1/ The "Present Serviceability Rating" (PSR) is a subjective, primarily ride-based rating system adapted from the "AASHO ROAD TESTS" conducted in the late 1950's and early 1960's. Reference: Highway Research Board Special Report 61E, 1962. The PSR values range from 0.1 to 5.0; higher PSR values represent smoother riding roadways. Some differences from other tables may be noted because these are

estimated from sample data.

2/ Some States elect to report IRI for these systems. May include samples entirely on structures.
