Component Description

The NHANES 2003-2004 Prostate File provides personal interview data on prostate conditions, prostate cancer treatment, and erectile

dysfunction (ED).

Eligible Sample

Mentally impaired individuals or participants unable to comprehend English or Spanish were excluded from the interview.

Questions on prostate disease diagnosis and erectile dysfunction were asked of male participants 20 years and older.

Questions on incontinence, prostate conditions, and prostate cancer treatment were asked of male participants 40 years and older.

Private room in the mobile examination center; administered through an audio computer-assisted self interview (ACASI).

**Administration** The ACASI enabled the participants both to hear questions through earphones and to read questions on the computer, and to move at their own speed as they touched the screen to indicate their response. No proxies or translators were permitted.
