| A. No burning.<br>B. Welding or metal cutting by special permit only.<br>C. No cutting or dead wood.<br>D. No blasting after 10:00 a.m.<br>E. No operations after 1:00 p.m. except:<br>a. Loading decked logs<br>b. Log hauling<br>c. Road maintenance<br>d. Dirt moving<br>e. Slash chipping on cleared areas<br>f. Culvert installation |  | <b>4</b>   |
| No operations except:<br>A. Watering and oiling roads.<br>B. Servicing equipment at landings and cleared areas.<br>C. Trucks already at landings may be loaded and leave.   |  | <b>5</b>   |
