Global Health Odyssey Student Group Behavior Expectations

The following guidelines for museum visit behavior were created to serve as a guideline for student groups. Student groups are usually larger than typical museum groups, which makes good behavior essential to the success of the visit. Students not willing to cooperate will be asked to wait for his/her group in the security area.

Students

- Be a good ambassador for your school! Respect others in your group and other museum visitors.
- Follow all instructions given by CDC Security and Global Health Odyssey staff.
- Make sure your cell phone is in the "off" or "silent" mode.
- Use quiet voices in the museum.
- Be an active participant. Listen closely to the presenter or tour guide and ask questions!
- Please do not touch an object unless invited to do so, and stay off the exhibit cases or other exhibit structures.
- Help preserve Global Health Odyssey's exhibits by not eating, drinking or chewing gum in the exhibit galleries.
- Visit the museum store only if allowed by your teacher
- If allowed, an adult chaperone must accompany students; no more than seven students may be in the store at any one time. The store may be visited after the guided tours.

Teachers

- Teachers and chaperones must stay with their groups at all times.
- Please be an active chaperone and a good example by not talking on your cell phone during the tour.
