HES 659 is comprised of approximately 320 acres of private land and 16 acres of USFS land that are fenced in common. The 16 acres of federal land contain both upland and riparian areas in mid seral condition.

**III. PERMITTEE MANAGEMENT RESPONSIBILITIES**

**WHERE A STATE CLOSURE ORDER EXISTS** - Any hay or straw used in association with this permit, will be certified and tagged as noxious weed, or noxious weed seed free as directed by the order.

To meet the State of Idaho's provision for trichomoniasis testing, all bulls must be tested at least 45 days prior to the turnout date.

Cattle that die from a contagious disease, or that die at a location where they may contaminate water or become a public nuisance, must be properly disposed of.

At the end of the grazing season, please mail in the actual use booklet that you have received.
