Geologists are utilized in the Office of Site Remediation Enforcement (OSRE), the Office of Regulatory Enforcement (ORE) and the Office of Compliance (OC). Geologists review, manage, and perform professional work in geology in connection with environmental planning, standards setting and compliance/enforcement functions. Geologists investigate, analyze, and review measurement techniques of physical phenomena and characteristics to protect or improve air, land and water resources to provide a clean and healthful environment.
