TOXICOLOGIST

(The Mid-level positions available at the EPA's Office of Enforcement and Compliance Assurance (OECA) provide full-time employment.)

OECA promotes compliance and enforces U.S. environmental laws while inspiring the regulated community to pursue pollution prevention and environmental stewardship. Toxicologists are utilized in the Office of Site Remediation Enforcement (OSRE), the Office of Regulatory Enforcement (ORE) and the Office of Compliance. Toxicologists are concerned with the development and interpretation of required data for risk assessment and safety evaluation of chemicals, including actual or potential environmental aspects of toxicology. They identify, predict and assess the effects of toxic factors in the physical environment. They evaluate toxic hazards from the use of pesticides, herbicides, fungicides, rodenticides and other toxic chemicals.
