OECA promotes compliance and enforces U.S. environmental laws while inspiring the regulated community to pursue pollution prevention and environmental stewardship. Biologists are utilized in the Office of Site Remediation Enforcement (OSRE), the Office of Compliance and the Office of Regulatory Enforcement (ORE). Biologists develop and interpret data for risk assessment and safety evaluation of chemicals, including actual or potential environmental aspects of ecotoxicology and biology. They identify, predict and assess the effects of toxic factors in the physical environment. They advise and assist in the development, execution, and monitoring of environmental protection plans and programs.
