born North Carolina. If the census was taken prior to October, this could be the son of Jeremiah and Drusilla Baldwin Spurlin of Warren county, Georgia who was born October 4, 1783. The same census shows Silas, age 50, born North Carolina, making his birth ca. 1800, but Jeremiah and Drusilla's son Silas was born July 5, 1793, and they were in Georgia as early as 1785.

According to the 1820 Jones County Census there were 8 children (or 7 children and brother Silas) living in John's household. We can place two of those children by name and birthdate, and then two more born after 1820.
