## Owner-Occupant No Action Request - Tricia Malanka

Upon a motion by Commissioner Abrams, seconded by Commissioner Ohama, it was voted on and unanimously carried that based on Tricia Malanka's letter of January 13, 2005 including the attachment of a letter from the State of California, Office of the Adjunct General dated 15 September 2004 ordering Mark G. Malanka to active duty as a member of his Reserve Component reporting to Fort Lewis , WA 98433 for deployment ISO Opn Enduring Freedom not to exceed 545 days from October 10, 2004; recommend approval to issue an informal non-binding opinion that the circumstances described by Tricia Malanka in her letter appears to fall within §514A-107(b)(2), "Unforeseeable job or military transfer," and further recommend approval to issue a no action letter.

# Program of Work: Recodification of Chapter 514A

Chair Imanaka acknowledged and noted his appreciation for the support of the Hawaii Chapter of the Community Associations Institute in the Commission's recodification efforts. CAI Hawaii issued out a "Recodification Alert: Your Help is Needed" flyer to its membership.

Chair Imanaka acknowledged receipt of the Federal Trade Commission's letter declining to analyze Section -149, Act 164, SLH 2004 in regard to its legality under federal law as requested by the Commission.

Chair Imanaka informed the committee that the recodification bill, House Bill 781 has been heard and has moved out of committee. The companion bill, SB 1132 will be heard on Friday, February 11 at 9 a.m. Chair Imanaka further thanked Commissioner Okawa for representing the Commission and presenting its testimony on House Bill 781.
