III. PERMITTEE MANAGEMENT RESPONSIBILITIES

A STATE CLOSURE ORDER EXISTS - Any hay or straw used in association with this permit, will be certified and tagged as noxious weed, or noxious weed seed free as directed by the order.

To meet the State of Idaho's provision for trichomoniasis testing, all bulls must be tested at least 45 days prior to the turnout date.

Cattle that die from a contagious disease, or that die at a location where they may contaminate water or become a public nuisance, must be properly disposed of.

At the end of the grazing season, please mail in the actual use booklet that you have received.

IV. IMPROVEMENT MAINTENANCE/CONSTRUCTION

Fence improvements on the Beyeler Pasture are the sole responsibility of the permittee and will be maintained prior to livestock entry into the unit being grazed. Maintenance should be completed before adjoining federal allotments are stocked.

V. ACTION SUMMARY

Watch for weeds, knapweed or leafy spurge, along the road right-of-ways. Please let us know if you see any new infestations or any new species we may not know about.
