National Blood Reserve, Proof of Concept using the Armed Services Whole Blood Processing Laboratory

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Proof of concept:

- The exercise tasking for the ASWBPL and DoD will be to provide coordinated blood product shipments to the New York City area.
 - Communication route is via HHS and ASBPO to the ASWBPL. For the exercise, ASBPO will info NORTHCOM and ASD(HA). [Request for Assistance (RSA) would normally be from HHS for SEC DEF approval]
 - -Two shipments of 25 units of RBCs for two different locations.
 - Financial re-imbursement to DoD will be through the National Blood Exchange.



Proof of concept:

• Brings visibility of using a DoD facility (ASWBPL) for a surge in blood product needs in a domestic disaster. DoD blood program policy for domestic interagency relationships not yet drafted.

• Test logistics between the DoD and civilian blood centers during a crisis with heightened security.

Capability

- Central receiving point for DoD
- Store blood products
- ASWBPL East
 - 12,000 RBC units
 - 31,000 FFP, CRYO, Frozen Red Blood Cells
- ASWBPL West
 - 8,000 RBC units
 - 7,000 FFP, CRYO, Frozen Red Blood Cells
- Re-ice blood
- Ship up to 7,200 RBC units per day
