# 14 FAH-4 H-600 DEFENSE COURIER SERVICE (DCS)

## 14 FAH-4 H-610 DEFENSE COURIER SERVICE (DCS)

(CT:DPM-1; 06-28-2007) (Office of origin: A/LM/PMP/DPM)

### **14 FAH-4 H-611 RECIPROCAL USE**

(CT:DPM-1; 06-28-2007)

The Department and the Department of Defense have concluded an agreement for the reciprocal use of their courier facilities. This means that the Department and posts with access to a DCS station (DCSSTA) can dispatch and receive [C] pouched and nonpouched items by DCS.

### **14 FAH-4 H-612 DCS ACCOUNT CODES**

(CT:DPM-1; 06-28-2007)

a. DCS uses a two line code to route and track items in the DCS system. When the item is pouched, the pouch tag must be altered to conform to the requirements of the DCS system. The code takes the following format:

> 406137-BRO5 AE BRUSSELS

The first six numbers on the top line are the DCS account numbers. The two letter designator indicate the DCSSTA route number on which the material will be delivered. If the number is 00 it indicates that he account picks up its material from the DCSSTA. The second line is the name of the account holder.

## 14 FAH-4 H-613 "ATTENTION" LINE

(CT:DPM-1; 06-28-2007)

Unpouched items dispatched via DCS must have an "ATTENTION:" line below and to the left of the two line account code and indicate the officer or the agency to which the item is to be delivered.

NOTE: Do not place this information on pouch tags.

## **14 FAH-4 H-614 POUCH TAG PREPARATION**

(CT:DPM-1; 06-28-2007)

- Posts preparing pouches for dispatch that will travel all or part of the way in the DCS system must meet both diplomatic and DCS requirements for tagging. In many instances, this will require double or triple tagging. Routing determines how many tags are required and in what order they must be attached to the pouch.
- b. If a post with a DCS account is dispatching to a post with a DCS account and the pouch will remain in the DCS system the entire journey, prepare only one pouch tag as listed below.
  - (1) UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, DEPARTMENT OF STATE, DIPLOMATIC POUCH must appear on the back of the tag.
  - (2) The channel of dispatch letter code must be in bold lettering in the lower right corner on the front of the tag. Only [C] pouches may be dispatched in the Defense Courier Service.
  - (3) The unique pouch number must be on the front of the tag.
  - (4) The gross weight must appear under the unique pouch number.
  - (5) Dispatch information must be in the upper left corner of the tag. Only the two line DCS account code of the post or the Department may be used as dispatch post. No employee or organization names may appear in the dispatch post information. The general post information format is:

DCS Account Number-DCS Route Number DCS Post Title Abbreviation Post Location

(6) Destination information must appear in the center of the tag. Only the two line DCS account code of the post or the Department may

be used as destination information. The general destination format is:

DCS Account Number-DCS Route Number DCS Post Title Abbreviation Post Location

(7) The caption, "VIA DEFENSE COURIER SERVICE" or "VIA DCS" must appear in the upper right corner of the tag.

#### 14 FAH-4 H-614.1 POST WITHOUT DCS ACCOUNT TO POST WITH DCS ACCOUNT

(CT:DPM-1; 06-28-2007)

When the pouch is traveling in the DCS system for the latter part of its journey, posts without a DCS account dispatching to a post with a DCS account must prepare tags as below:

- (1) Prepare a DCS tag as above except; the dispatch post information is the DCS account code of the post where the pouch will enter the DCS system.
- (2) Staple a normal diplomatic pouch tag over the DCS tag.
- (3) The dispatch post on the diplomatic tag is the post at which the pouch will enter the DCS system.
- (4) The post or courier who transfers the pouch to DCS will remove the top tag and prepare the DCS Form-1.

NOTE: If a post with a DCS account code is dispatching to a post without a DCS account code and the pouch will begin its journey in the DCS system, pouch tags, dispatch post, and destination post information must be reversed.

#### 14 FAH-4 H-614.2 POST WITHOUT DCS ACCOUNT TO POST WITHOUT DCS ACCOUNT

(CT:DPM-1; 06-28-2007)

When the pouch will travel the middle portion of its journey in the DCS system, posts without a DCS account dispatching to a post without a DCS account must prepare three pouch tags as outlined below:

(1) Prepare a normal diplomatic pouch tag from post of origin to post of

destination.

- (2) Prepare a DCS tag as outlined in 14 FAH-4 H-614, except the dispatch post DCS account code is the post where the pouch will enter the DCS system and the destination post is the DCS account code of the post where the pouch exit the DCS system. Staple it over the diplomatic tag.
- (3) Staple a regular diplomatic pouch tag over the DCS tag.
- (4) The post or courier who transfers the pouch to DCS will remove the top tag and prepare the DCS Form-1.
- (5) The post or courier who receives the pouch from DCS will remove the DCS tag and sign the DCS Form-4.

So that all posts are kept current on DCS account codes; posts who are holders of these codes must notify the Department by telegram of any changes in the account number, new account, or canceled account.

## **14 FAH-4 H-615 AUTHORIZED MATERIAL**

(CT:DPM-1; 06-28-2007)

- a. Only [AX] and [C] pouches are eligible for dispatch by DCS courier.
- b. Posts with DCS account codes may dispatch unpouched items to another post or any other holder of a DCS account. Only TOP SECRET items may be dispatched.
- c. DCS personnel are identified by the DCS Form-9 ID card.
