

FARM COMPUTER USAGE AND OWNERSHIP

In 2003, 72 percent of New England farms had computer access compared with 72 percent in 2001, 57 percent in 1999, and 35 percent in 1997. Nationally, 58 percent of farms had computer access compared with 55 percent in 2001, 47 percent in 1999, and 38 percent in 1997. Fifty-nine percent of New England farms had Internet access in 2003, up three percentage points from two years ago and up 48 percentage

points from 1997, the first year the survey was conducted. In New England, 61 percent of farms owned or leased computers in 2003, compared with only 31 percent in 1997. Forty percent of New England farms were using computers for farm business in 2003, compared to 30 percent nationwide.
