

Migratory Bird Conservation Commission



The Migratory Bird Conservation Commission

Section 2 of the Migratory Bird Conservation Act of February 18, 1929 (Act), established the Migratory Bird Conservation Commission.

Section 2, as amended. A Commission to be known as the Migratory Bird Conservation Commission, consisting of the Secretary of the Interior, as Chairman; the Administrator of the Environmental Protection Agency; the Secretary of Agriculture; two Members of the Senate, to be selected by the President of the Senate; and two Members of the House of Representatives, to be selected by the Speaker, is created and authorized to consider and pass upon any area of land, water, or land and water that may be recommended by the Secretary of the Interior for purchase or rental under this Act, and to fix the price or prices at which such area may be purchased or rented; and no purchase or rental shall be made of any such area until it has been duly approved for purchase or rental by said Commission. Any Member of the House of Representatives, who is a member of the Commission, if reelected to the succeeding Congress, may serve

on the Commission notwithstanding the expiration of a Congress. Any vacancy on the Commission shall be filled in the same manner as the original appointment. The ranking officer of the branch or department of a State to which is committed the administration of its game laws, or his authorized representative, shall be a member ex officio of said Commission for the purpose of considering and voting on all questions relating to the acquisition, under said sections, of areas in his State. For purposes of said sections, the purchase or rental of any area of land, water, or land and water includes the purchase or rental of any interest in any such area of land, water, or land and water.

In 1989, the Commission acquired the additional responsibility of approving project funding under the North American Wetlands Conservation Act. This Act provides Federal funding to encourage partnerships to protect, enhance, restore, and manage wetlands and other habitats for migratory birds and other fish and wildlife. The North American Wetlands Conservation Council, which was created by

this legislation, submits project recommendations to the Commission for funding approval.

Small Wetlands Program

50th Anniversary

August 2008 will mark the 50th anniversary of the Fish and Wildlife Service's Small Wetlands Program, created to stem the rapid loss of important small wetlands and grassland habitat across the United States' Prairie Pothole Region. In its half-century of existence, the Small Wetlands Program has developed into one of the most successful landscape-level conservation efforts in the United States, complementing the success of the Federal Duck Stamp Program.

The Small Wetlands Program began in 1958 as an amendment to the Migratory Bird Hunting Stamp Act of 1934 (also known as the Duck Stamp Act). It authorized the Service to use Duck Stamp funds to acquire Waterfowl Production Areas, small wetland and pothole areas and interests, for the benefit of migratory

waterfowl. Since the program's inception, with Migratory Bird Conservation Commission approval, the Service has permanently protected nearly three million acres of prairie habitat.

The wetlands and virgin grasslands in this glacially-created landscape are an invaluable natural resource. While the region accounts for just ten percent of North American waterfowl breeding habitat, it produces nearly half of the continent's total ducks. These lands also help connect people with nature by providing excellent opportunities for bird watching, hunting, photography, and environmental education.

This year the Service is celebrating the Small Wetlands Program by highlighting its successful past and the need to continue conserving this resource for

the future. In addition to providing information at events across the country, the Service has developed a Web site to help inform the public about prairie habitat conservation and to provide other communication materials to help tell this great conservation story.

What can you do? Buy a Federal Duck Stamp. And more importantly, tell people how important Federal Duck Stamps are to ensuring healthy populations of all migratory birds. The Migratory Bird Conservation Fund

The Migratory Bird Hunting Stamp Act of March 18, 1934 (Duck Stamp Act), created the Migratory Bird Conservation Fund (MBCF), to provide the Department of the Interior with monies to acquire migratory bird habitat. There are three major sources of funds deposited into the MBCF account. The most well-known source is the revenue received from the sale of Migratory Bird Hunting and Conservation Stamps, commonly known as Duck Stamps, as provided for under the Duck Stamp Act. The other two major sources include appropriations authorized by the Wetlands Loan Act of October 4, 1961, as amended, and import duties collected on arms and ammunition, as provided for under the Emergency Wetlands Resources Act of 1986.

The MBCF finances two Fish and Wildlife Service land acquisition programs which are administered by the Division of Realty. The first program purchases

major migratory bird conservation areas under the authority of the Migratory Bird Conservation Act of 1929, as amended. The second program purchases small natural wetlands, grasslands and interests, known as Waterfowl Production Areas, under the authority of the Duck Stamp Act, as amended. These are located primarily in the Prairie Pothole Region of the upper Midwest and the northern Great Plains.

In Fiscal Year 2007, \$44,096,057 was available for obligation from the MBCF. The Department of the Interior, through the Service, obligated a total of \$43,566,914. This includes \$15,791,007 for the acquisition of land and interests in land totaling 15,359 acres in major migratory bird conservation areas. It also includes \$16,564,812 for the acquisition of Waterfowl Production Areas totaling 32,063 acres.



MBCC Approvals for Fiscal Year 2007

In Fiscal Year 2007, the Migratory Bird Conservation Commission approved the 2,367-acre acquisition boundary at Assabet River National Wildlife Refuge in Middlesex County, Massachusetts. The refuge was created in 2000, when the Ft. Devens Army Base transferred ecologically important areas of the former Sudbury Training Annex to the Service, in accordance with the Defense Base Realignment and Closure Act, for the benefit of migratory birds.

Also, in Fiscal Year 2007, the Commission granted boundary addition approval for 49,871 acres at seven previously approved migratory bird areas, and price approval and price re-approval for 6,553 acres at ten previously approved areas.

National Wildlife Refuge System New Area Boundary Approval

Assabet River National Wildlife Refuge *Middlesex County, Massachusetts*

The Migratory Bird Conservation Commission approved the Assabet River National Wildlife Refuge on September 12, 2007. The refuge was established in 2000 when the Department of the Army transferred 2,229 acres to the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service (Service), in accordance with the Defense Base Realignment and Closure Act. The refuge was established for the purpose of having “particular value in carrying out the national migratory bird management program,” and is comprised of the most ecologically-important areas of the former Sudbury Training Annex at Ft. Devens Army Base. It is further surrounded by large blocks of the Sudbury State

Forest and municipal and privately-owned conservation land, and is managed as part of the Eastern Massachusetts Refuge Complex. The refuge includes a substantial wetland complex, and a large, contiguous block of mature forest, which were both protected by the military from significant human disturbance for more than fifty years. The refuge provides valuable habitat for migratory bird species including the American black duck, mallard, green-winged teal, wood duck, Canada goose, and a host of shorebirds, wading birds, raptors, and neotropical migrant songbirds.

On September 12, 2007, the Commission granted new area boundary approval to the existing 2,229-acre refuge and boundary addition approval for 138


acres, in two ownerships, consisting of wooded swamp and fresh water marsh along the main stem and backwaters of the Assabet River. In addition, the Commission granted price approval for the fee title acquisition of 72 acres, part of the 138-acre addition. The boundary addition and price approval tract directly connect the high quality riverine wetlands of the refuge to the Assabet River, and the Service is now better able to manage for waterfowl and other migratory birds.

The Commission granted new area boundary and addition approval for the 2,367-acre refuge, and price approval for the fee title acquisition of 72 acres, in one ownership, on September 12, 2007.

National Wildlife Refuge System Boundary Addition Approvals

Grasslands Wildlife Management Area *Merced County, California*

The Migratory Bird Conservation Commission approved the Grasslands Wildlife Management Area (Grasslands WMA), located in the San Joaquin Valley, on May 23, 1978, with a 48,000-acre acquisition boundary to protect and enhance a major wintering area for migratory waterfowl. The Commission approved the Grasslands WMA East Division boundary on March 27, 1990, to preserve an additional 36,550 acres of wetlands and associated upland habitat.

Grasslands WMA is the largest remaining continuous block of freshwater wetlands in all of California. This area is an

important wintering area for Pacific flyway waterfowl populations, providing habitat for 30 percent of the entire flyway. Numerous species of ducks including the northern pintail, green-winged teal, northern shoveler, and mallard winter here. Grasslands WMA also provides wintering habitat for Ross's goose, lesser snow goose, cackling Canada goose, Pacific greater white-fronted goose, and the lesser and greater sandhill crane.

On September 12, 2007, the Commission granted approval to expand the Grasslands WMA boundary by 46,850 acres to preserve the last remaining unprotected grassland and wetland habitat complex in the San Joaquin Valley. The Service plans to acquire


permanent conservation easements in the project area that will protect the valuable wetlands and grasslands. The Service also plans to work cooperatively with local farmers to promote wildlife-friendly agricultural practices such as managing specific crops that are beneficial to waterfowl, timing of harvests to produce the greatest benefit to waterfowl, using fallowed fields, taking advantage of non-farmed areas, and utilizing water as a management tool. In addition, the Commission granted price approval for the acquisition of a permanent easement covering 255 acres, that supports waterfowl and other migratory birds.

Lake Umbagog National Wildlife Refuge *Coos County, New Hampshire*

The Migratory Bird Conservation Commission approved the Lake Umbagog National Wildlife Refuge on March 21, 1995, to protect and manage a unique and diverse wetland complex for waterfowl and wetland-dependent wildlife species. The refuge includes diverse and extensive palustrine, lacustrine, and riverine wetland complexes recognized as some of the finest wildlife habitat in the States of New Hampshire and Maine. UMBAGOG (pronounced Um-BAY-gog) is a Native American word which translates to "clear water." The habitat and abundant wildlife found on and around the refuge are recognized as special and important — by Anasagunticook Native Americans, who hunted, trapped and traded around

the lake and its rivers, and to European settlers, who brought farming and logging to the area. The glacial geology, northern climate, and the meandering and seasonally flooding of the Magalloway and Androscoggin Rivers created a unique and richly diverse environment. Located on the northern part of the New Hampshire/Maine border, about one-third of the refuge includes wetland habitat in Maine. Both States are setting aside additional lands to complement the protection of the Lake Umbagog watershed, and both States have listed Lake Umbagog as a priority site for acquisition under the Atlantic Coast Joint Venture of the North American Waterfowl Management Plan.

Wildlife values include waterfowl production and migration habitat, with


a large amount of forested wetland of particular importance to the American black duck, whose populations are declining, and cavity nesters such as wood ducks, goldeneye, and hooded mergansers. Lake Umbagog is also considered the most productive breeding site for the common loon in New Hampshire, and is recognized as one of the most important breeding areas in the northeastern United States for its high nesting success.

The Commission granted boundary addition approval for a 727-acre tract, and price approval for the fee title acquisition of a portion of the tract on September 12, 2007. The Service plans to promote and enhance the habitat for the American black duck and other waterfowl and migratory birds.

Missisquoi National Wildlife Refuge

Franklin County, Vermont

The Migratory Bird Conservation Commission approved the Missisquoi National Wildlife Refuge on September 27, 1940, and the Service established it on February 4, 1943, with the purchase of 1,582 acres. The refuge is located in the northwestern part of Vermont, forty miles north of Burlington, on Lake Champlain. It includes most of the Missisquoi River delta where it enters Lake Champlain, and is composed mainly of woodland swamp, hayfields, brushy/shrubby early succession fields, and forests. The floodplain and marshes of the delta provide a major resting and feeding area for several waterfowl species.

The Commission granted boundary addition and price approval for a 156-acre tract located adjacent to the refuge.

The area is part of a productive and valuable wetland and grassland complex providing migration and nesting habitat for waterfowl, wading birds, neotropical migratory birds, and other wetland- and grassland-dependent species. The tract provides habitat for the wood duck, mallard, American black duck, ring-necked duck, common goldeneye, hooded merganser, American bittern, great blue heron, and grassland nesting species in decline such as bobolink, Savannah sparrow, and eastern meadowlark. It joins the refuge to Vermont's 80-acre Wildlife Management Area which then connects to Lake Champlain.

For several generations, the tract was used and managed as hay land and pastureland as part of a productive dairy farm. These uses complemented the management of the adjoining refuge lands, and protected the land from

development.

The Service plans to manage the tract to preserve and enhance the habitat for waterfowl, marsh and wading birds, and grassland nesting neotropical migratory birds in decline in the Northeast.


Retention of normal spring floodwaters and maintenance of the late season, single-cutting hay land will be done to create ideal habitat conditions for many important migratory species in the Lake Champlain portion of the Atlantic Flyway. In addition to providing valuable habitat, this tract is across the road from the newly-constructed refuge headquarters and visitor station.

The Commission granted boundary addition and price approval for the fee title acquisition of a 156-acre tract, consisting of wetland and grassland habitat, on June 13, 2007.

Rappahannock River Valley National Wildlife Refuge Richmond County, Virginia

The Migratory Bird Conservation Commission approved the Rappahannock River Valley National Wildlife Refuge on March 14, 2001. The refuge was established in 1996 to assist in meeting waterfowl population, species, and wetland goals of the North American Waterfowl Management Plan, the Service's Chesapeake Bay/Susquehanna River Watershed Program, and other national and regional resource priorities. Rappahannock River and its adjacent marshes and waters are one of the Chesapeake Bay's most important and productive estuarine assets, supporting a wide diversity of sub-aquatic and emergent wetland plant communities. These lands and waters, in turn, provide optimum habitat for large concentrations of waterfowl and other migratory birds. As the fourth largest river system entering the Chesapeake Bay, the Rappahannock River provides essential habitat for a great diversity of migratory birds, and for endangered and

threatened wildlife and plant species. The Rappahannock River has long been recognized as one of the most important waterfowl migration and wintering areas in Virginia. The marshes along the river and its tributaries have been identified as important American black duck habitat in the Service's Category Plan for the Preservation of American black duck wintering habitat on the Atlantic Coast. Emergent wetland plant communities include important wildlife food plants such as wild rice, wild millet, bulrush, sedge, and arrowhead. The river also supports populations of mallards, ruddy ducks, ring-necked ducks, canvasbacks, Canada geese, and tundra swans.

The Commission granted boundary addition and price approval for a 174-acre tract that fronts on Cat Point Creek, a tributary of the Rappahannock River. Conservation entities ranging from international to local, including the following: U.S. Ramsar Committee, U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service, Environmental Protection Agency, The Nature Conservancy, Virginia Department of Game and Inland Fisheries, Tidewater

Resource Conservation and Development Council, and Cat Point Creek Citizen Advisory Committee have recognized the marshes and adjoining uplands of Cat Point Creek for their importance to fish and wildlife. The wetlands and adjoining uplands of Cat Point Creek are among the highest priorities for conservation listed in the refuge's Land Protection Plan.

High priority waterfowl species observed using the creek include the mallard, American black duck, blue-winged teal, wood duck, and Canada goose. Refuge surveys have found several marsh birds of conservation concern including the American and least bittern, marsh wren, sora rail, king and Virginia rail, and common moorhen.

The Commission granted boundary addition and price approval for the fee title acquisition of a 174-acre tract on September 12, 2007.



Red Rock Lakes National Wildlife Refuge *Beaverhead County, Montana*

The Migratory Bird Conservation Commission approved the Red Rocks Lake National Wildlife Refuge on August 20, 1963. President Franklin D. Roosevelt signed Executive Order 7023 on April 22, 1935, to establish "Red Rock Lakes Migratory Waterfowl Refuge ... as a Refuge and breeding ground for wild birds and animals." On September 4, 1935, Executive Order 7172 expanded the refuge by 37,000 acres.

Located in the Centennial Valley of southwestern Montana, approximately 60 air miles southeast of Dillon, the refuge encompasses the largest wetland complex in the Greater Yellowstone ecosystem, and provides some of the best waterfowl breeding habitat in the Intermountain West. The Lower Red Rock Lakes portion of the refuge supports one of the highest densities of breeding lesser scaup in North America, exceeded only by breeding areas in portions of Alaska

and the Yukon. In addition, the refuge and surrounding Centennial Valley supports the highest density of breeding trumpeter swans in the tri-state flock (Idaho, Montana, and Wyoming) of the Rocky Mountain population. Other waterfowl species found on the refuge include mallard, gadwall, cinnamon teal, blue-winged teal, redhead, canvasback, lesser scaup, bufflehead, ruddy duck, and northern shoveler.

The Commission granted price approval for a contiguous parcel, the largest refuge inholding, consisting of 7,050 acres (3,784 acres in fee and 3,266 acres of State lease lands). The parcel provides important breeding habitat for 21 species of waterfowl and 35 species of other wetland-dependent birds in southwest Montana. In addition, the tract includes several important water rights which will ensure future water supplies for the existing Red Rock Lakes wetland complex. The tract will also provide the public with additional opportunities for wildlife-dependent recreation.

The project was a cooperative effort between the Service and The Nature Conservancy (TNC), which purchased the entire Murphy Creek Ranch in November 2006. The previous owner, Centennial Livestock, Inc., had used the property for summer livestock grazing since the early 1900's. The Service had negotiated with Centennial Livestock, Inc. for nearly 20 years but was unable to reach agreement because over 2,000 acres of the ranch were located outside the refuge boundary. TNC retained these lands and agreed to sell the 7,050 acres (3,784 fee acres and 3,266 acres of State lease lands) to the Service, all of which, except 320 acres, lie within the Commission-approved refuge boundary.

The Commission granted boundary addition approval for 320 acres and granted price approval for the fee title acquisition of 3,784 acres and a 10-year State lease of 3,266 acres on March 14, 2007.



San Bernard National Wildlife Refuge *Brazoria County, Texas*

The Migratory Bird Conservation Commission approved the San Bernard National Wildlife Refuge on February 27, 1968. The Service approved the Austin's Woods Conservation Plan in 1997, which authorized the acquisition of up to 28,000 acres of satellite units to San Bernard NWR.

The Autin's Woods Unit is part of a productive and valuable wetland complex


providing wintering, migration, and resident habitat for waterfowl, wading birds, neotropical migratory birds, and other wetland-dependent wildlife species. Thousands of waterfowl winter in the area, including mottled ducks, mallards, pintails, gadwalls, widgeons, northern shovelers, blue- and green-winged teal, black-bellied whistling ducks, and ruddy ducks. The Commision approved the fee title acquisition of a 46-acre tract located within the Mid-Coast Initiative of the Gulf Coast Joint Venture of the North American Waterfowl Management Plan.

The Service will manage the tract as part of the Austin's Woods Unit of the refuge, and will preserve and enhance the habitat for waterfowl, wading birds, neotropical migrants, and other wildlife.

The Commission granted boundary and price approval for the fee title acquisition of the 46-acre tract, consisting of wetland habitat, on March 14, 2007.


**San Bernard National Wildlife Refuge - Austin's Woods Units**

Trinity River National Wildlife Refuge *Liberty County, Texas*

The Migratory Bird Conservation Commission approved the Trinity River National Wildlife Refuge on June 14, 1994. The refuge was established on January 3, 1994, when the Service acquired 4,400 acres of bottomland hardwood and associated habitats in Liberty County, using Land and Water Conservation Fund dollars. On March 4, 1999, the Service approved the Lower Trinity River Floodplain Habitat Stewardship Program, and expanded the refuge boundary to 79,600 acres.

The refuge protects important remnant bottomland hardwood and associated habitats for migrating, wintering, and breeding waterfowl and breeding colonial waterbirds. It has been identified as a priority project for the East Texas

Bottomland Hardwood Initiative, a component of the Lower Mississippi Valley Joint Venture and the North American Waterfowl Management Plan. The waterfowl species that most benefit are wood duck, mallard, gadwall, American widgeon, green- and blue-winged teal, and mottled duck.

The Commission approved the fee title acquisition of a tract that lies within the 100-year floodplain of the Trinity River and contains key, old bottomland hardwoods. The property had been under the ownership of a development company who was developing adjacent areas. To assist in protection of this very valuable area, The Conservation Fund purchased the property in an attempt to make it part of the refuge. The property had been used for recreation and timber harvest for many years and was in danger of a subdivision development.


The Service plans to develop and manage most of the proposed tract for compatible wildlife-dependent recreational activities such as hunting, wildlife observation, and environmental education. Also, by acquiring this tract, the Service will come closer to meeting the established habitat protection goals for the East Texas Bottomland Hardwood Initiative and the Lower Mississippi Valley Joint Venture and will protect important waterfowl habitat in the Trinity River floodplain.

The Commission granted boundary addition and price approval for the fee title acquisition of 1,598 acres on September 12, 2007.

Notes on Tables One and Two

The information contained in this report includes those acquisitions and dispositions of land and interests therein that are purchased with Migratory Bird Conservation Fund monies or acquired under the authority of the Migratory Bird Conservation Act. It also includes other migratory bird areas such as those that are transferred to the Fish and Wildlife Service under the authority of Public Law 80-537 to carry out a migratory bird management program.

In an ongoing effort to improve data quality, the figures in Tables One and Two may show minor changes from previous annual reports. Lands in which the Service previously acquired a less-than-fee interest (leases and easements) may be purchased in fee during the year, and the number of easement or lease acres

will show a decrease and the number of purchased acres will show an increase. The acreage appearing in the Approvals and Summary of Land Acquisitions sections of this report will not appear in Tables One or Two until after the tracts are acquired and the funds are actually expended. Also, a newly approved refuge will not appear on Table One until the tracts are acquired.



North American Wetlands Conservation Fund MBCC Approvals for Fiscal Year 2007 (Summary)

The Migratory Bird Conservation Commission approved 72 wetland conservation project proposals for funding in Fiscal Year 2007 under the North American Wetlands Conservation Act. A total of \$69,559,868 from the North American Wetlands Conservation Fund (Fund), together with \$240,723,812 in partner funds, are supporting 47 projects in the United States, 12 in Canada, and 13 in Mexico. The following tables provide summary and detailed allocation information.
