National Special Security Events (NSSE)

NSSE Procedure

- 1) Threat Profile of Event
- 2) Identify Major Suppliers in Event Area
- 3) Identify Major Trauma Hospitals in Event Area
- 4) Discuss Current and Projected Blood Supplies
- 5) Identify Potential Transportation Issues
- 6) Identify Potential Media Issues
- 7) Exchange of Emergency Point-of Contact Information
- 8) Final Report (prior to the Event)
- After-Action Review



National Response Plan

Blood and Blood Products: HHS monitors blood availability and maintains contact with the American Association of Blood Banks Inter-organizational Task Force on Domestic Disasters and Acts of Terrorism and, as necessary, its individual members, to determine:

- (a) The need for blood, blood products, and the supplies used in their manufacture, testing, and storage;
- (b) The ability of existing supply chain resources to meet these needs; and
- (c) Any emergency measures needed to augment or replenish existing supplies.


National Blood Reserve
