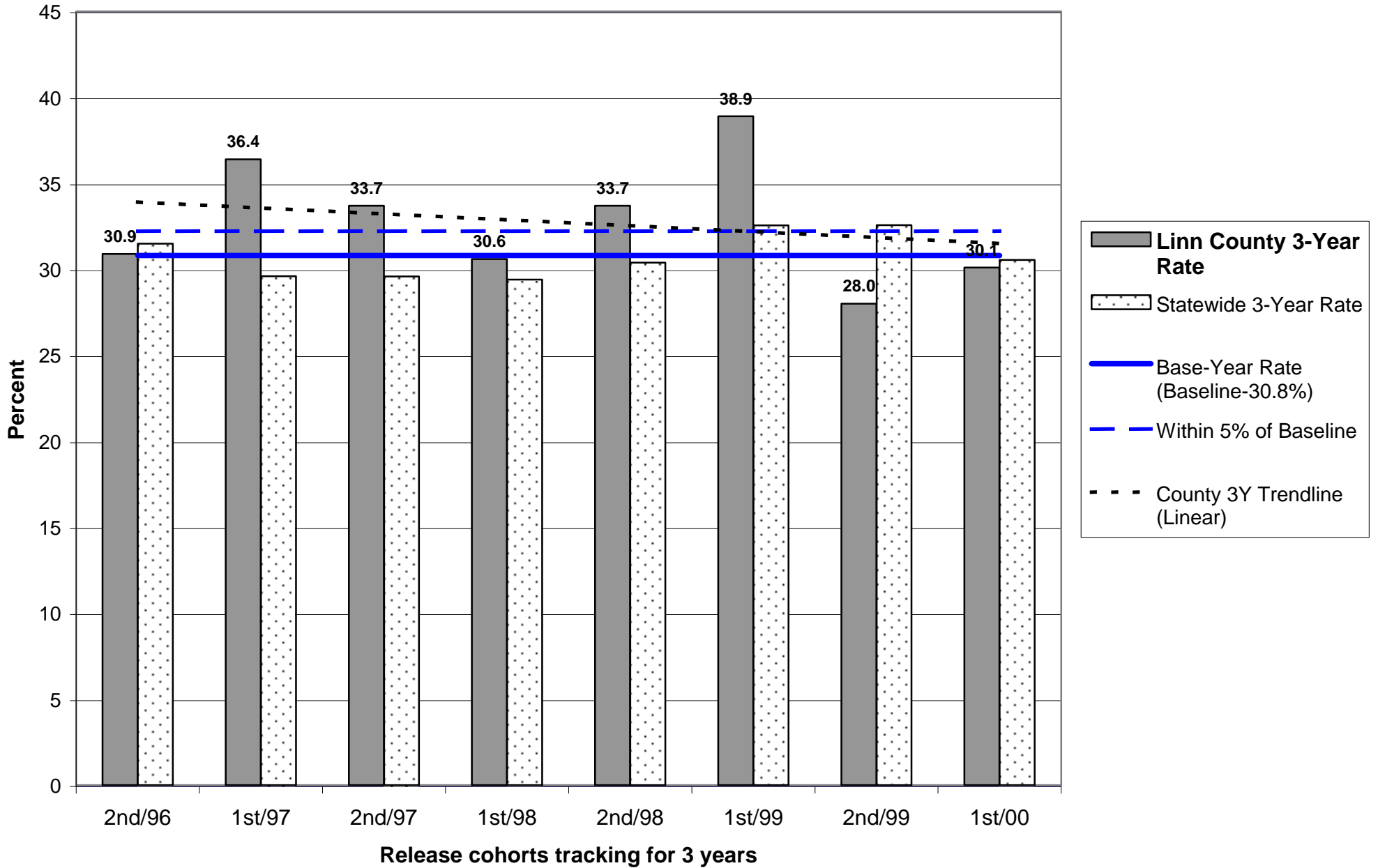


Probation Recidivism Rates - 1st Half 2003

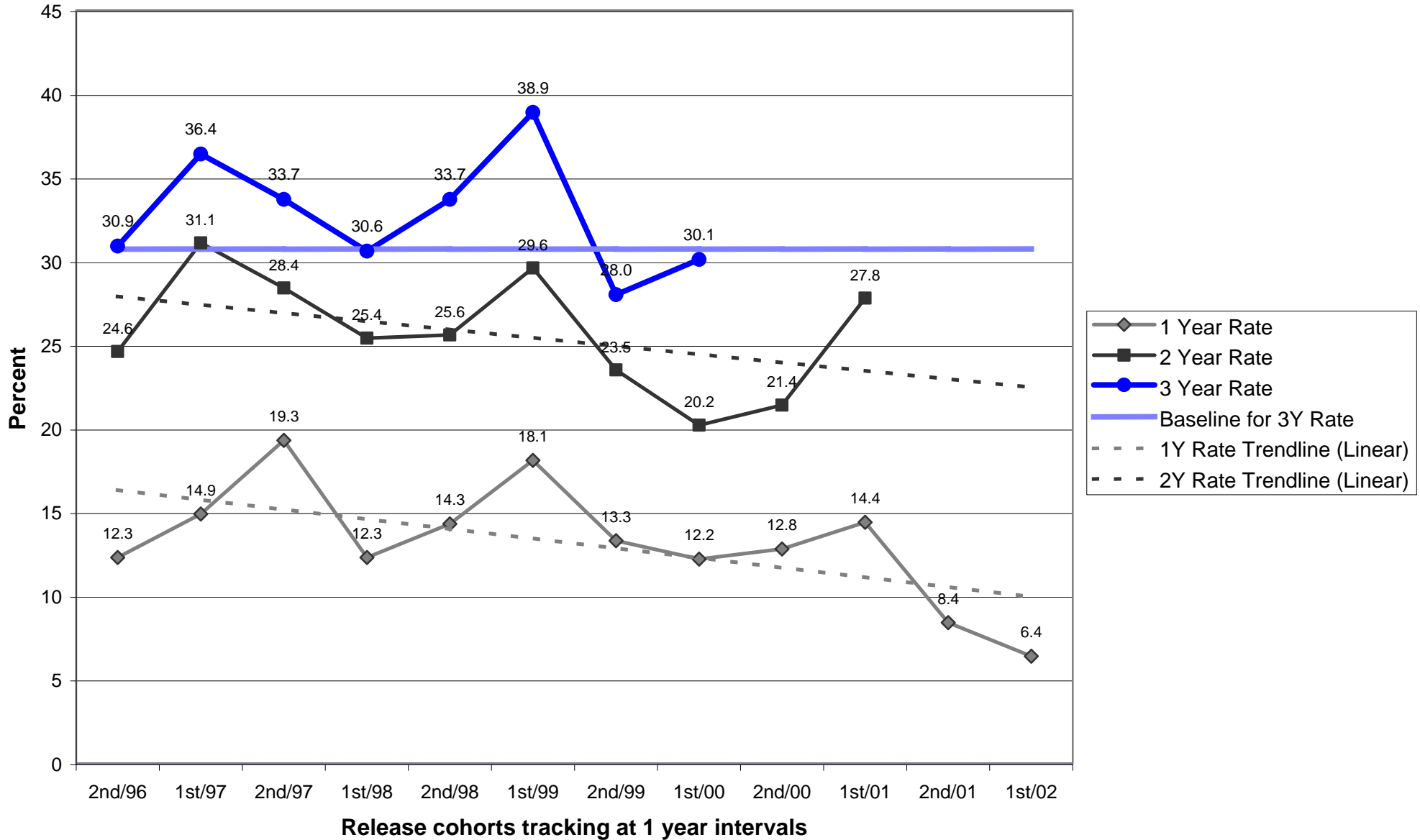


Parole/Post-Prison Supervision Recidivism Rates - 1st Half 2003

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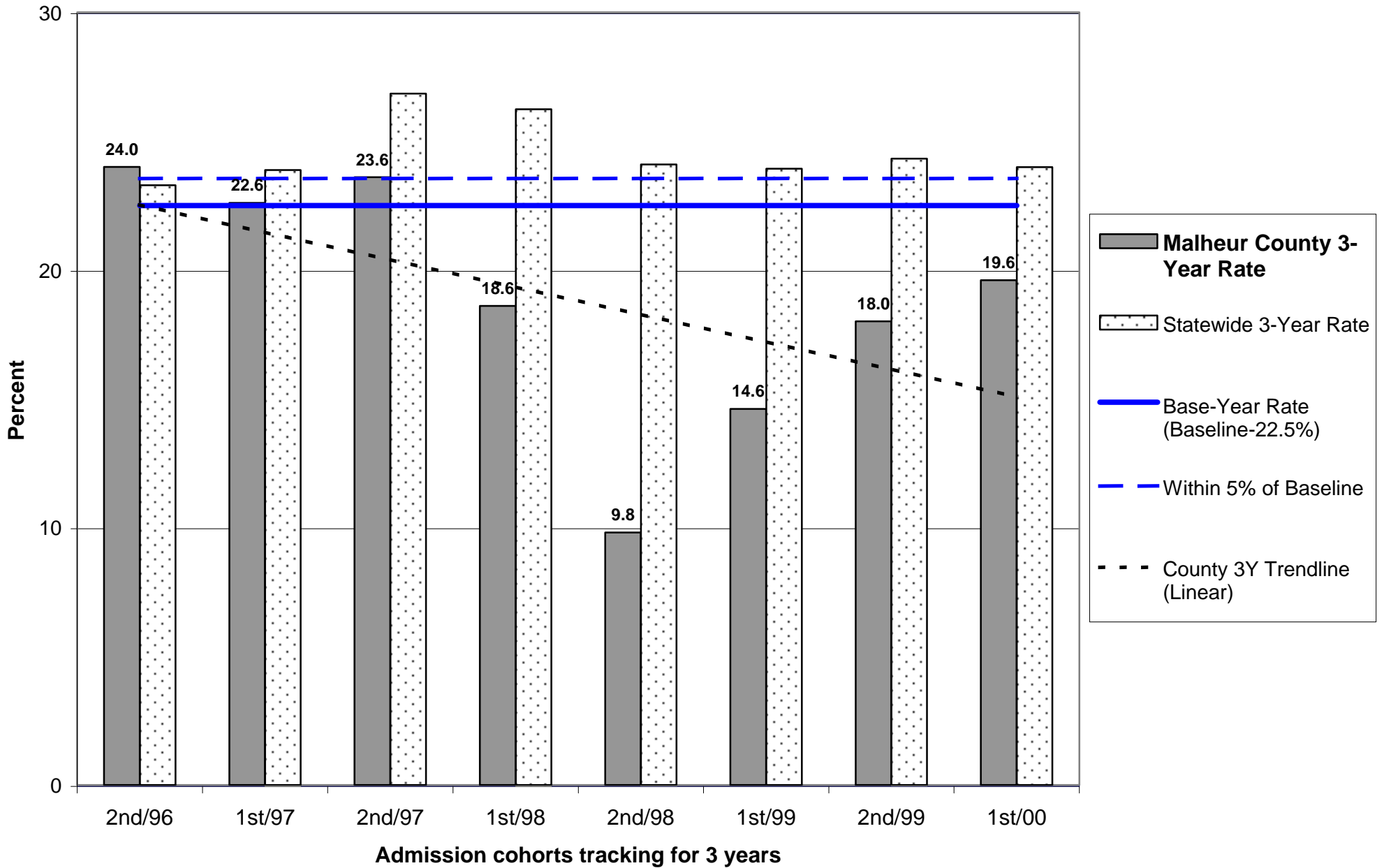
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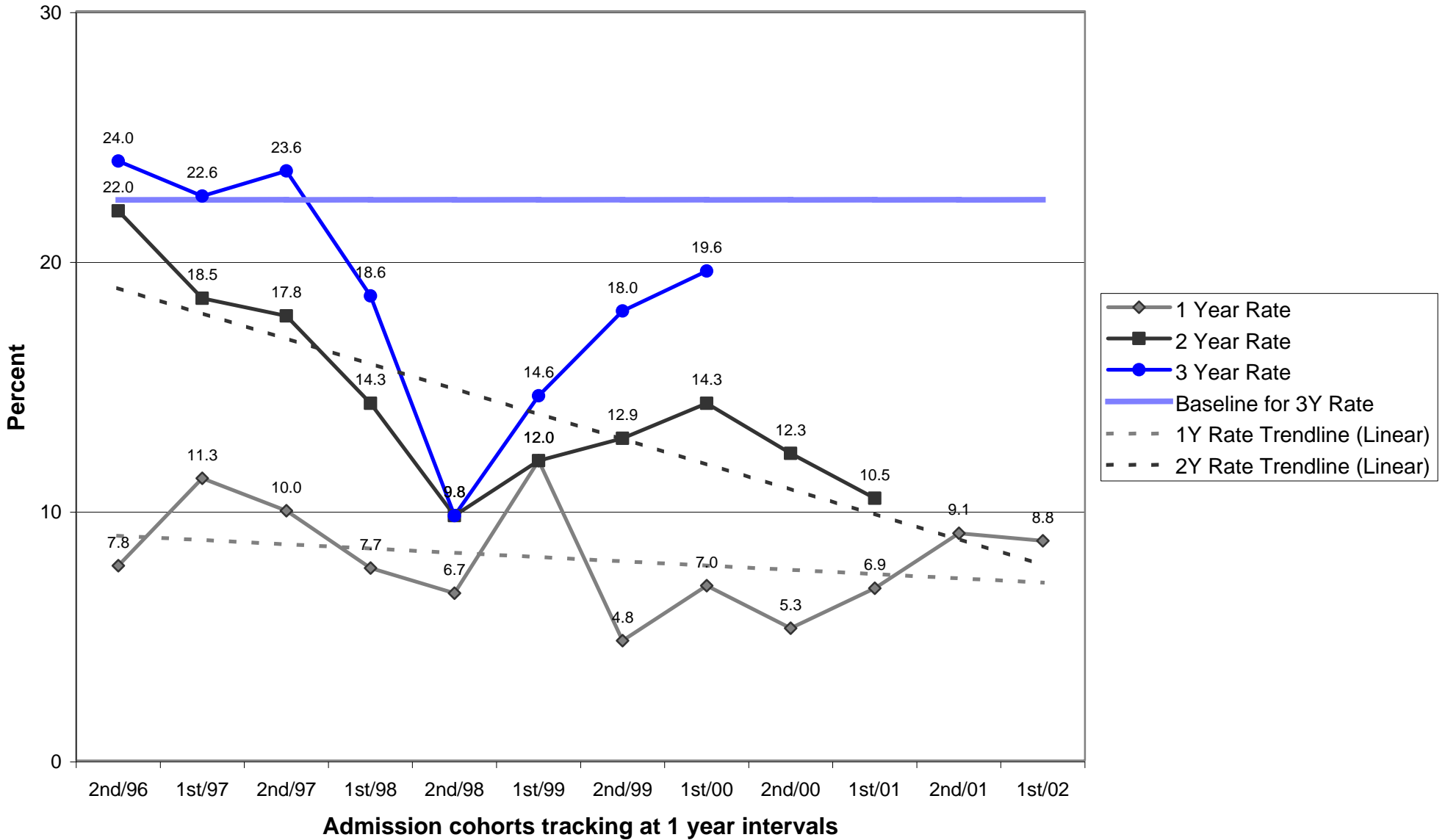

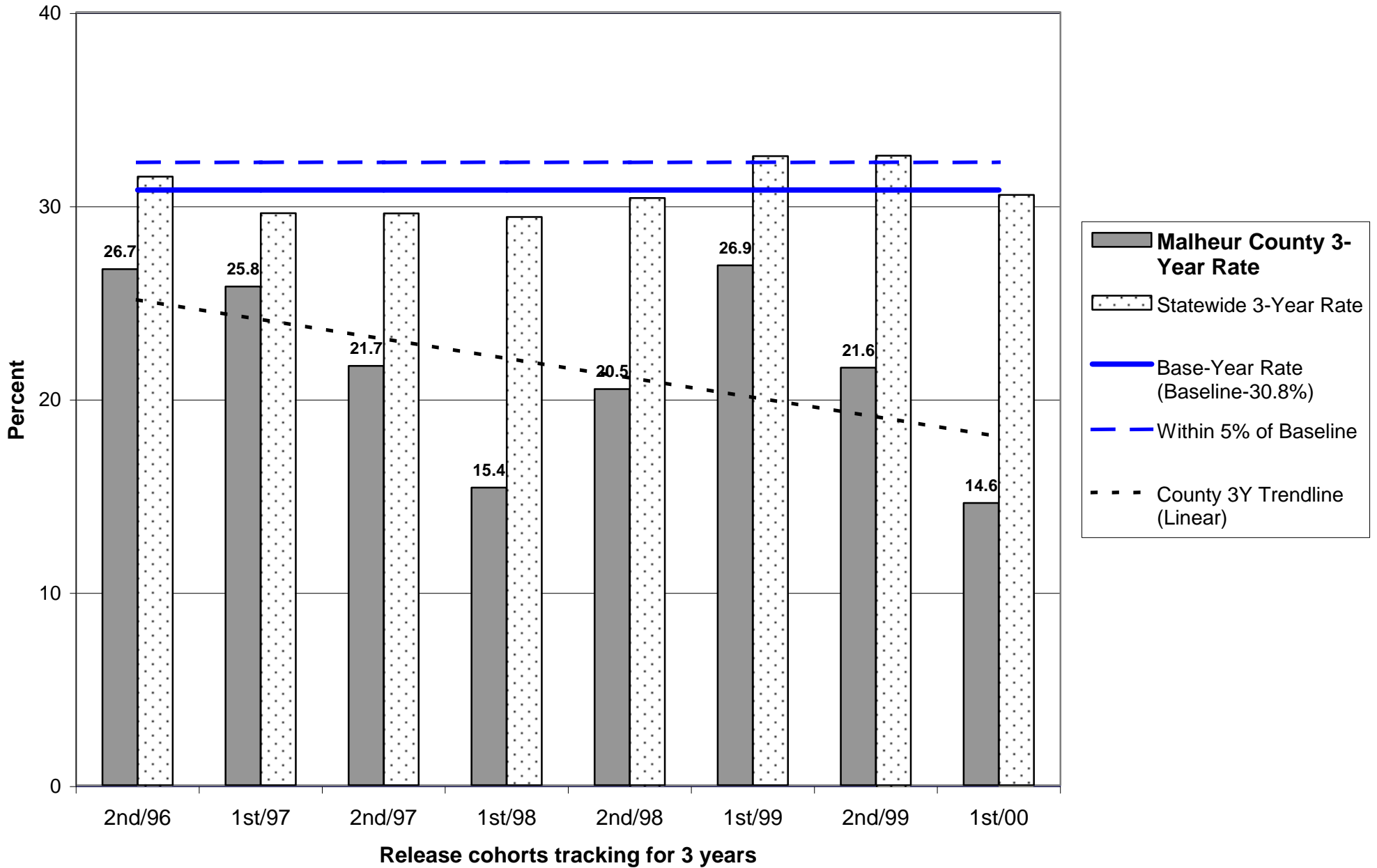


Probation Recidivism Rates - 1st Half 2003

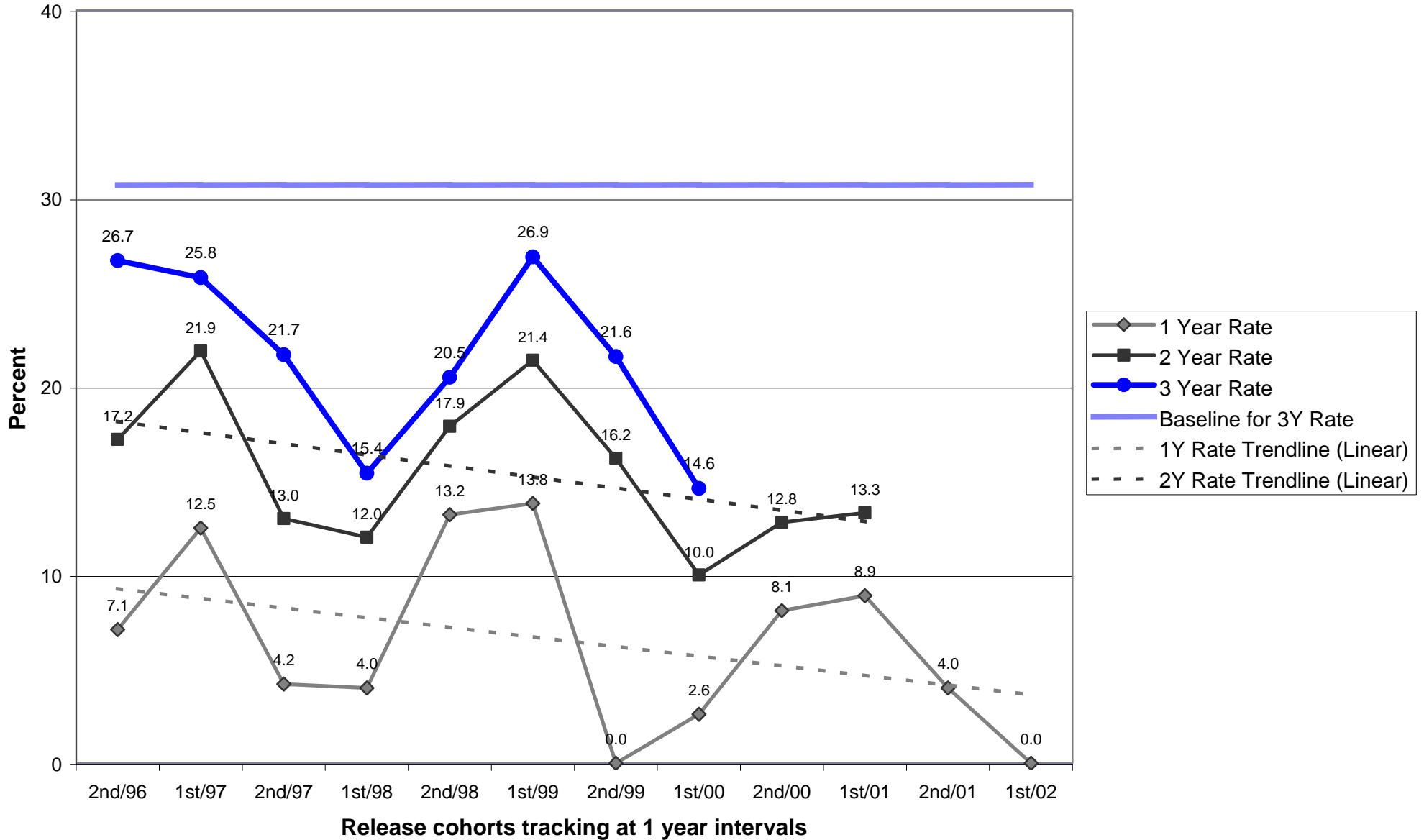


Parole/Post-Prison Supervision Recidivism Rates - 1st Half 2003

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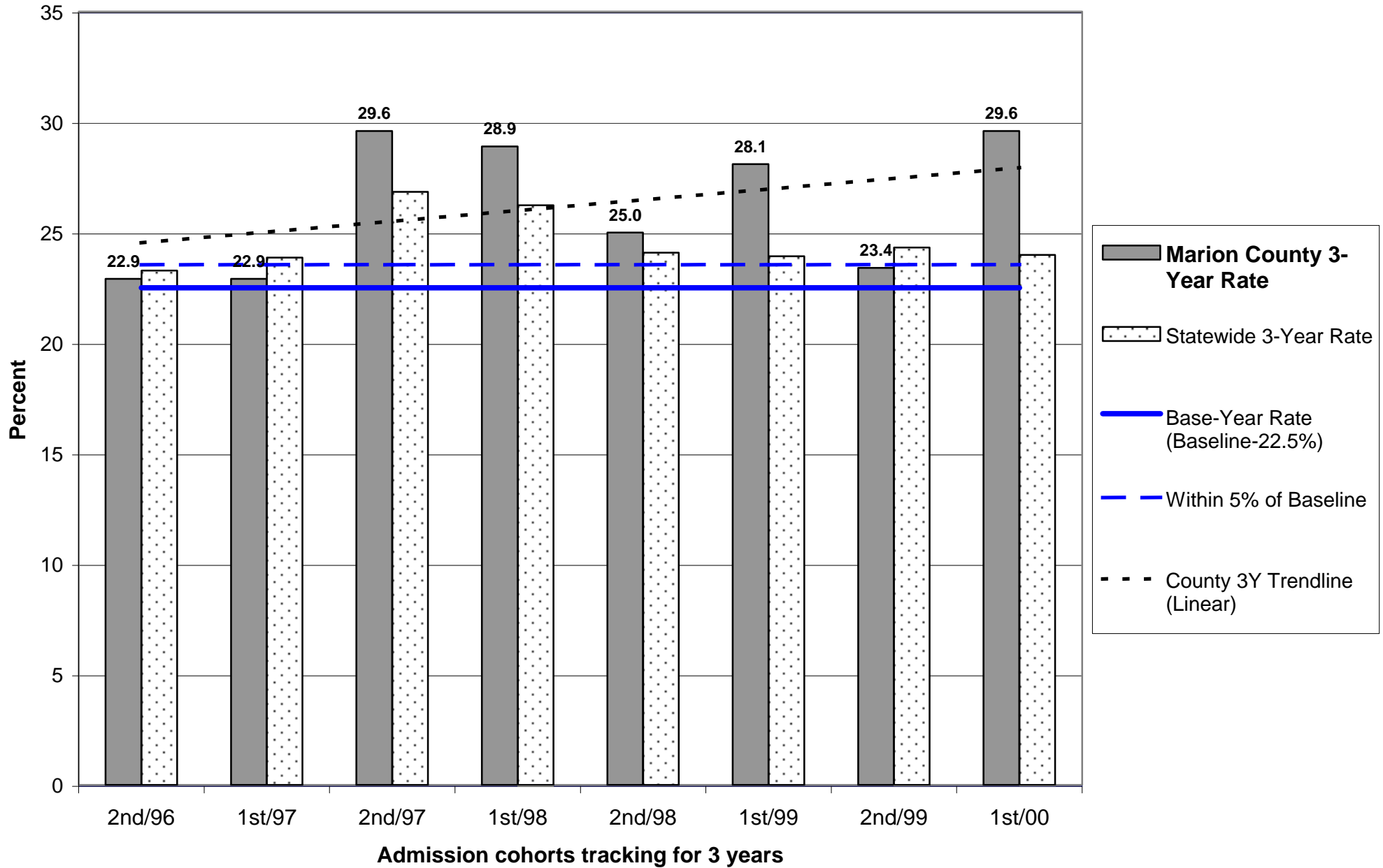
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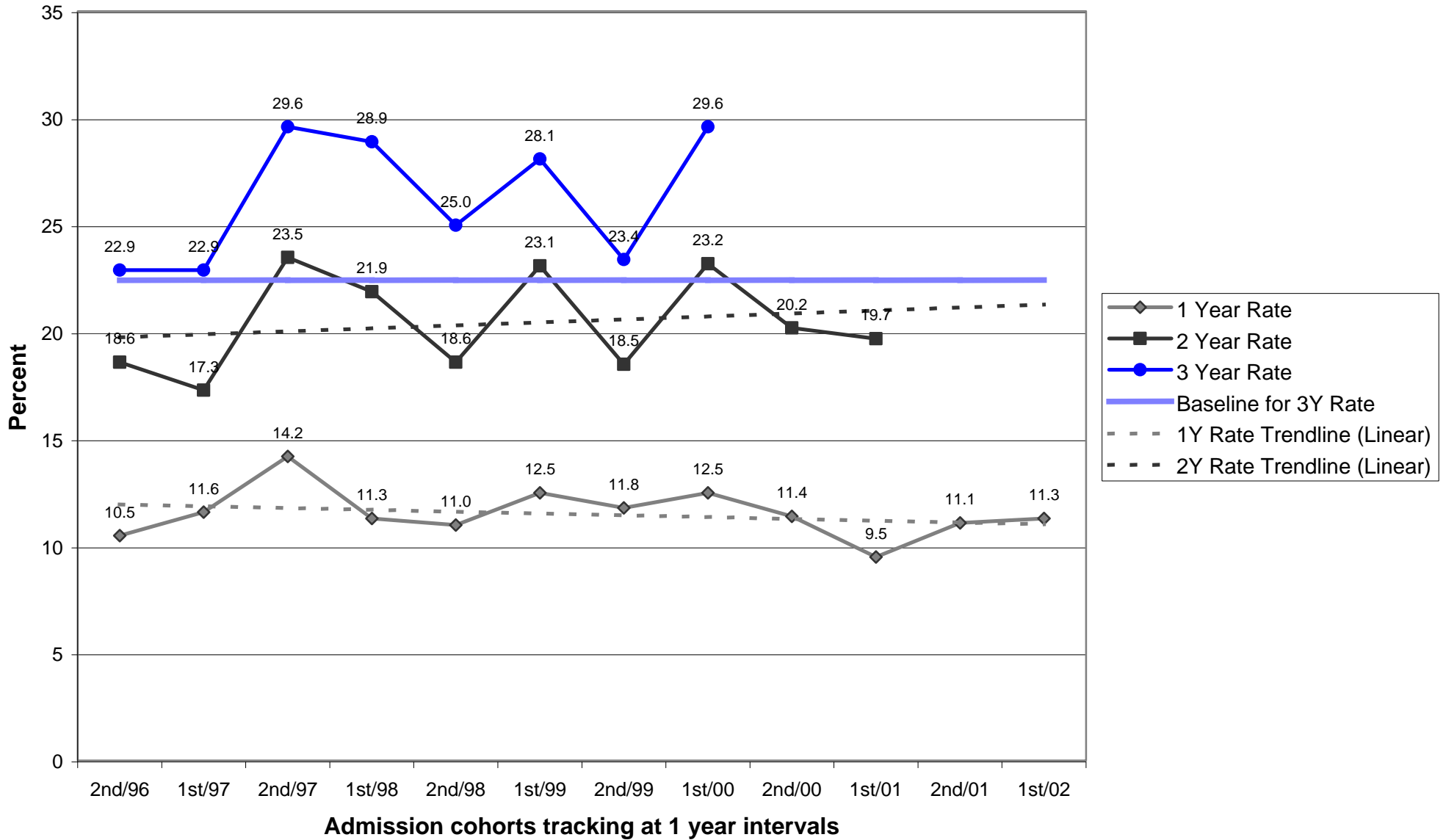

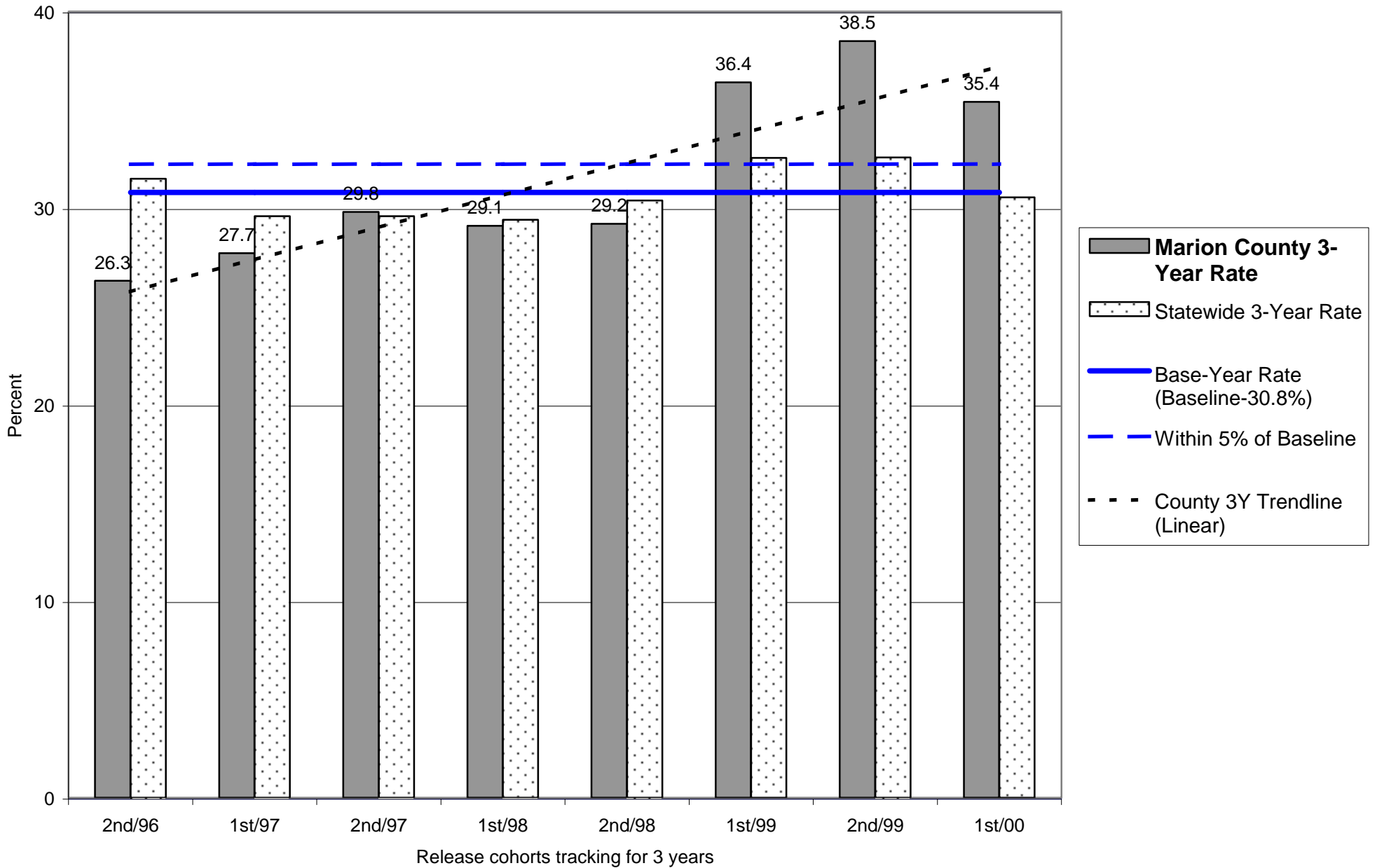


Probation Recidivism Rates - 1st Half 2003

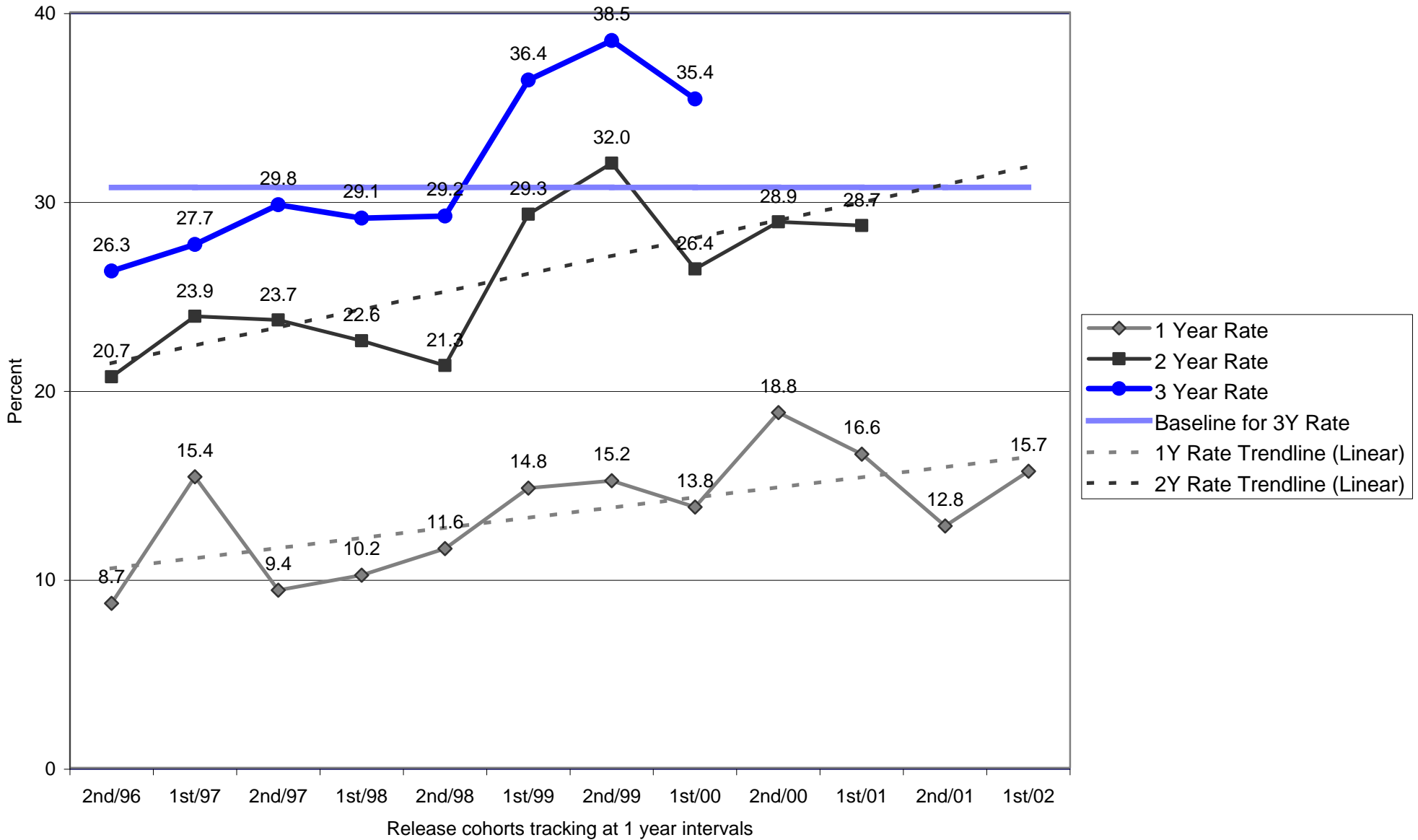


Parole/Post-Prison Supervision Recidivism Rates - 1st Half 2003

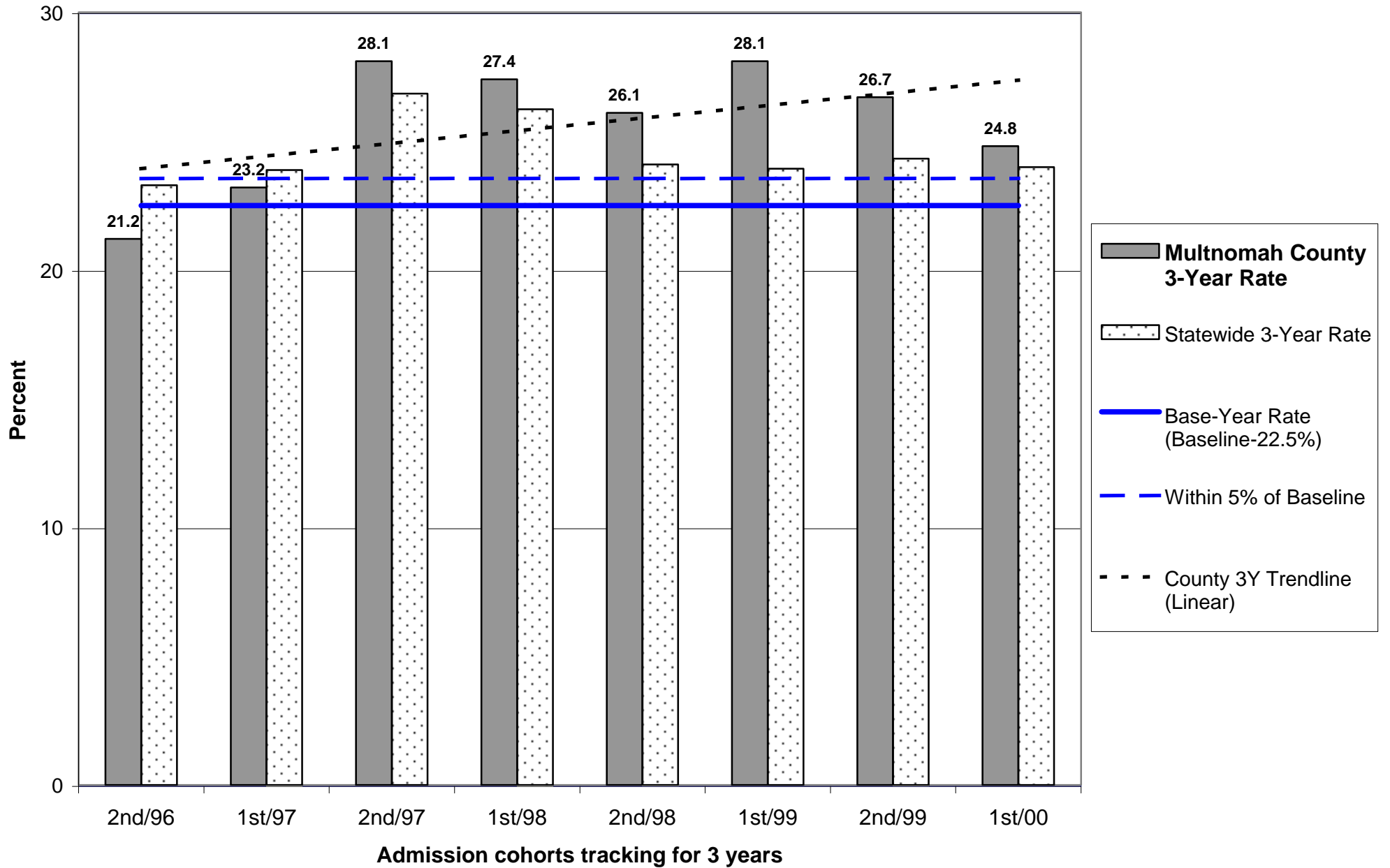

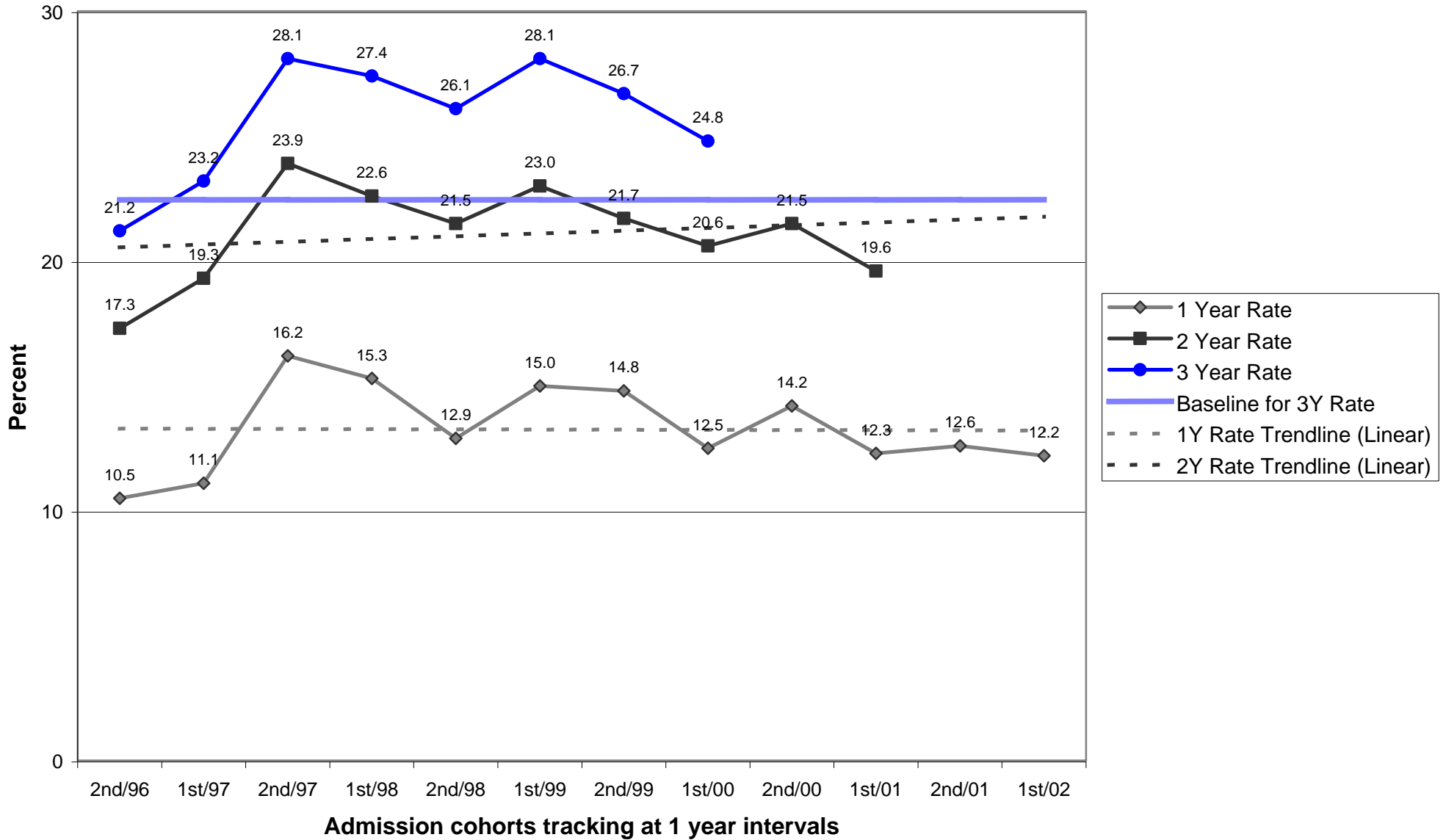

Probation Recidivism Rates - 1st Half 2003

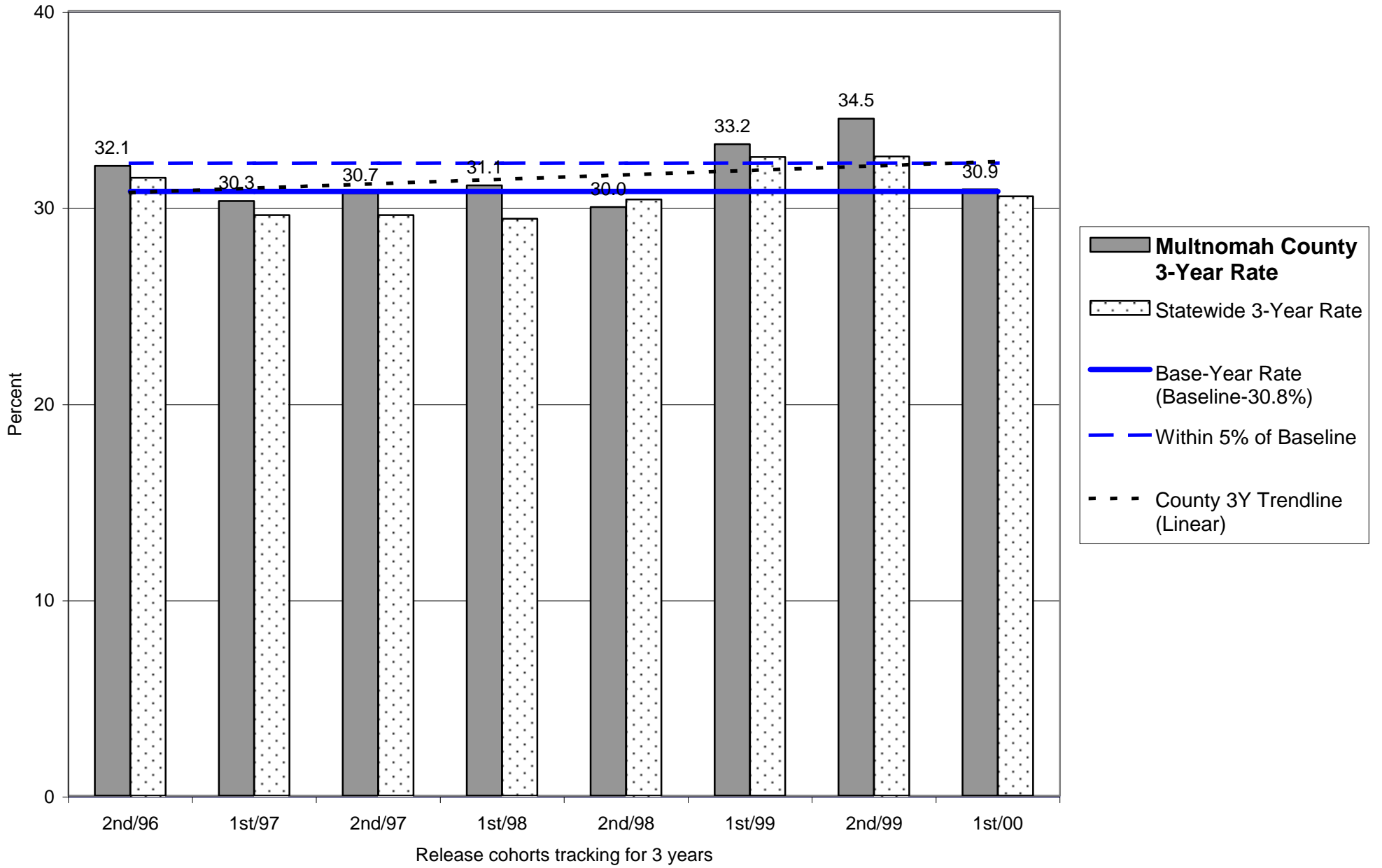


Probation Recidivism Rates - 1st Half 2003

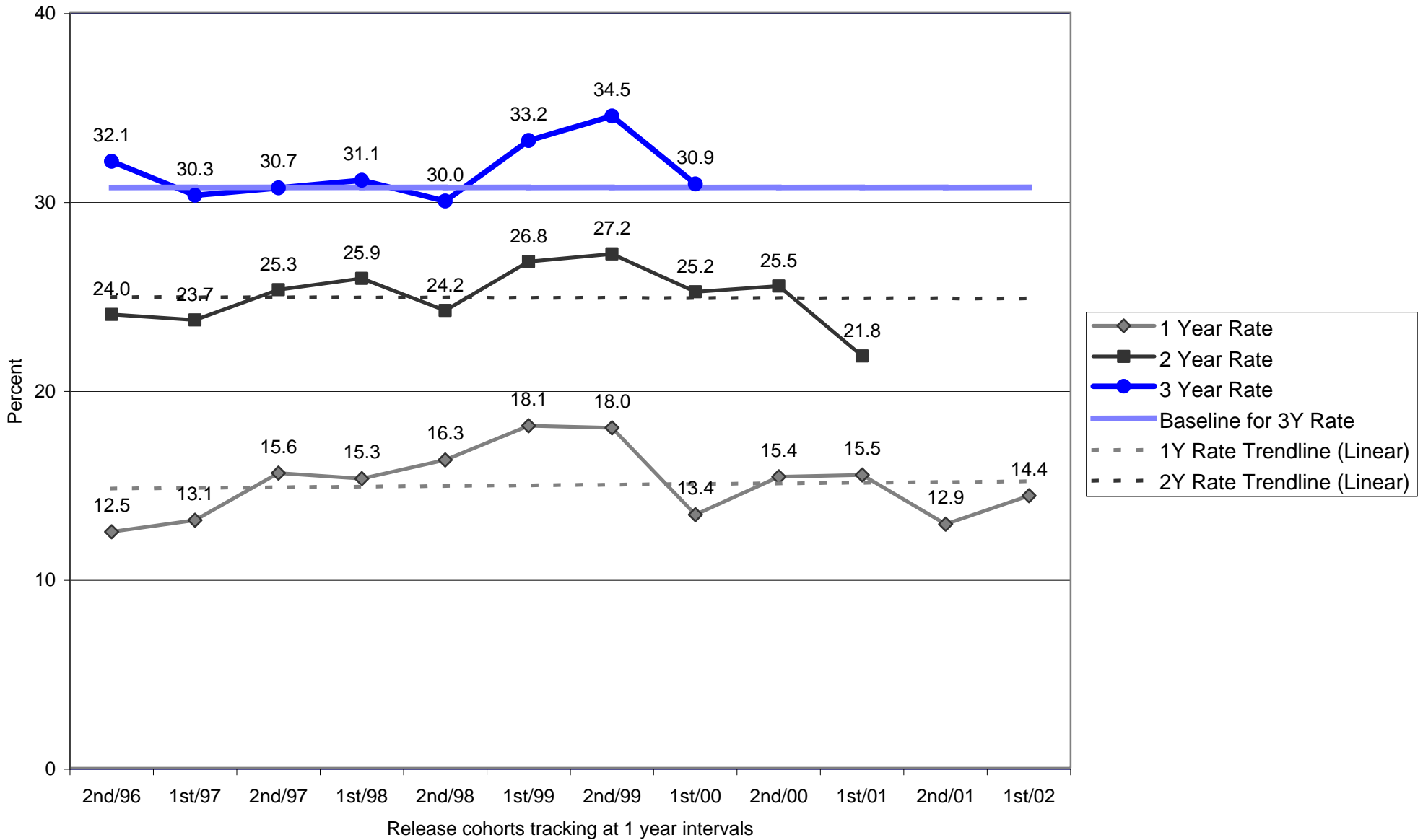


Parole/Post-Prison Supervision Recidivism Rates - 1st Half 2003

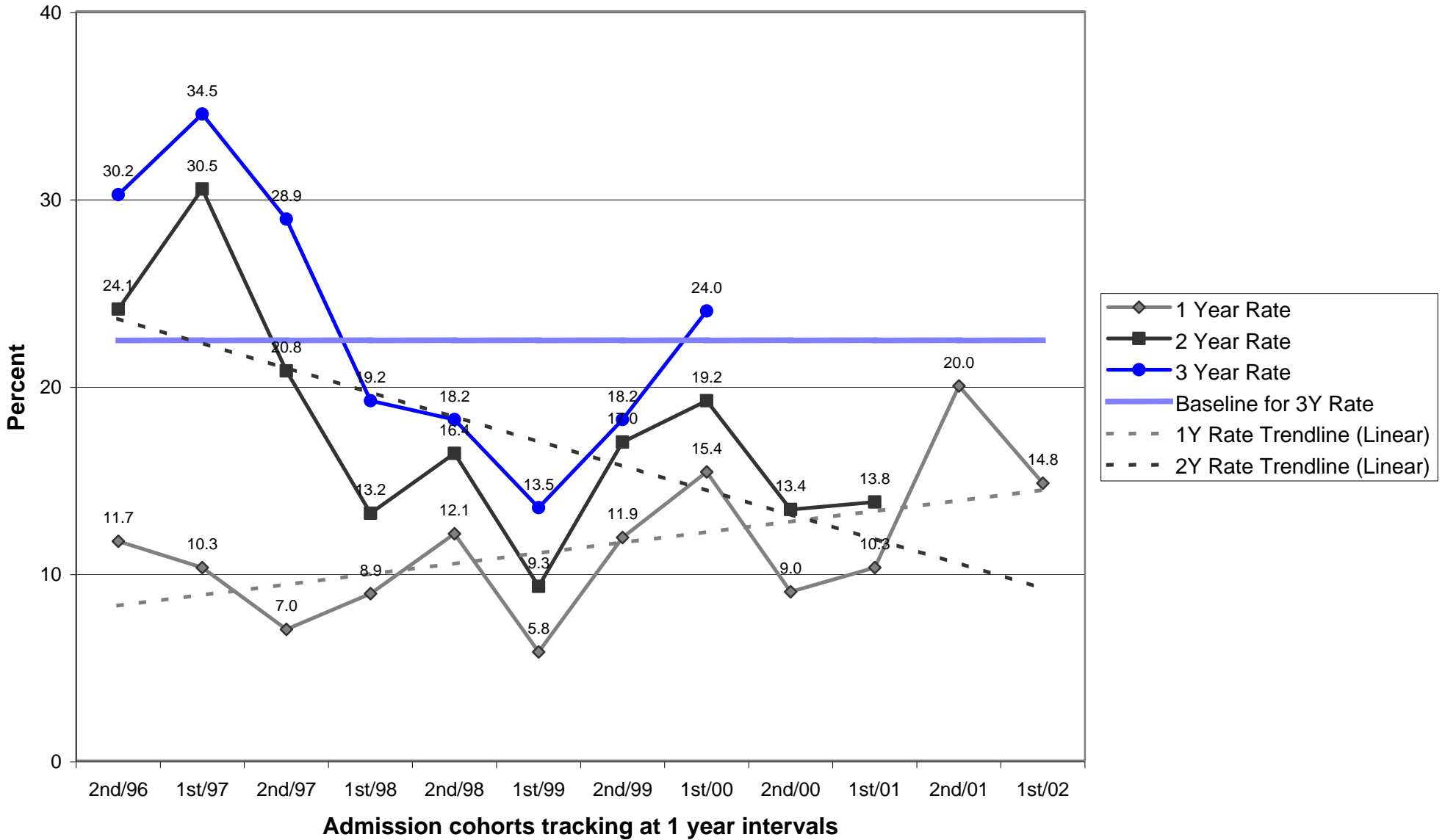

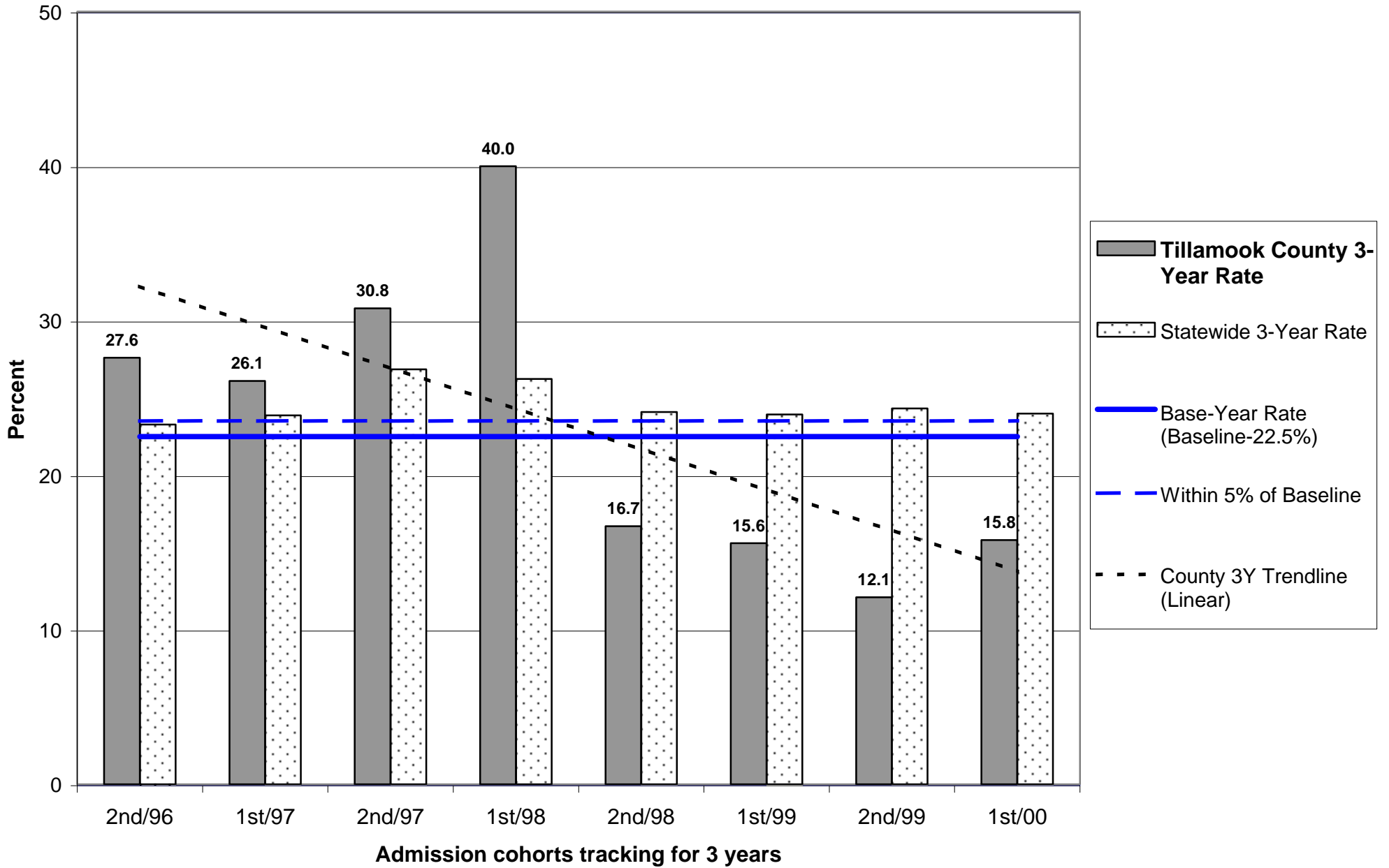

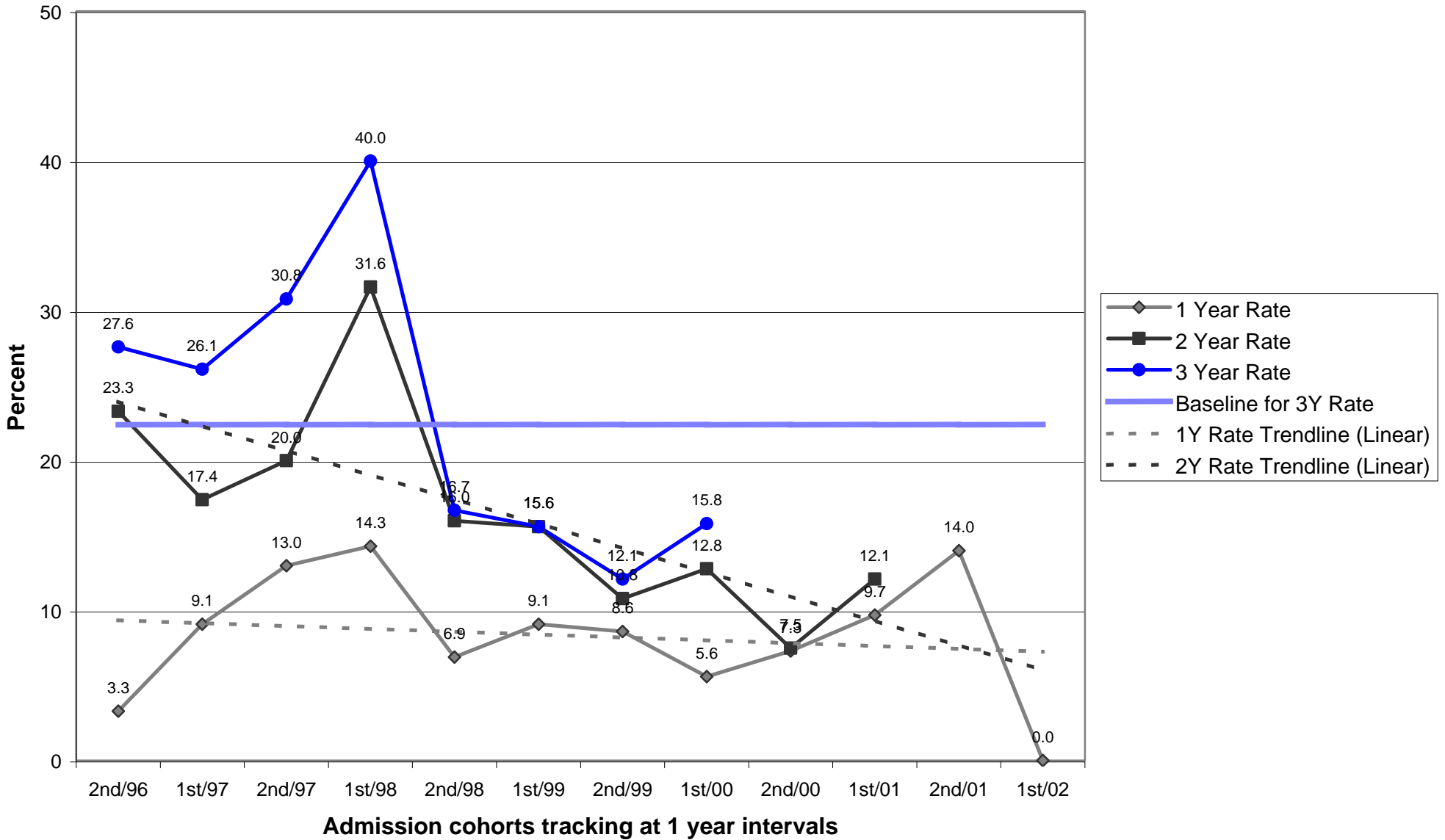

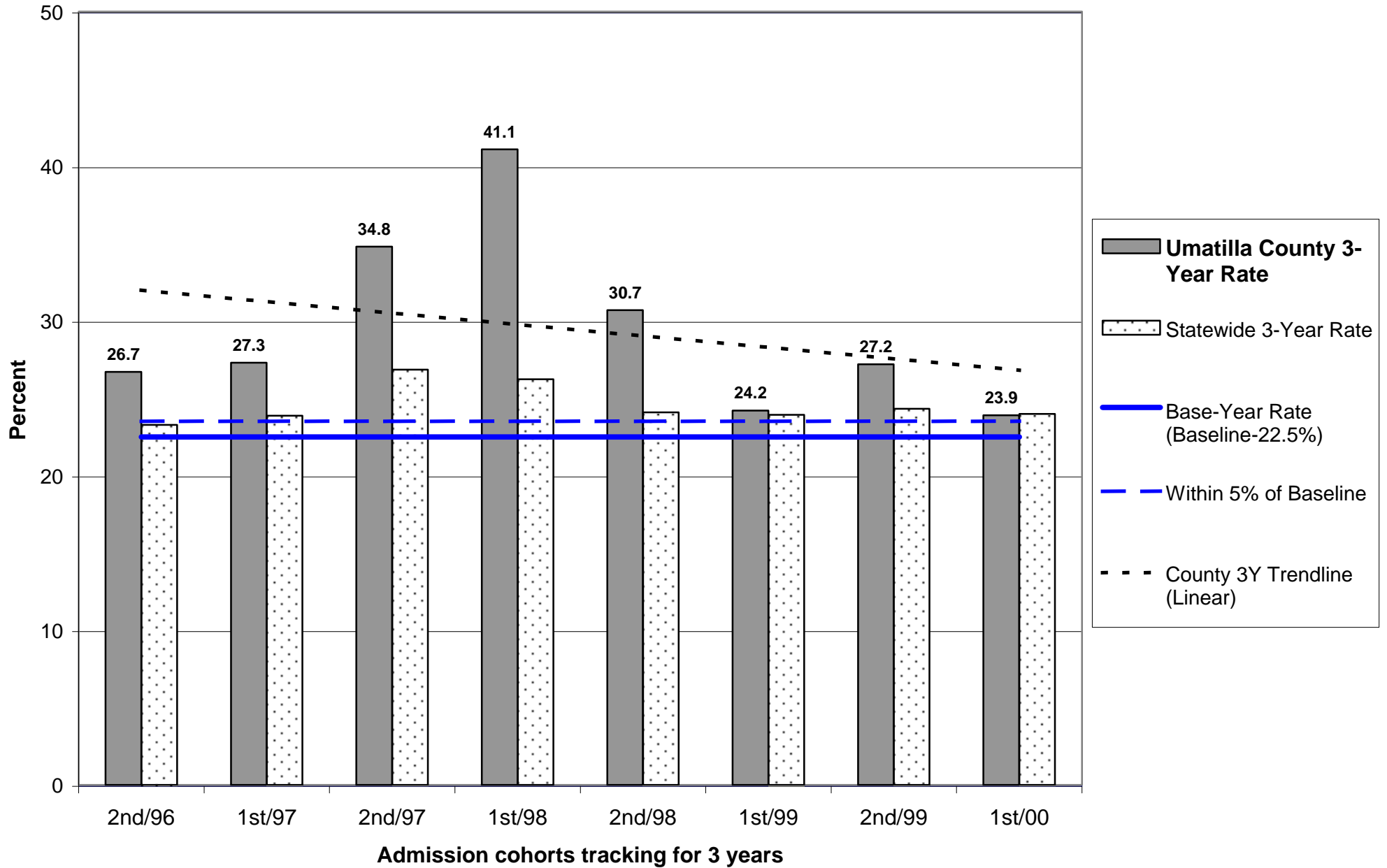

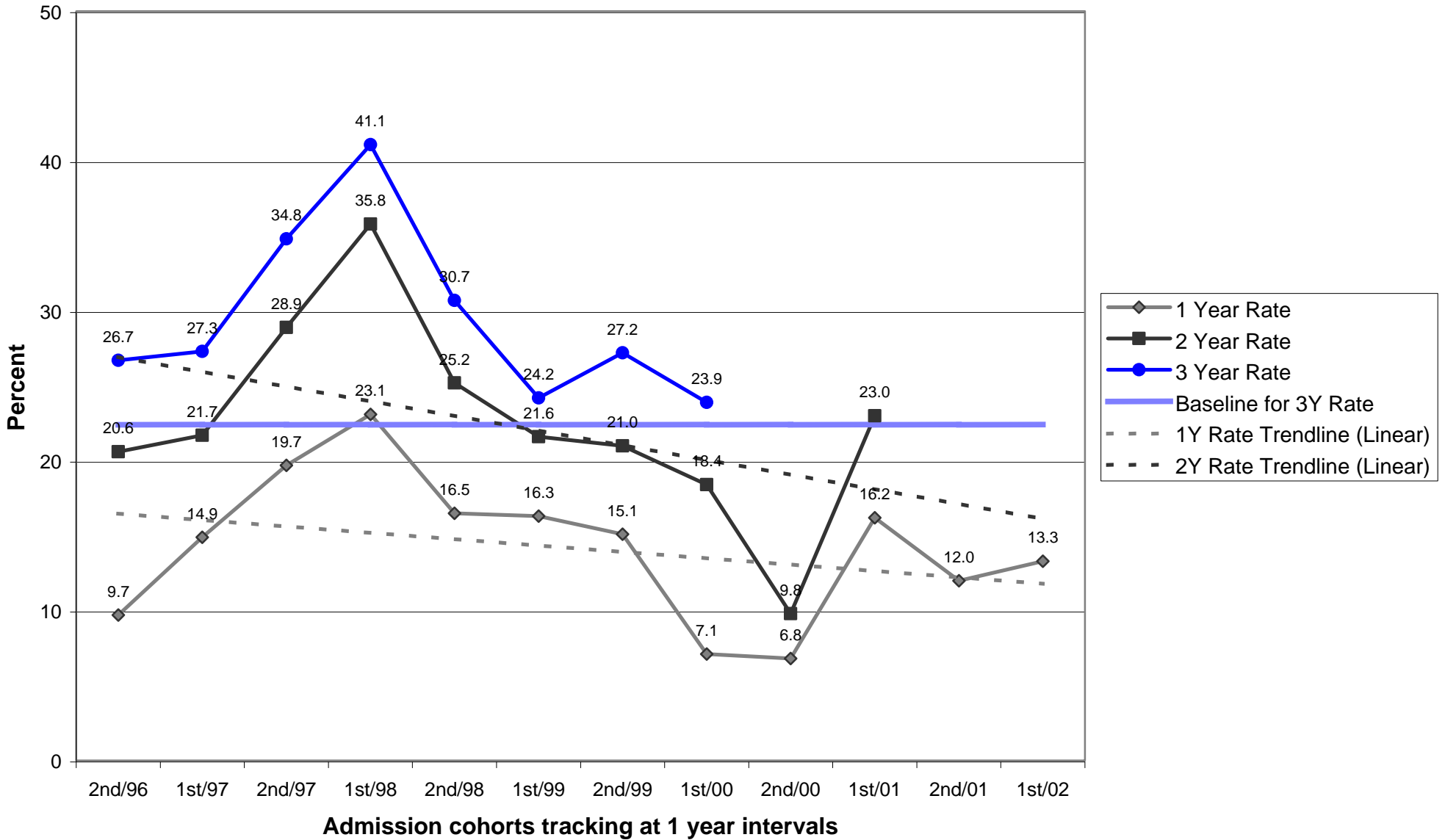
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Probation Recidivism Rates - 1st Half 2003

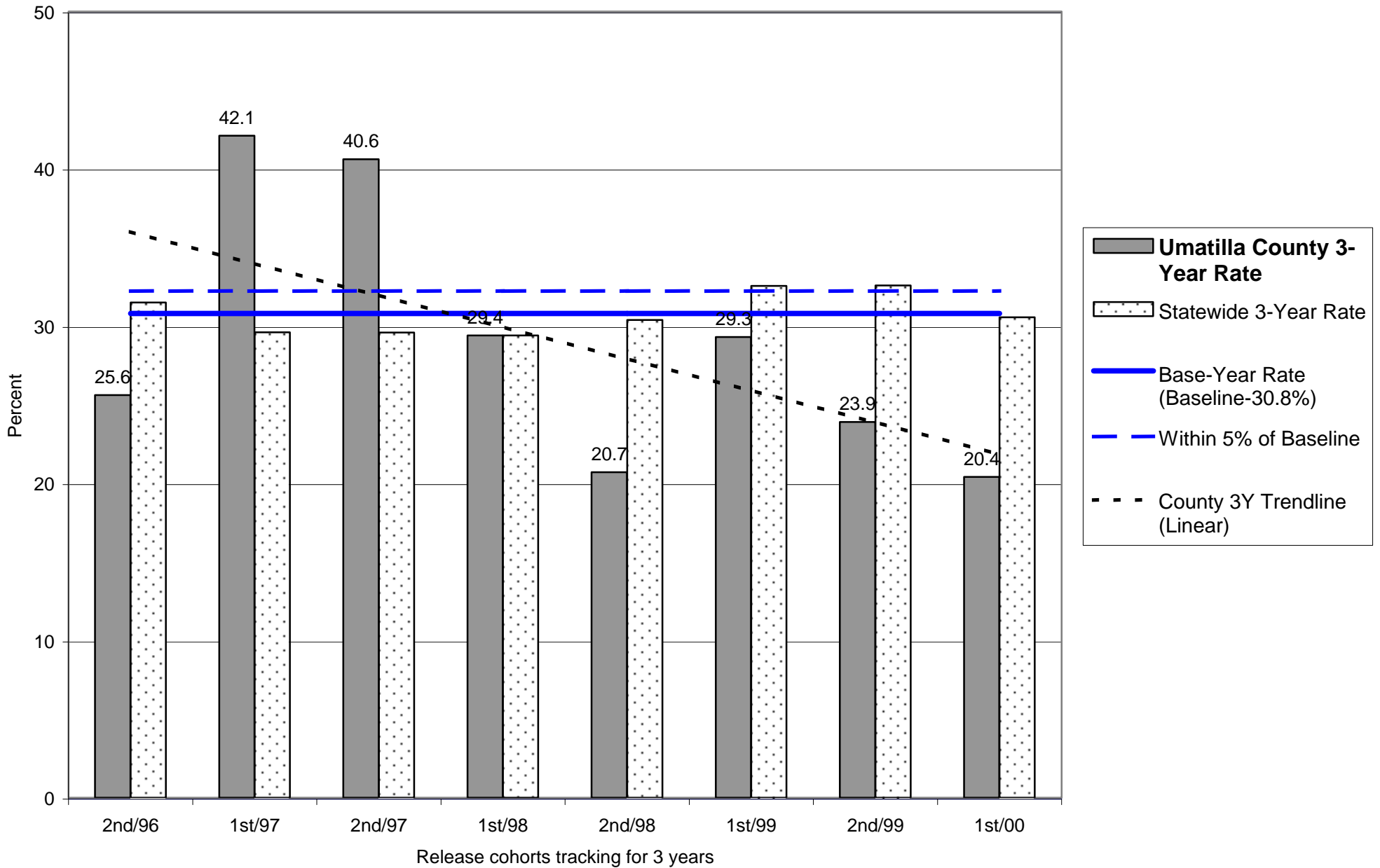


Probation Recidivism Rates - 1st Half 2003

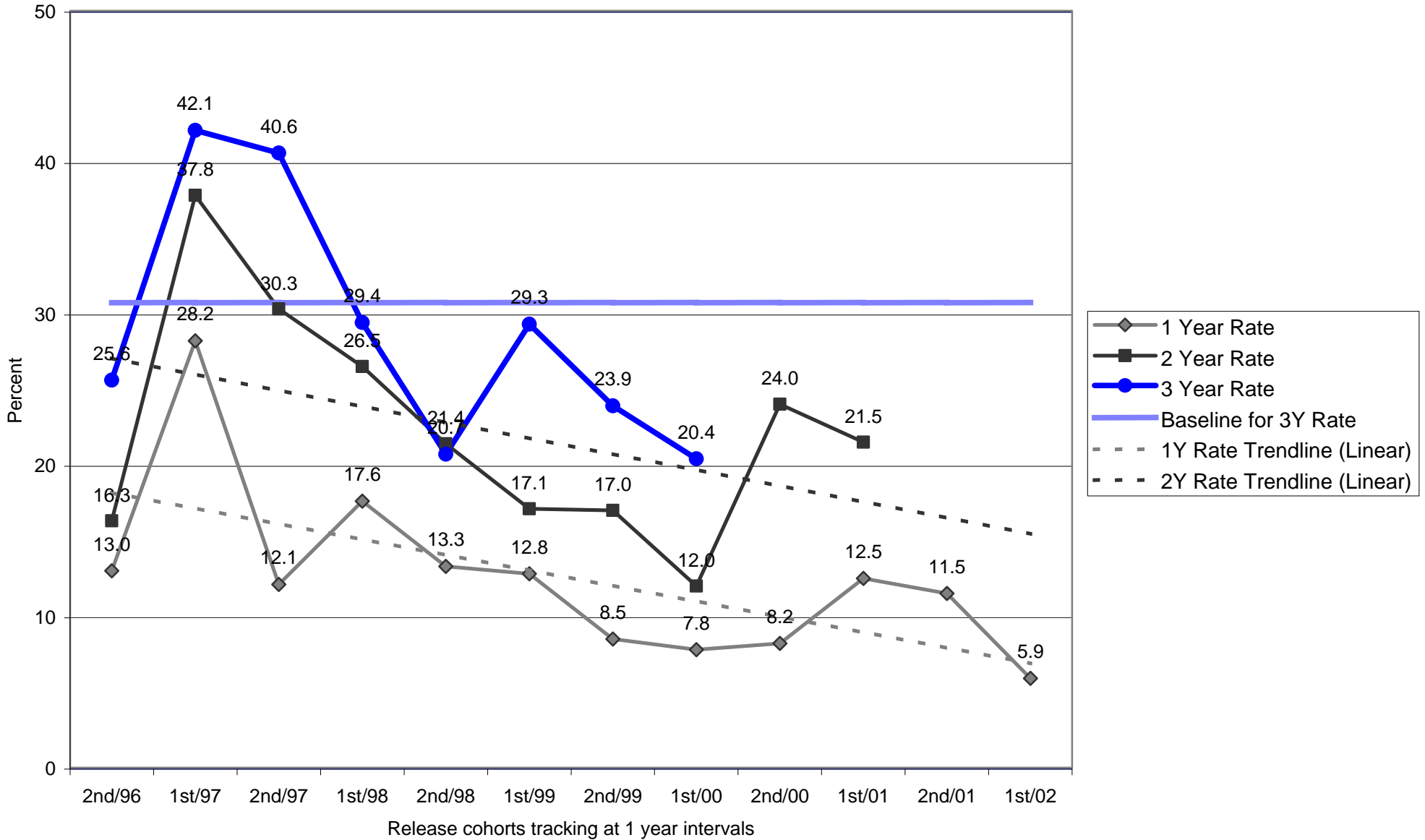


Parole/Post-Prison Supervision Recidivism Rates - 1st Half 2003

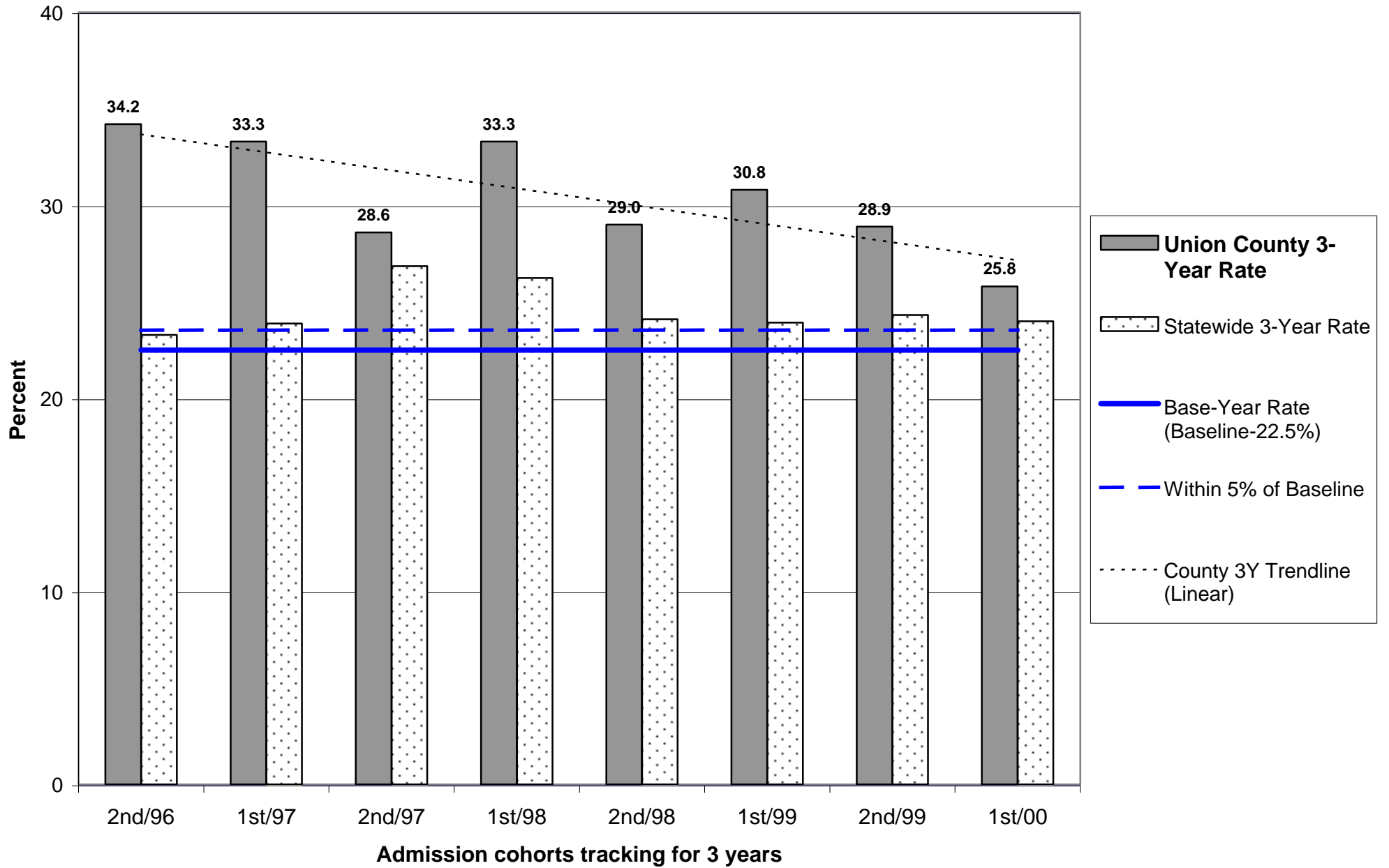

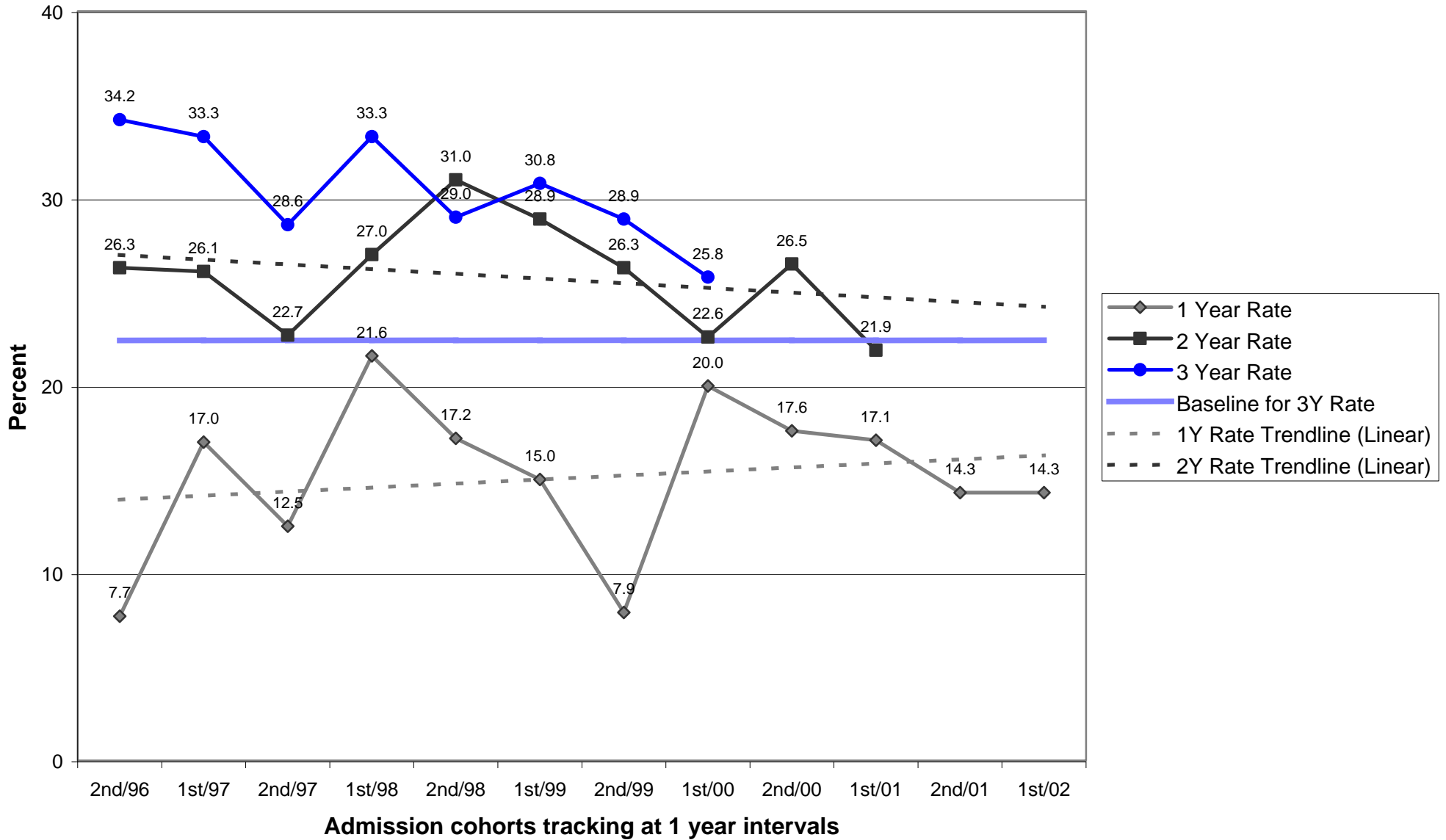

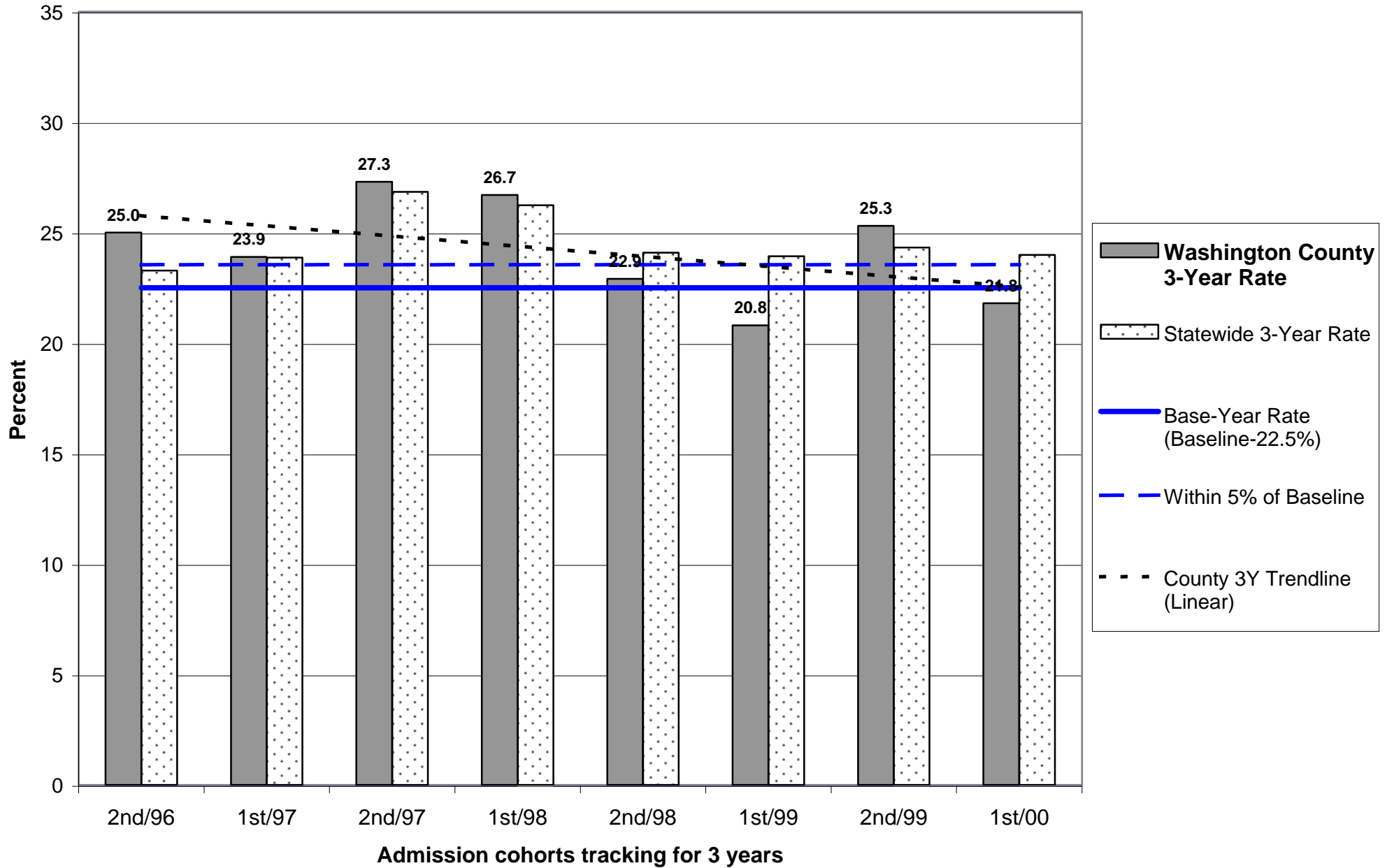

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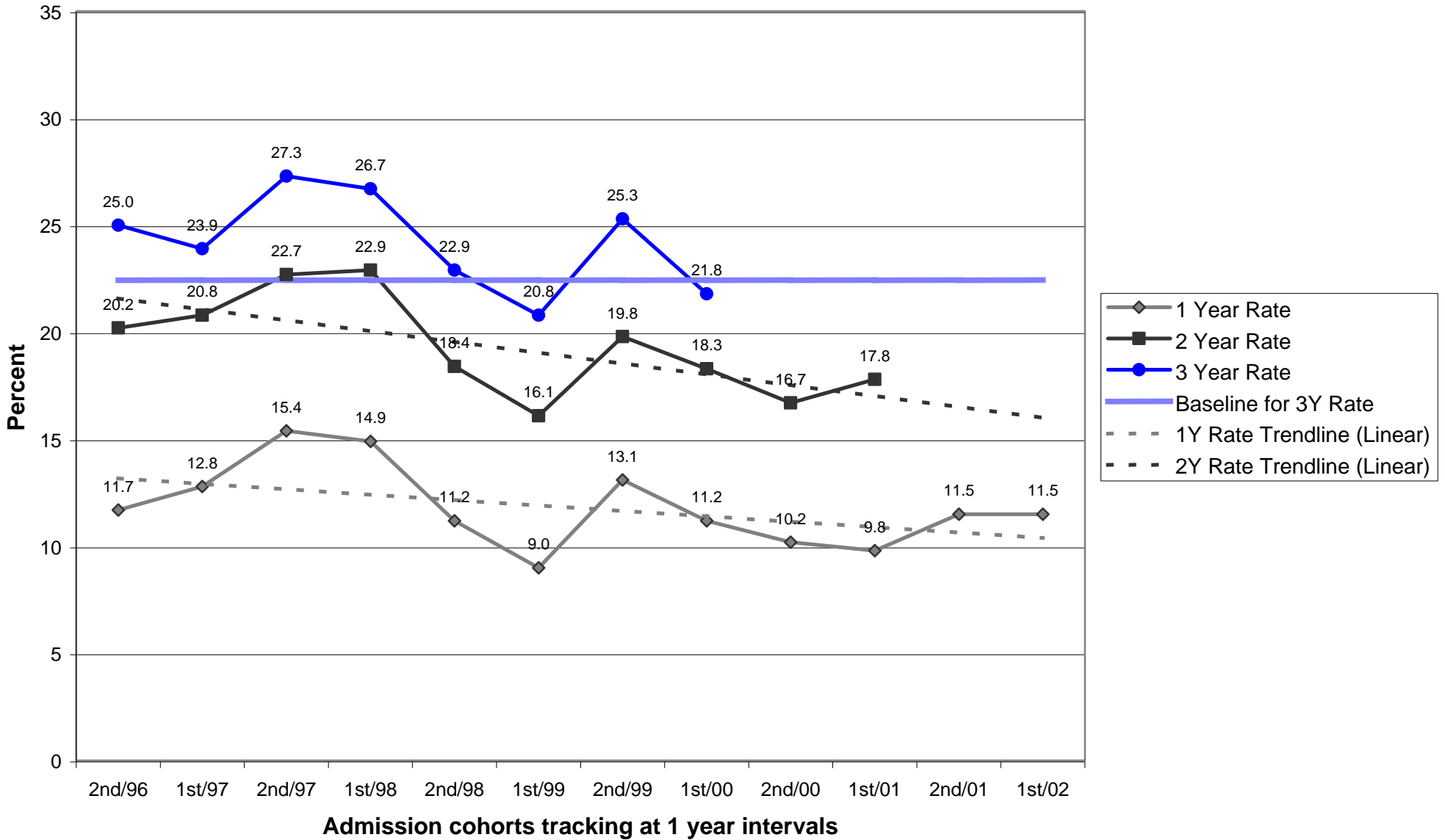

Probation Recidivism Rates - 1st Half 2003

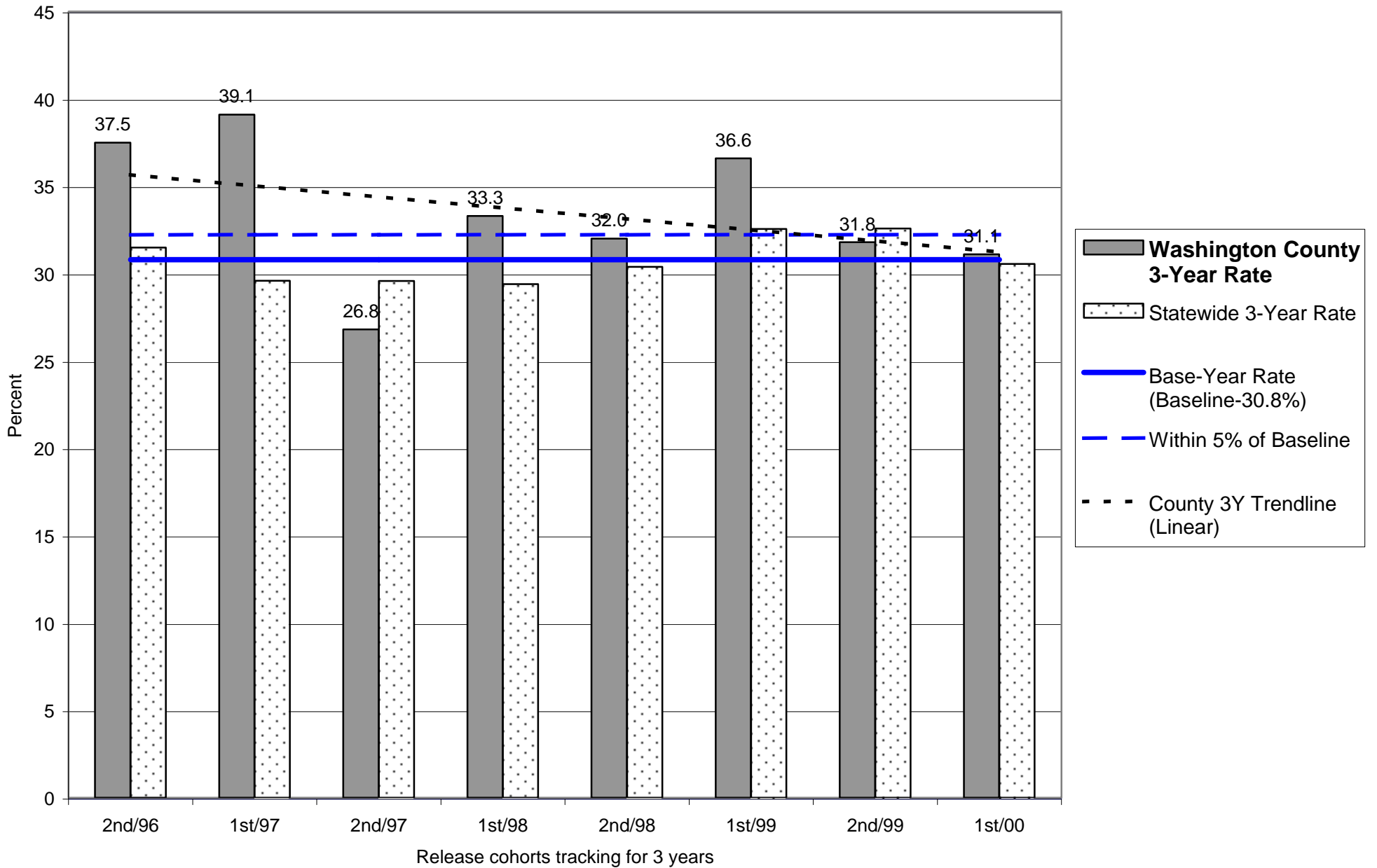


Probation Recidivism Rates - 1st Half 2003

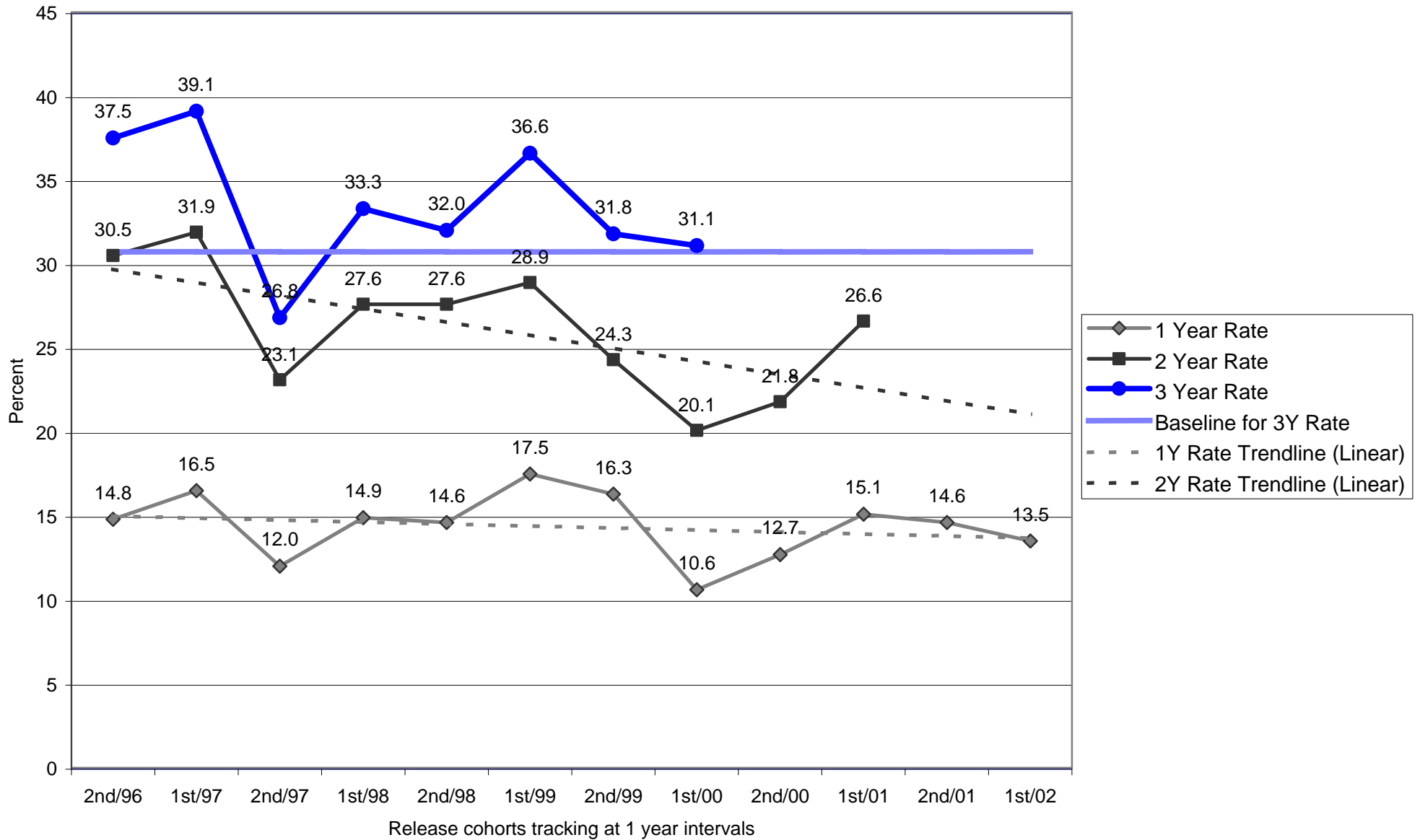


Parole/Post-Prison Supervision Recidivism Rates - 1st Half 2003

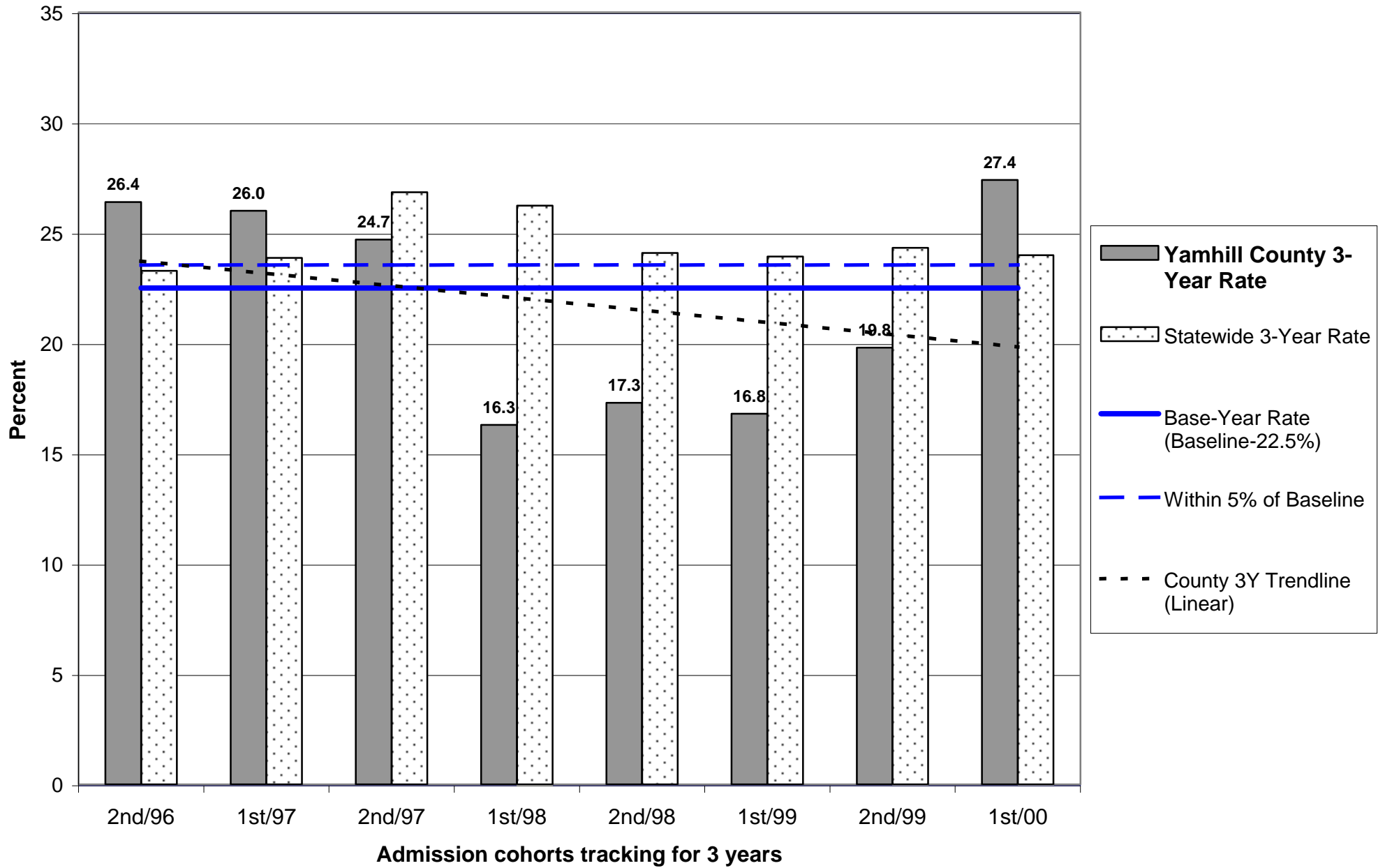

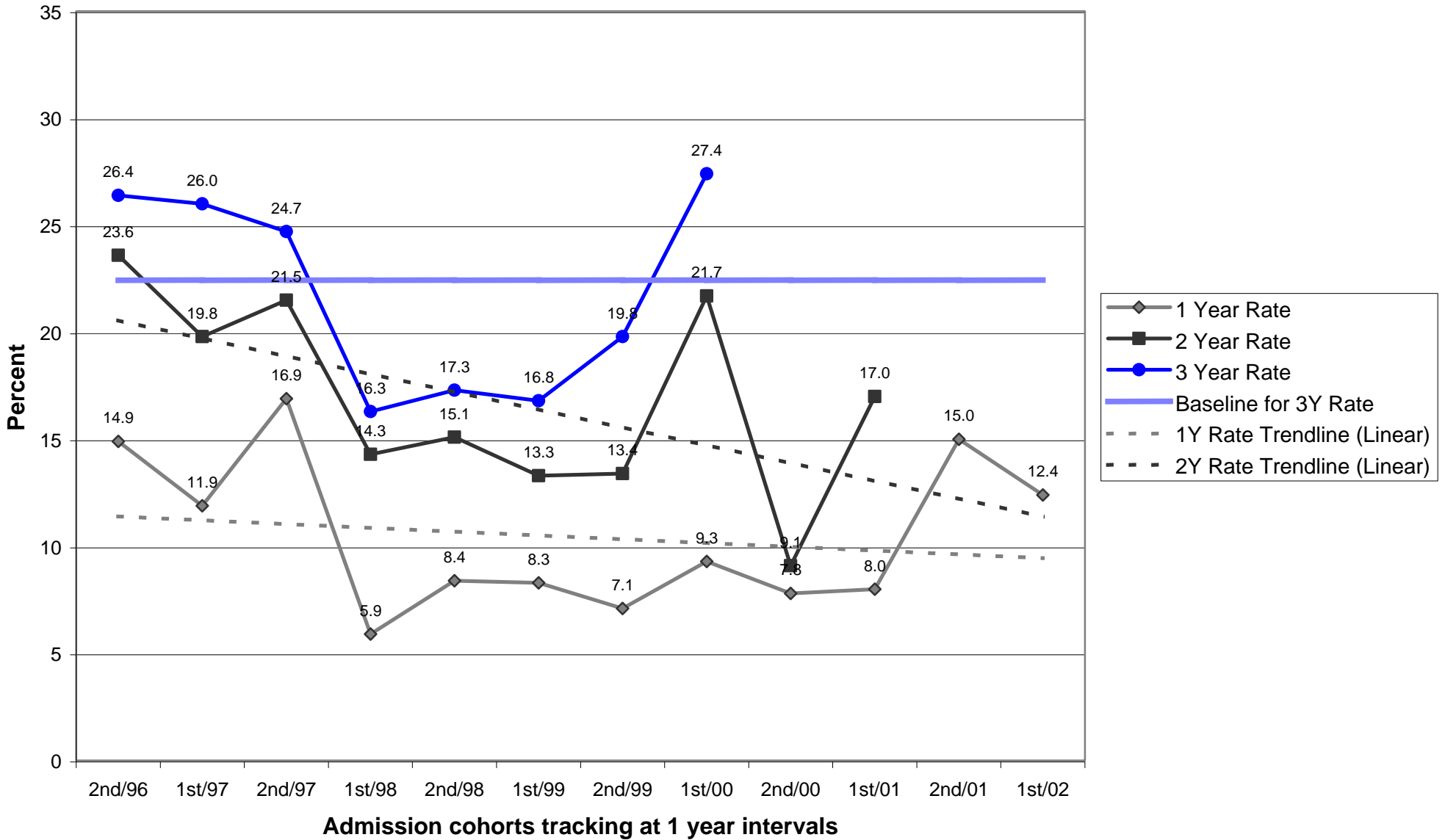

Probation Recidivism Rates - 1st Half 2003

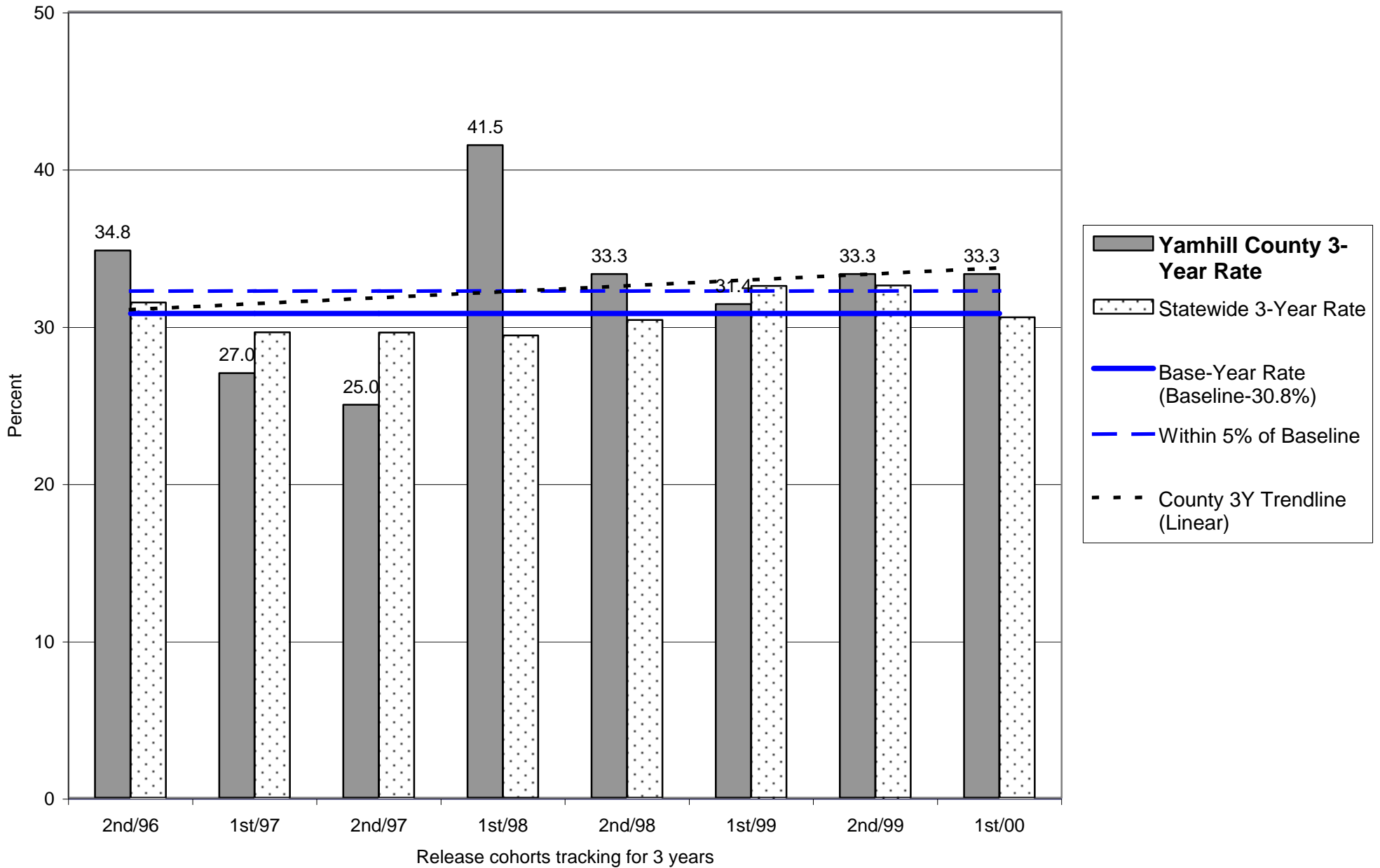


Probation Recidivism Rates - 1st Half 2003

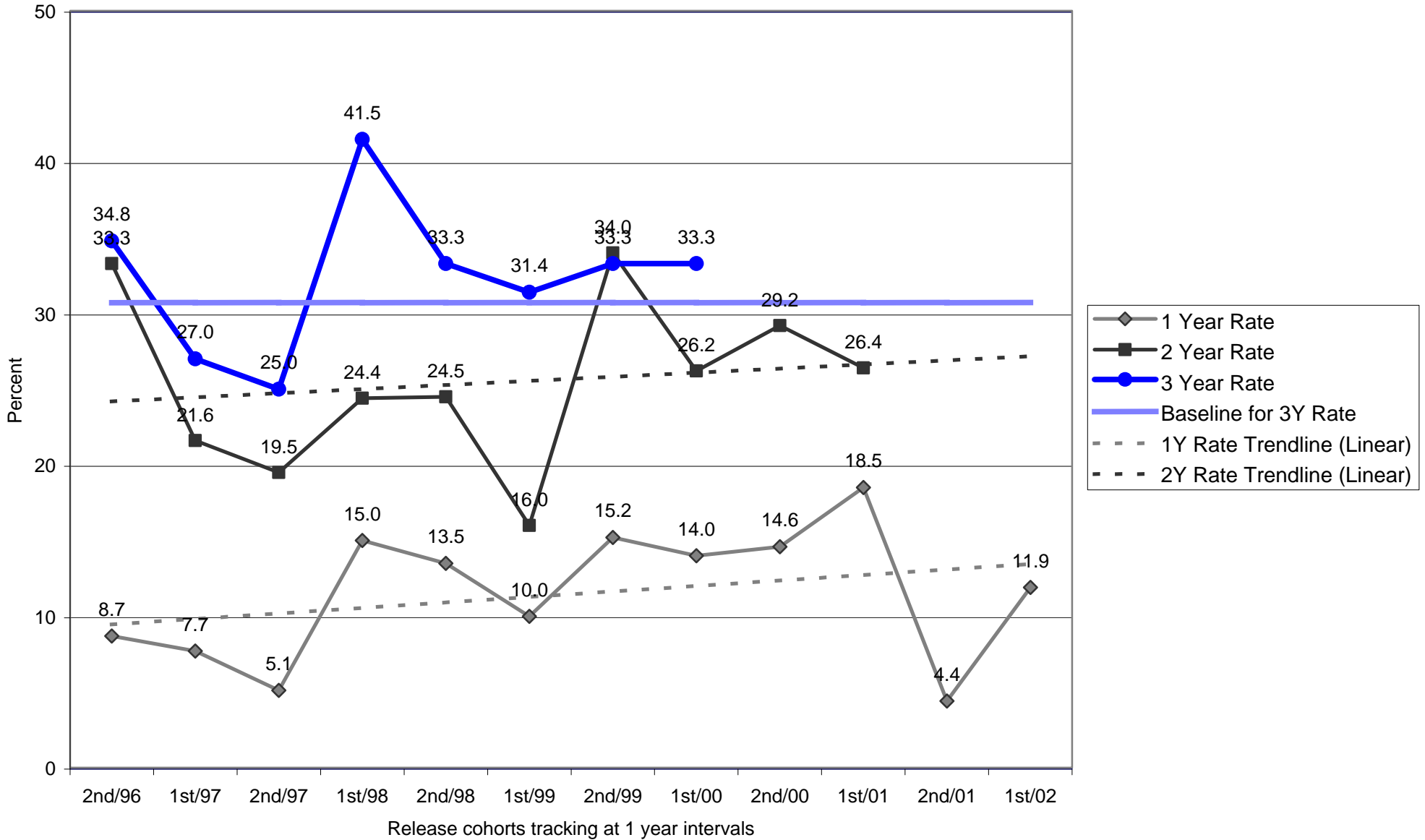


Parole/Post-Prison Supervision Recidivism Rates - 1st Half 2003

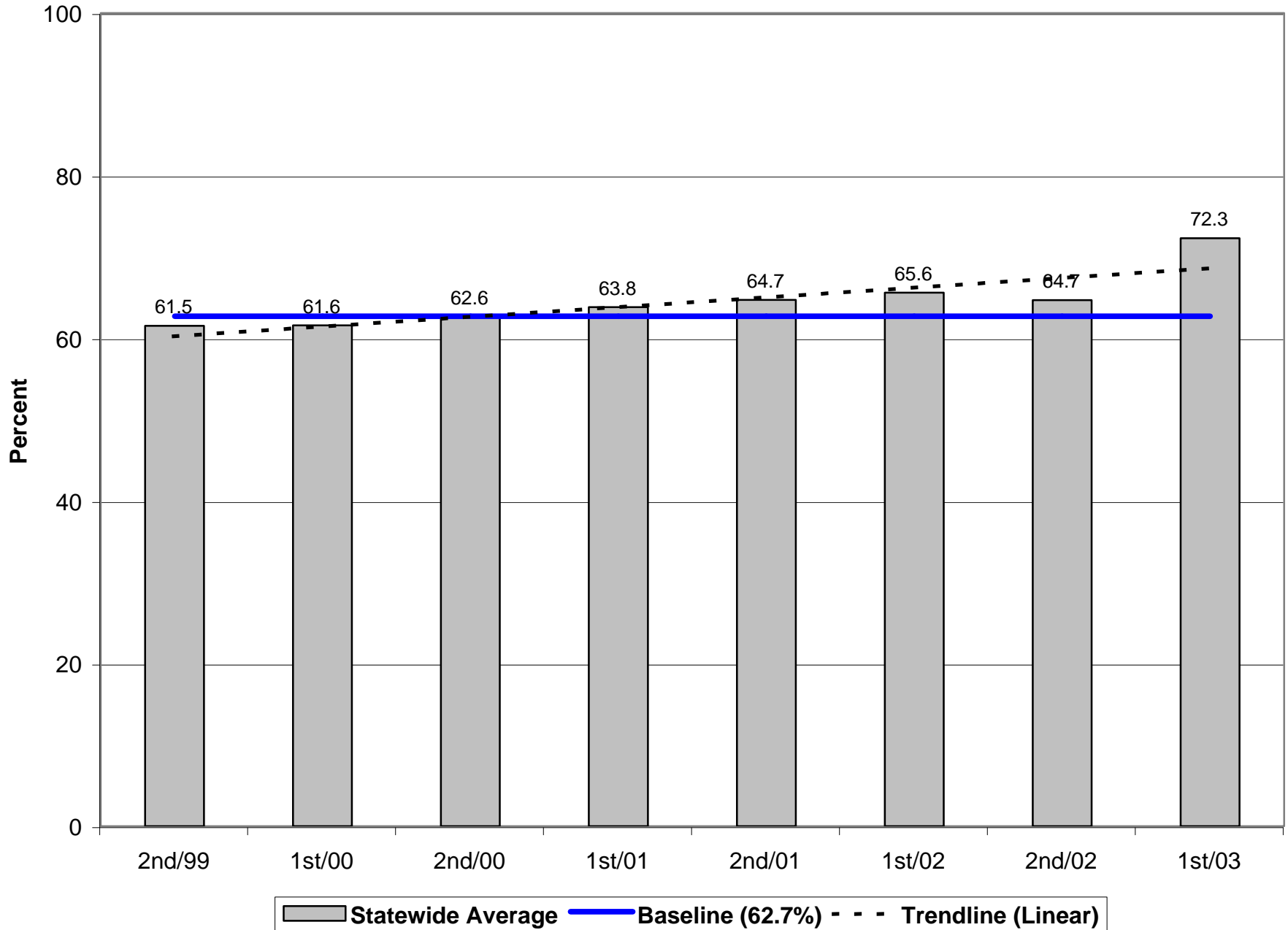

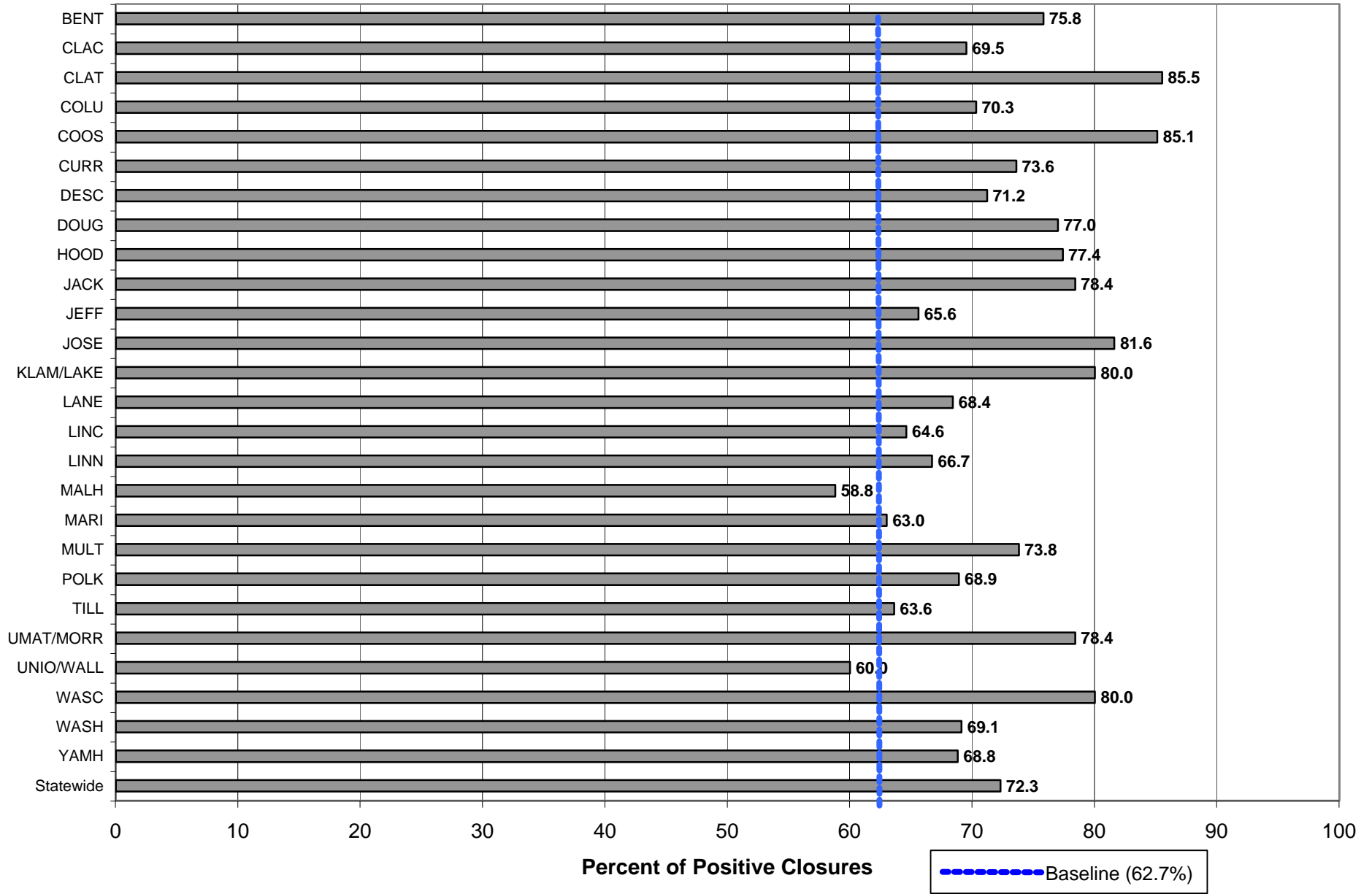

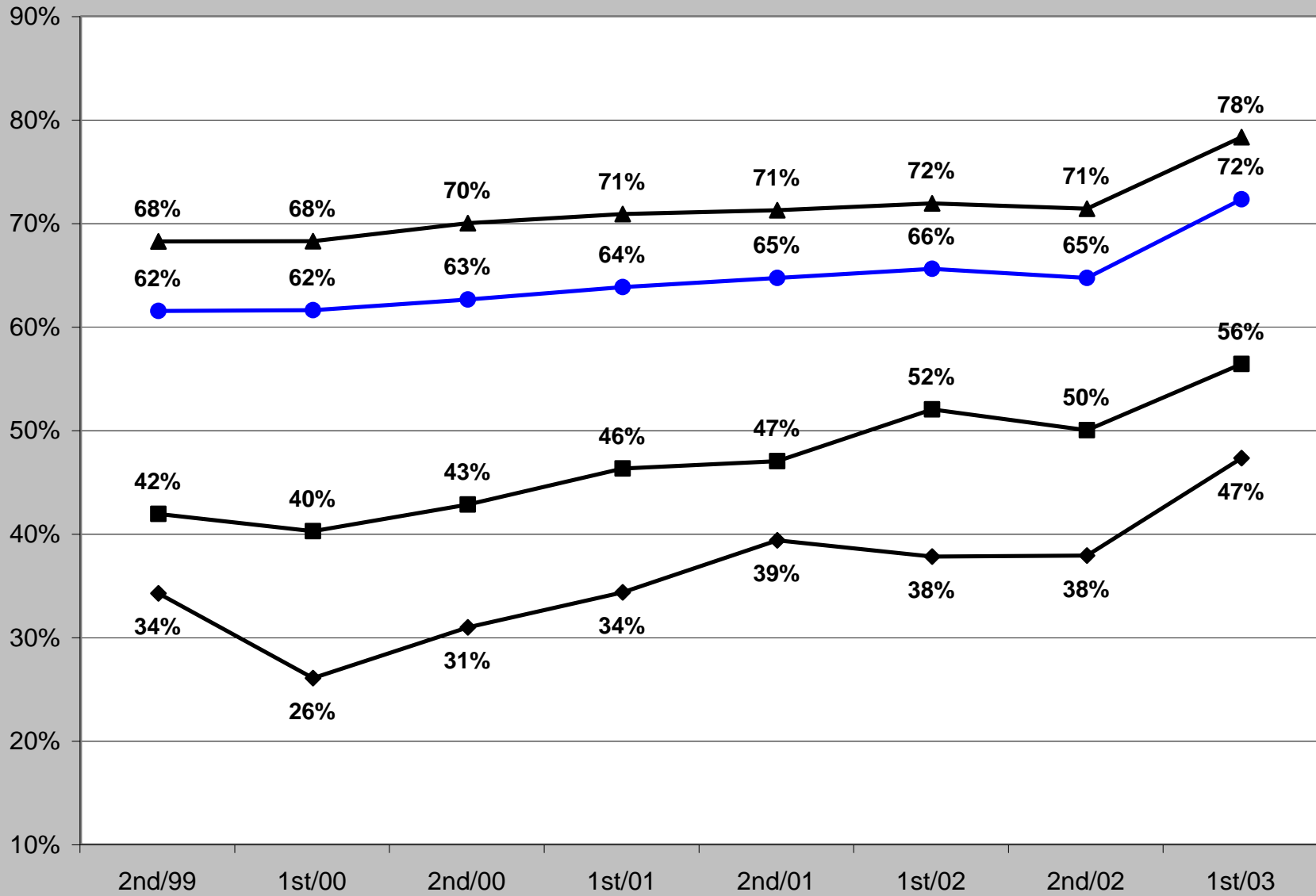
Probation Positive Case Closures through 1st Half 2003 (Statewide Total)

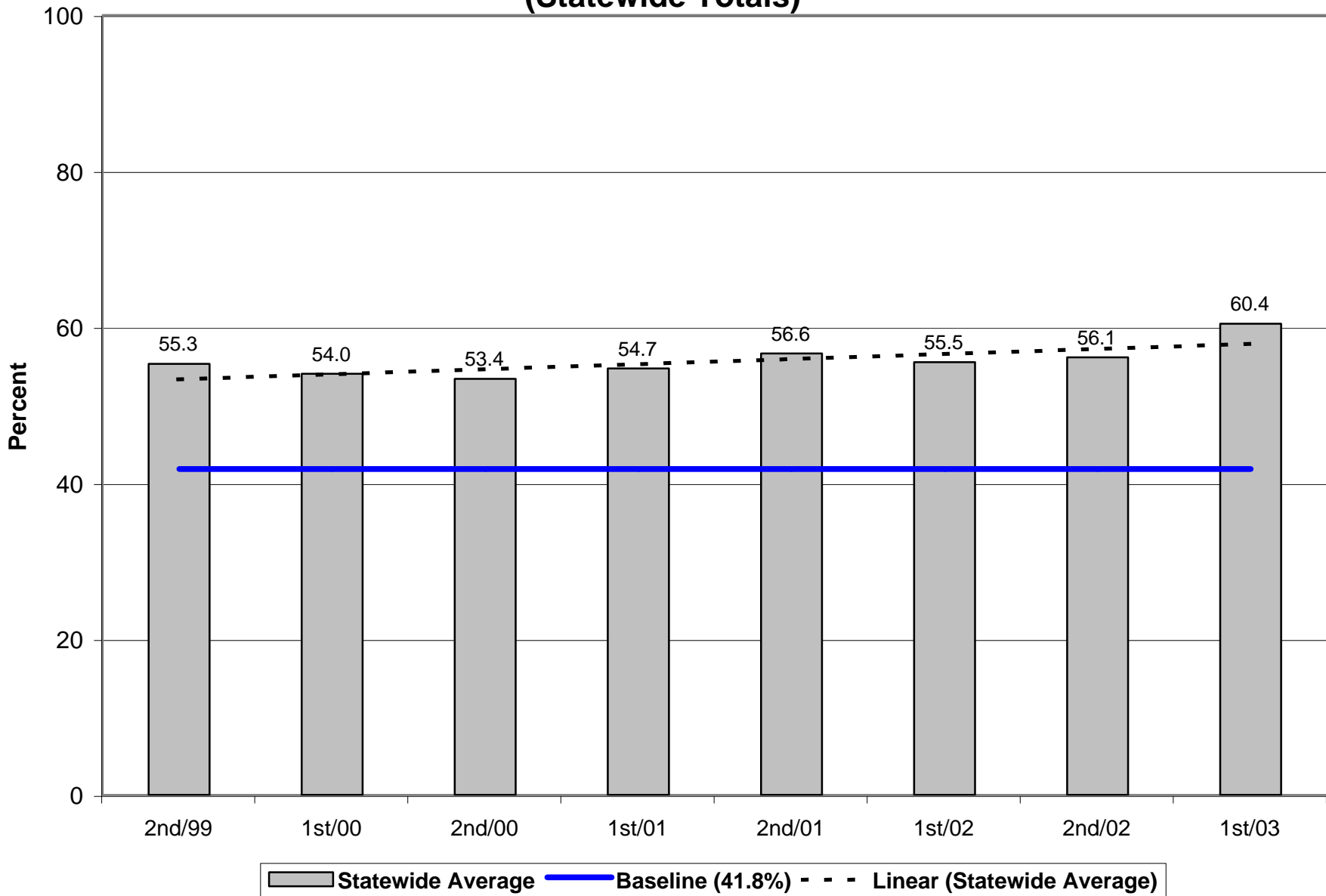

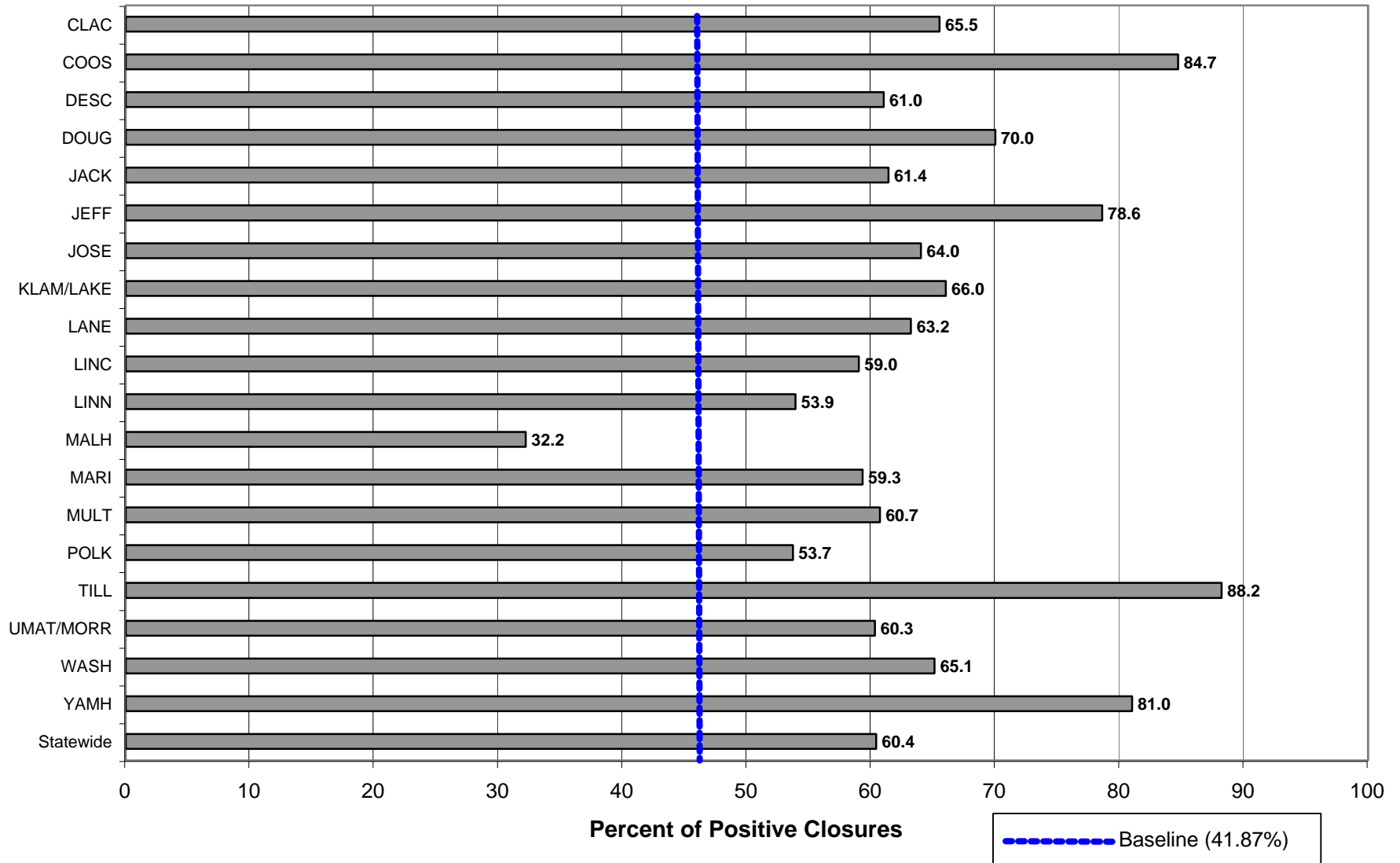

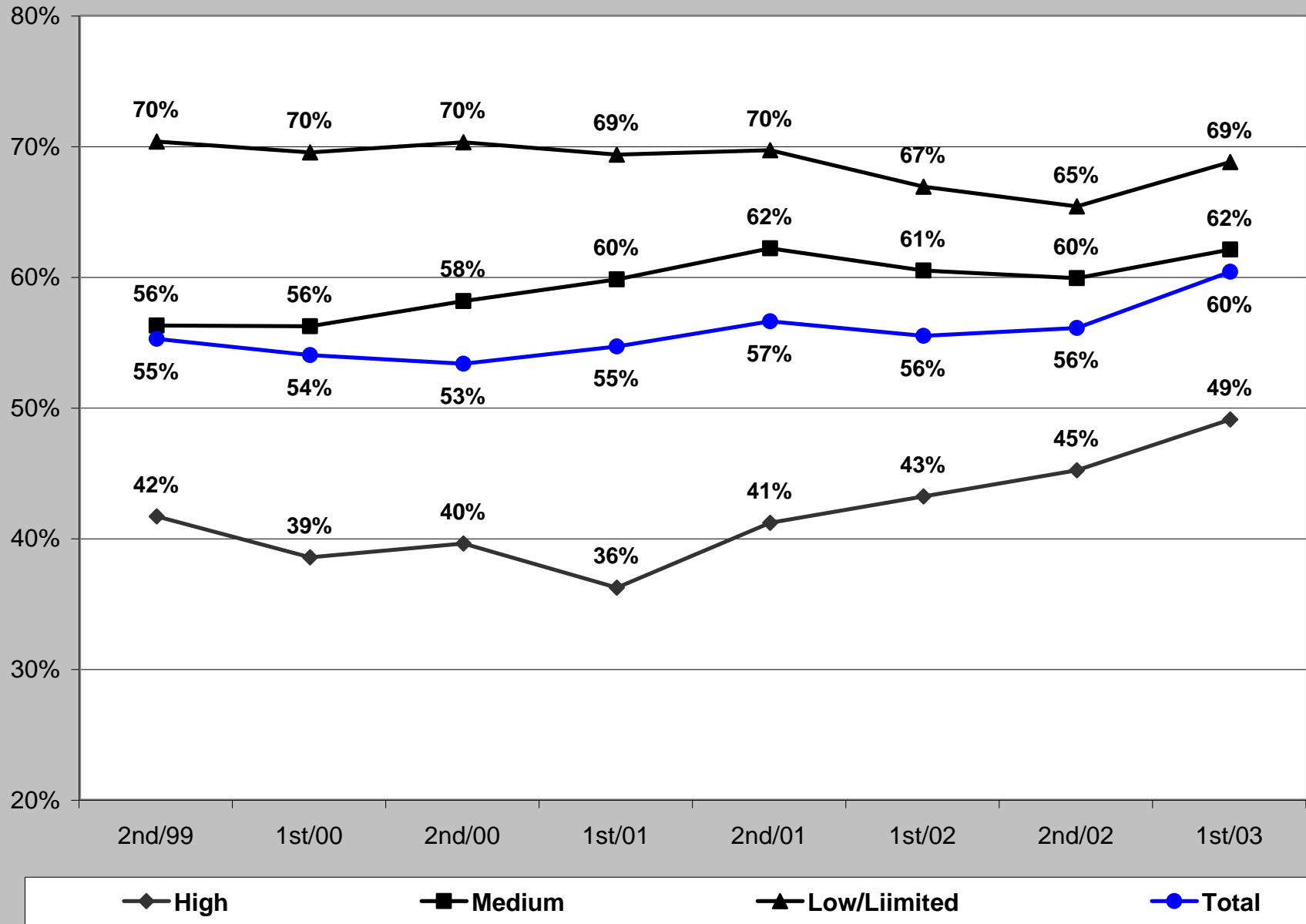
Parole/Post-Prison Supervision Positive Case Closures through 1st Half 2003 (Statewide Totals)



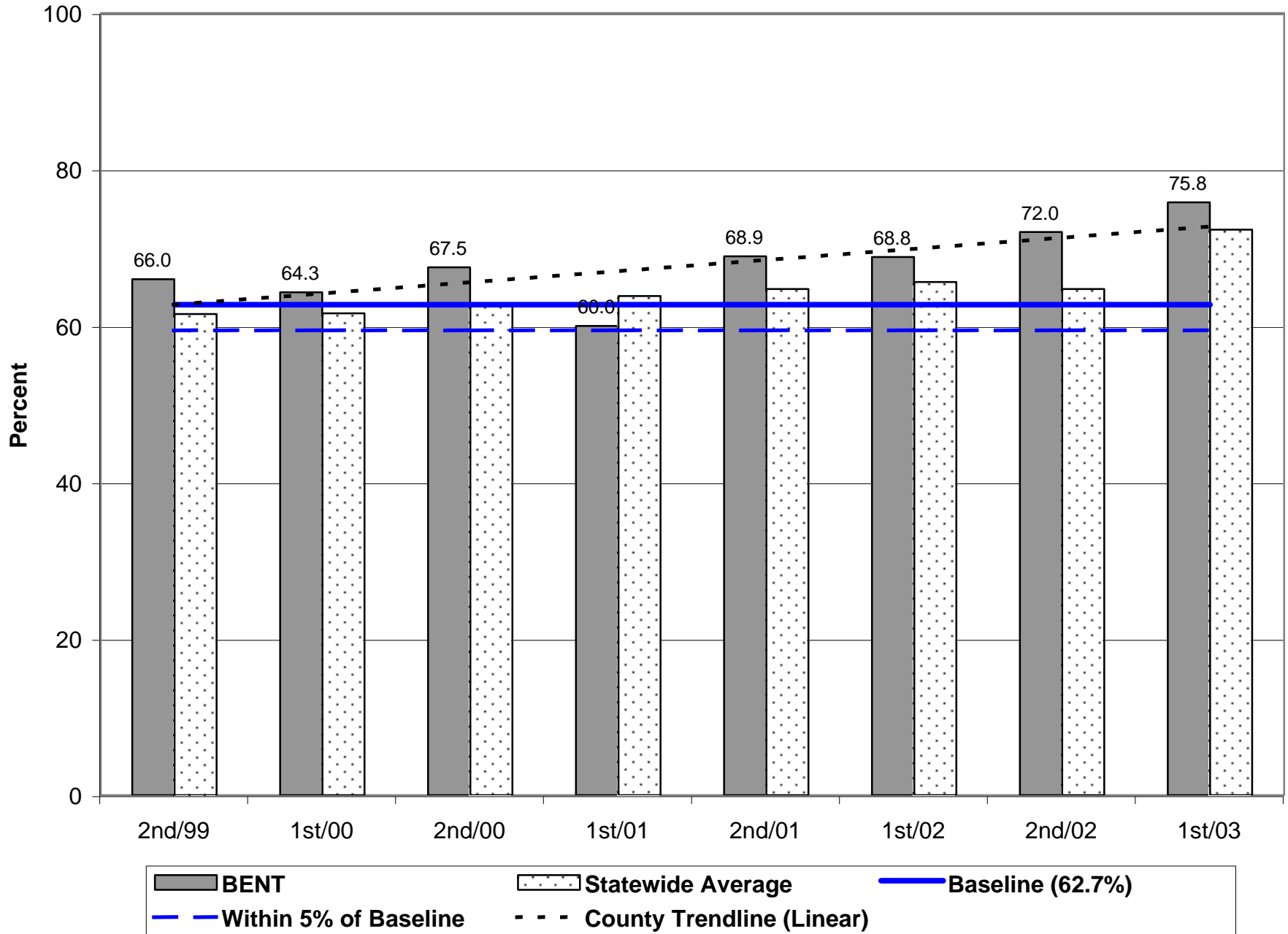

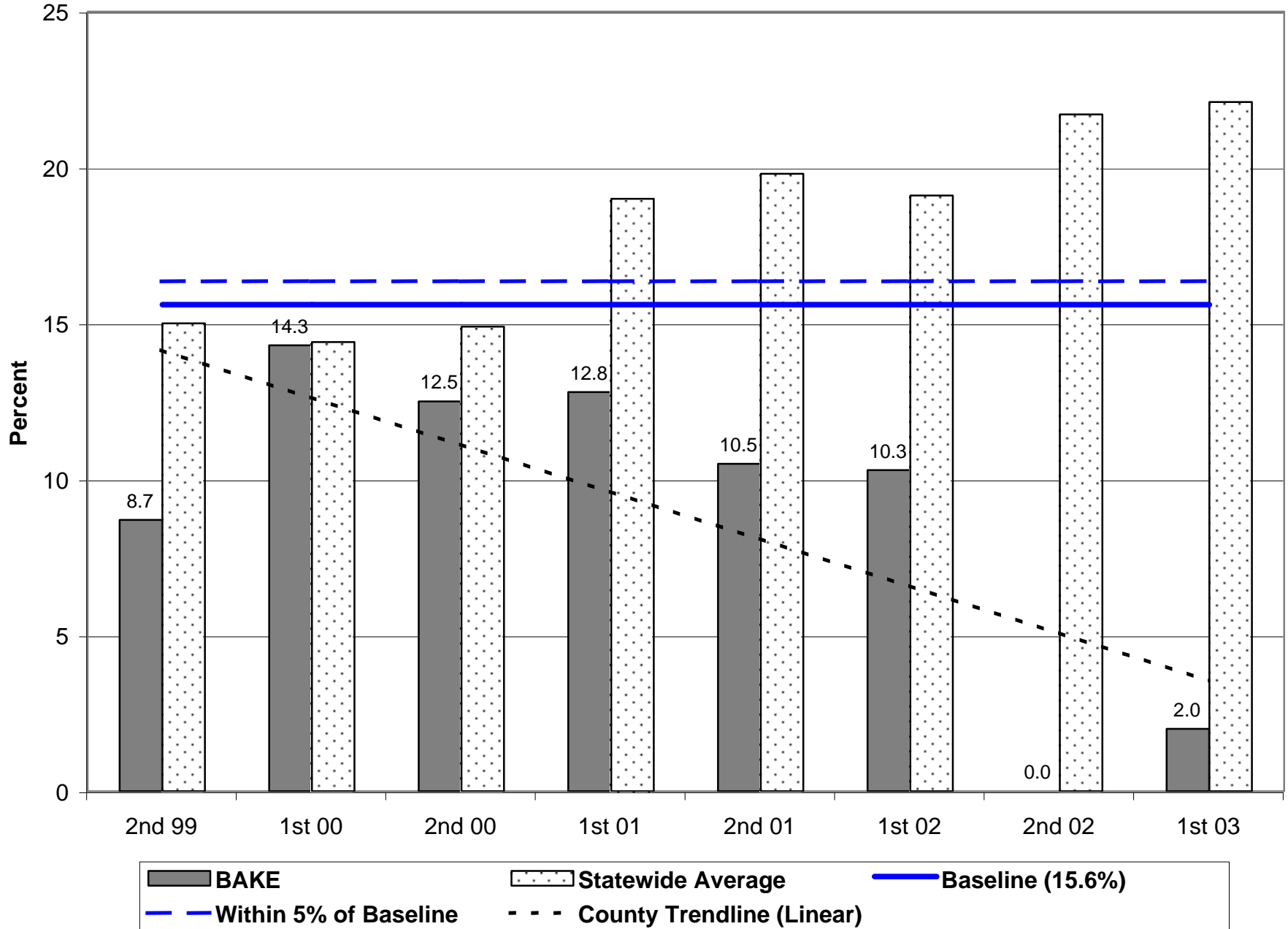
High Risk Abscond Rate through 1st Half 2003 (Statewide Total)



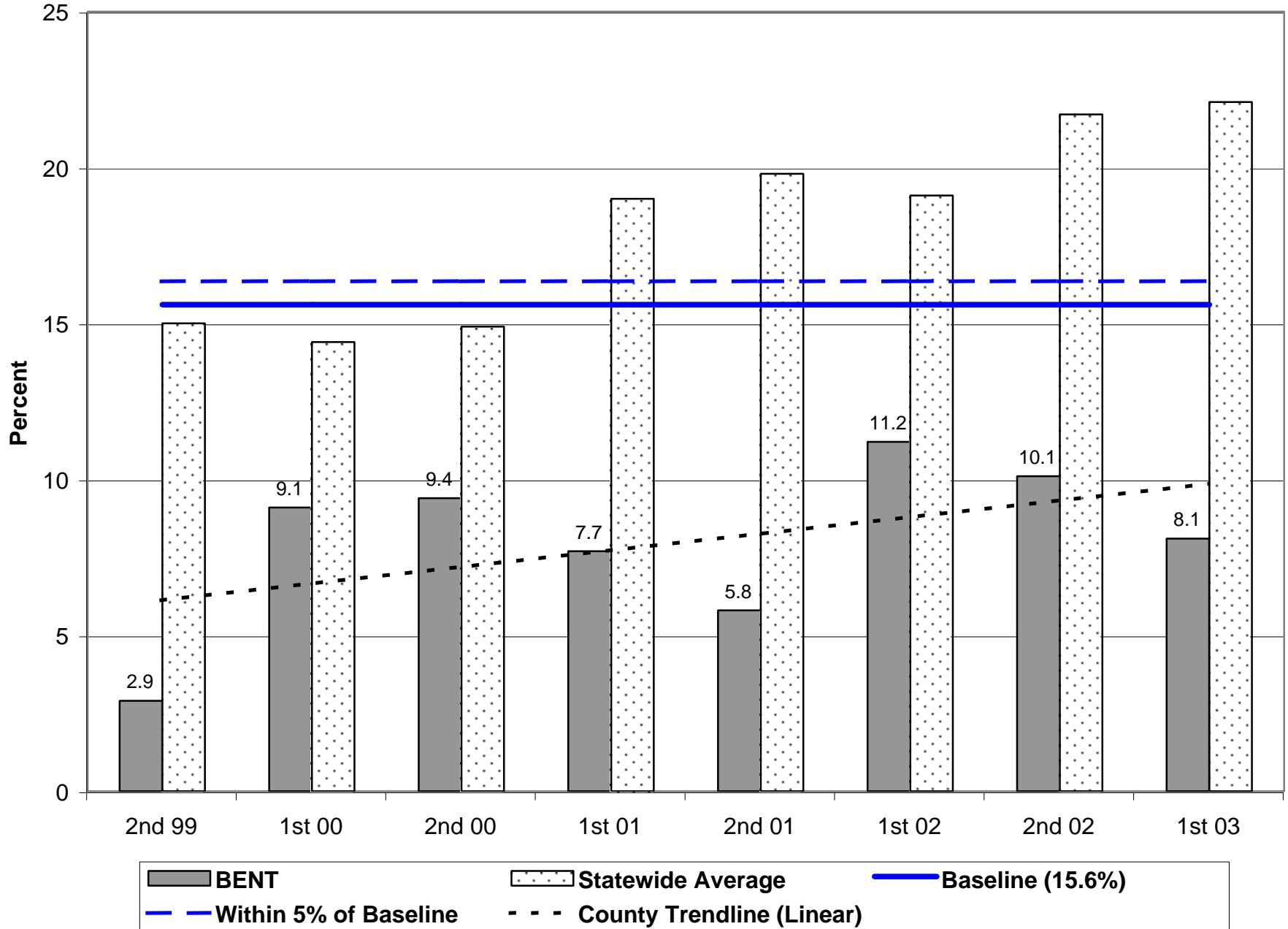
High Risk Abscond Rates for Counties with High Risk Caseload Pool Greater than 30 Cases - 1st Half 2003



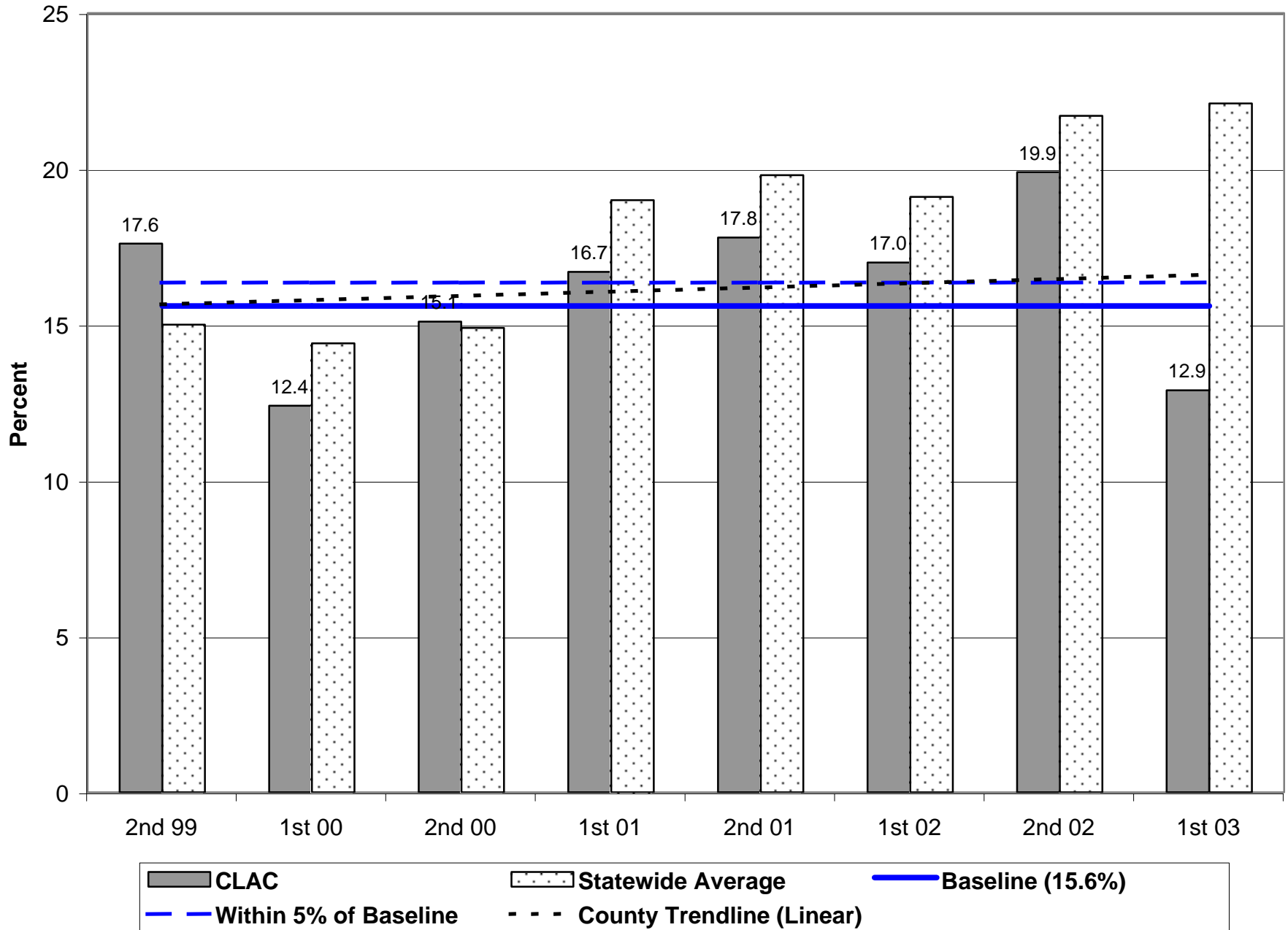
