Volunteers spread word on tax credits

Cutting the pinch: The complicated process of finding loopholes can be well worth the effort

In 2003, more than a third of Utahns who were eligible to take an Earned Income Tax Credit (EITA) instead left the money in the federal treasury, the highest percentage of nonclaimants in the nation.

This year, several groups hope to shrink that number with the Volunteer Income Tax Assistance Program, or VITA, which offers help to low- and moderate-income wage earners with household incomes of less than \$37,000. Utahns lost about \$81 million by not taking the EITC for tax year 2002, the most recent year figures are available.

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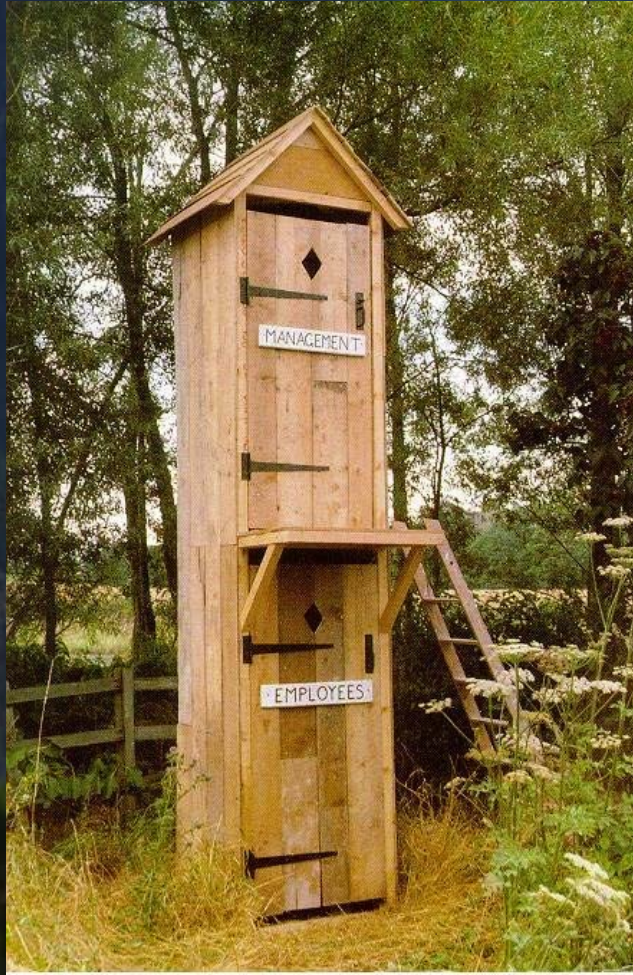

2005 Volunteer Income Tax Assistance (VITA)

The VITA program assists individuals or families whose income is approximately below \$37,000 a year to e-file their simple tax returns. A goal of VITA is to assure those applicable claim the Earned Income Tax Credit (EITC) which can bring them up to \$4,400. The 211 Info Bank is setting up appointments or providing information on walk-in VITA sites.

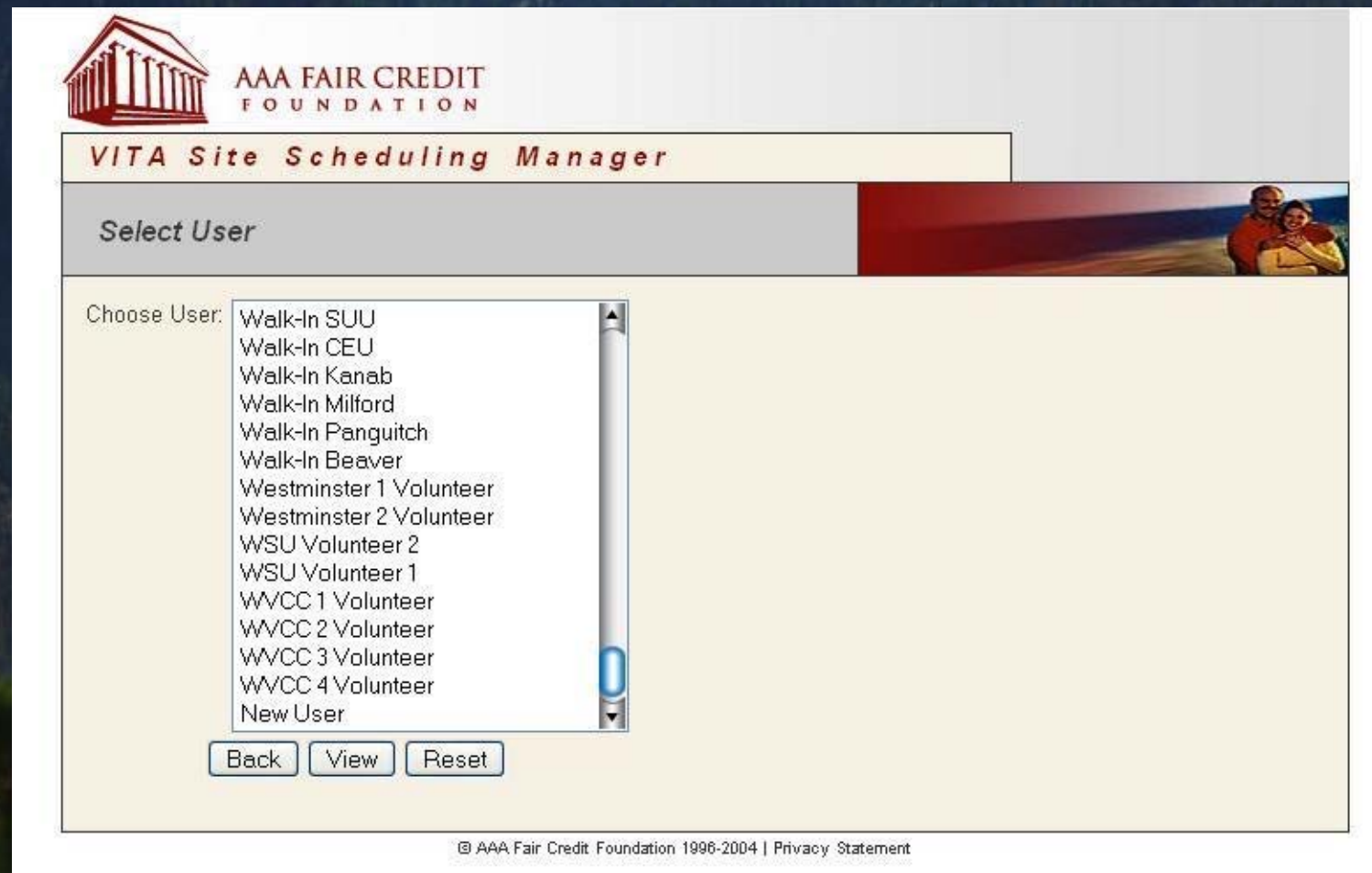

 - Domestic Violence Shelters
 - Deaf and Blind Centers
 - Homeless Resource Centers & Shelters
 - Remote areas of the community
- Schedule early, schedule late
 - Most people want refund ASAP
 - Procrastinators wait until the last minute

Economic Development And Sustainability

- Municipalities receive 1/3 or more of their revenue from sales taxes
- VITA patrons spend locally
- Unrealized Tax Revenue
- Many unaware of EIC
- Savings from filing fees kept local
- VITA = Sustainability
