OECA promotes compliance and enforces U.S. environmental laws while inspiring the regulated community to pursue pollution prevention and environmental stewardship. Information Technology Specialists are utilized in all of OECA's offices for web development and minor data responsibilities. The Office of Compliance (OC) runs legacy data systems and modernizes systems as resources allow. An Information Technology Specialist determines data validation requirements, relationship, and input layouts derived from reviewing regulatory proposals and users' request for change. In addition, they study and evaluate new software products and programming techniques to improve the efficiency of use for the configuations management process for both software and technical documentation.
