OECA promotes compliance and enforces U.S. environmental laws while inspiring the regulated community to pursue pollution prevention and environmental stewardship. Chemists are utilized in the Office of Compliance. Chemists identify, predict, and assess the effects of toxic factors in the physical environment. They evaluate toxic hazards from the use of pesticides, herbicides, fungicides, rodenticides and other toxic chemicals. They give advice on and perform work to protect and improve environmental quality, and assure compliance with environmental laws and regulations. They advise and assist in the development, execution, and monitoring of environmental protection plans and programs.
