<u>Kiowa Pond Area</u>: From Stead Tanker Base – cross under freeway (395) and make a left onto North Virginia Street. Make a right onto Seneca Drive. Proceed north past the railroad tracks and make a left on Kiowa Way. This will take you to the jump spot on the Carson Ranger District (It is a large dirt parking area with some forest information signs about 100 yards from the houses). Please stage along the side of the road or along an adjacent side road before you reach the large parking area. Please allow enough room on the road to allow for a large fire

engine to pass.
