

To: Inmate Friends and Families Subject: Debit Calling for All ODOC Facilities.

Debit Calling (Family option)

What is it: Inmate family can deposit funds in the inmate's **telephone debit account** for the inmate to use to place any calls he/she desires.

Cost of Call: These calls will be charged at a discounted call rate.

Call Type	Setup fee	Per Minute
Local	\$1.75	0
IntraLATA (e.g. Salem, Portland, Vancouver, WA)	\$1.46	\$.09
InterLATA / Intrastate (Between Lata's but in state)	\$2.35	\$.45
InterLATA / Interstate (e.g. Seattle, etc.)	\$2.35	\$.55

Benefit to the family:

- The inmate can call family at discounted rates.
- This is another option for people who can't be called collect due to their local exchange carrier.

Limitations:

- Funds become the inmate's once they're deposited. All funds should be used prior to the inmate's release.
- The inmate can call anyone he/she wishes. Calling can't be limited to the person depositing the money.
- The minimum amount per deposit is \$50.

To deposit to an inmate's debit account via **Money order** or **Casher's check**, Contact VAC at **1-800-786-8521**

OR

Send money Via MoneyGram.

1) Go to nearest MoneyGram agent.

Where? - Go to www.Moneygram.com to search for nearest agent by Zip code.
- Consult your local yellow pages.

2) Sender fills out an ExpressPayment form.

What to fill out? - Receive Code = **5031**

Pay To = **VALUE ADDED COMMUNICATIONS**

City = **Plano**

State = **Texas**

Account Number = **Sender's 10 digit phone number**

Dollar amount = **Amount to be sent**

Message = **Put Inmate's name and Inmate SID**

3) How much will it cost?

\$8.95 per payment.

\$8.50 if from WALMART

****** MoneyGram agents only take cash !!!! ******

4) How long does it take?

All payments received via MoneyGram will be posted to the inmate's debit account by 9:00 AM CST the next business day.

- If there are any questions about the process, please call 1-800-786-8521.
 - The inmate will need to dial **1-XXX-XXX-XXXX** to use the debit funds. The debit call will announce that it is a prepaid call rather than a collect call. If the call announcement says it is "Collect" you will be billed for the call.
 - Both debit and collect calls must be accepted by dialing the proper digits at the time of the call. Please listen carefully when receiving calls.
 - Debit call **charges** start when there is a connection of any type. Collect call **charges** start when the call is accepted.
