The campground is located on the north end of the Carson Ranger District, north of Verdi and southwest of Bordertown in Dog Valley. The 18-site campground is nestled amongst the tall Jeffery Pine of the eastern Sierra offering a cool break from the hot summers of the valley floor. Reno is short drive east offering numerous services and amenities. If selected, some of the duties you would perform as a campground host would be ensuring the campground remains clean, safe, and inviting to the public. Some knowledge of the local areas, plants, animals, and history is helpful but not essential. The campground is open the length of the summer and the position would be needed until October 15.

Applicants will be considered until filled, and should be prepared to commit for the length of the season. Applicants will be required to supply their own camp trailer and food. All tools and supplies necessary to carry out the duties of maintaining the campground will be provided.
