9, 1827. He died near Crescent City, Logan County,  
Oklahoma September 27, 1901. Aged 74 years 6 Months and  
18 days. Mary Elizabeth Watson was born in London Medicine  
County Ohio August 4, 1837. On June 29, 1855 she was  
Married to Peter Paugh of the same community in which she  
had grown up. To them five children were born.  
Richard Quinn Paugh born in Hancock County Illinois,  
December 10, 1856. William Henry Paugh born in Hancock  
County Illinois September 29, 1859. John McClellan Paugh  
born in Medicine County Ohio September 18, 1862. Lucy

1865. Nettie May Paugh was born in Cowley County, Kansas,  
March 25, 1877.

Mary Elizabeth Watson Paugh grew to woman hood and in her  
sixteenth year gave her heart to God and still clings to  
the cross. On June 29, 1855 was united in marriage to  
Peter Paugh of the same place and to this union was born five  
children all of whom are living near and with her to cheer  
her last days. Her companion passed to the better world  
the 27 of September 1901. She passed away September 10,  
1913, at 7:10 p.m.

south east of Winfield, near  
Silverdale - she married Horace  
Kimberlin at U.B. Church in Winfield  
Feb 23 - 1925. She <sup>Buried at Highland</sup> passed July 16 - 1929  
at Repts Kaws.

I had a brother <sup>Water Francis</sup> 10 yr. my senior  
married Nellie Hensley, he passed  
May 6 1971 at Cape City Ark &  
buried there.

With my parents when I was five  
we moved to Clinton Mo. I attended  
my first grade school there. My parents  
moved to Winfield Kaws so they

could help care for my father's  
aged mother (my grandmother) Mary  
Elizabeth Pough. I attended Wenfield  
Schools from 2<sup>nd</sup> grade to 1<sup>st</sup> yr. of  
High School. My sister Effie graduated  
as a R.N. nurse from the old  
Wenfield Hospital 1918.

My parents moved to Hot Springs  
Ark March 6 - 1920. I with 8 other  
young people from our community -  
Leth & Chyler Lounds - Jimmy + Ethel  
Lynch (niece) my room mate Rena  
Sterens, Jennie Phillips (Hillard) and  
my boy friend Elmer Godwin (4 yrs)  
attended at Magnolia Ark - then  
was called A + M. College, now it  
is Southern State, and the cost  
was \$30.00 per month. I was in  
a school play, also a piano recital -  
played "The 7 latter." (6 flats)

I spent one school year with  
my brother Walter Pough + his wife  
(Mellie Wensley)

Nellie in ~~at~~ Cushing Okla. (He worked  
in the oil fields.

The next school year was at  
Hanes Ark. (Half way between Hot  
Springs and Mountain Pine) a subscription  
school - \$6.00 per month - I had to  
walk between 3 + 4 miles - carry a  
cold lunch, was free -

My Junior + Senior year I drove to  
Hot Springs - High School (T model ford)  
had to cross the Bayou, no bridge.  
Part time two neighbor girls - the  
pastors daughter Francis Rodgers +  
Dora Godwin rode with me.  
When the bayou would be high -  
sometimes real risky to ford it.  
I graduated from Hot Springs High  
School May 1924.

The next school year was at Haws  
Ark. (Half way between Hat Spg. and  
Mountain Pine) a subscription school - 6  
per month.

My Junior + Senior years were at Hat  
Spg. High, I graduated May - 1924

Soon after graduation my parents  
accepted Sept of a Convalescent Home  
in Winfield Kas, and my sister  
~~is~~ Effie Mae Paugh R.N. nurse  
was also employed in Winfield.  
Red Cross + Public Health nurse

I worked a year at Stutzmans  
Jewelry Store in Winfield.

I married Edward Arthur West  
June 28 - 1925 - (U.B. Church) Zelma + Harry M. Kay  
Effie + Horace Kunkler

When Edythe Irene was 3 1/2 mo. old  
Ed with my father J. M. Paugh were



out mending fence on my parents farm  
Jan 15, 1927. They had a 12 gauge shot  
gun in the wagon, so to hunt rabbits  
doves etc also. Ed pulled the gun out  
when they got to the house & the  
trigger caught on some wire. He  
was seriously injured, wound in  
side & back, also right hand. We  
went to Mayo Clinic in 1934, found he  
had 40 shots in back, made him  
a brace, but never would wear  
it. He died Sept 6, 1942 at Wesley Hosp  
Wichita Kas. We were married 17 yrs.  
Buried in West Plot in Memorial Lawn  
Cemetery, Ark. City KS.

I married George Bayd Keahy  
Oct 2, 1946 at Marshall Ark. I was  
a very happy person as I knew my darling  
would be good to my 2 children Kent &  
and also Edythe Dene, & also my parents.

Boyd was a wonderful husband  
to me - He was bed ridden &  
complete helpless for 18 mo, long before  
that semi-invalid. He died Dec 18, 1980  
at 1017 Airport Rd. 2nd St. Spg. Ark. Miles  
Mortuary of Warfield Ks. came and  
got his body - services were held  
at miles. Dec. 22, 1980, and
