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1.0 POLICY

It is the goal of the CRC to identify and reduce the risks of acquiring and transmitting infections among human research subjects, CRC staff and all others who may come in contact with them.

2.0 APPLICABLE POLICIES AND GUIDELINES

2.1 To accomplish this policy, the BNL Medical Department has established guidelines, policies and procedures to address surveillance, prevention and control of infections and/or infectious diseases.

2.2 All members of the CRC staff, while participating in clinical studies with the CRC, shall comply with the Medical Department guidelines and policies associated with infection control. Such documents are included in the Department's Infection Control Manual.

2.3 Any deviation by a clinical program from the Department's approved procedures regarding Infection Control must be submitted in writing to the Medical Department Chairperson and approved by the Medical Department Chairperson prior to undertaking the alternative procedure.
