USS Recruit

Nobody ever got seasick on this US Navy ship. The *USS Recruit* (TDE-1) is the only Navy ship to be commissioned but never to be afloat. Dubbed the USS Neversail, this two-thirds scale replica of a destroyer escort was firmly

planted in concrete
on the grounds of
the Naval Training
Center (NTC) in San
Diego, California.
Used to train hundreds of thousands
of sailors on shipboard operations,
the ship also included classroom space.
