(The Mid-level positions available at the EPA's Office of Enforcement and Compliance Assurance (OECA) provide full-time employment.)

OECA promotes compliance and enforces U.S. environmental laws while inspiring the regulated community to pursue pollution prevention and environmental stewardship. Environmental Protection Specialists are utilized in all of OECA's offices. An Environmental Protection Specialist generally resolves problems of major significance to EPA programs. They evaluate the effectiveness of major environmental programs, analyze and recommend program changes, develop significant improvements in guidelines, policies, procedures and techniques. They also advise and assist in the development, execution and monitoring of environmental protection plans.
