Order No. 2007 - 01 Stanislaus National Forest Summit Ranger District

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(a), the following act is prohibited within the Summit Ranger District of the Stanislaus National Forest. This order is effective from June 5, 2007 through September 15, 2007, from May 15, 2008 through September 15, 2008, and from May 15, 2009, through September 15, 2009.

Possessing, storing or transporting any dog within the area between the dog trail and Pinecrest Lake, located within the Pinecrest Day Use Area. The Pinecrest Day Use Area is located in the NW ¼ of Section 22, T.4N., R.18E., Mt. Diablo Meridian and Base, as shown on the attached map. 36 CFR 261.58(s).

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this order:

- 1. Persons with a disability using a service dog.
- 2. Persons with a permit from the Forest Service specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
- 3. Any Federal, State, or local officer or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force using a dog in the performance of an official duty.

This prohibition is in addition to the general prohibitions contained in 36 CFR Part 261, Subpart A.
