Chair Imanaka reported that project statistics collected for the consultants' review time for the period July 1 through September 30, 2002 were provided for the committee's information. The average review is approximately 10 to 17 days. Chair Imanaka commended the consultants for doing an excellent job and providing excellent service to the community.

County of Hawaii

Commissioner Yamanaka reported that the meeting packet included a copy of a letter from the Hawaii Island Board of Realtors to the Hawaii County Planning Department expressing its concerns on condo projects in ag districts. The information was provided to keep the committee abreast of the concerns growing on the Big Island.

Chair Imanaka reported that the Commission is in receipt of a copy of the ordinance from the Hawaii County which was file stamped and signed by the Mayor on September 25, 2002. The ordinance is essentially regulating condos like subdivisions.

CPR Workshops and Meetings – Report

A written report on the September 10, 2002 Condominium Consultant's workshop was distributed for informational purposes. Chair Imanaka noted that it was a very productive session thanked the consultants for volunteering their time to attend the workshop.

The committee acknowledged receipt of the "Report from the Condominium Consultant Workshop of September 10, 2002" and recommended that the CRC commit the recommendations for further study and review.

Program of Work: Recodification of Chapter 514A

Recodification Attorney Arakaki reported that the Blue Ribbon Recodification Advisory Committee will be meeting twice a week for half-day sessions to complete its current work product by the end of the month.
