1. In accordance with reference (a), reference (b) is approved and the initiation of the Shore Based Response Boat (SBRB) System Capability Replacement Project as a Major Acquisition is authorized.
2. The Assistant Commandant for Operations is designated as the Project Sponsor and is responsible for:
  - a. submitting a Mission Need Statement (MNS) and the MNS updates for Coast Guard Acquisition Review Council (CGARC) and the Administration Acquisition Executive (AAE) approval;
  - b. submitting a Preliminary Operational Requirements Document (PORD) via the Project Manager to Commandant (G-A) for acceptance;
  - c. submitting an Operational Requirements Document (ORD) for CGARC review and Chief of Staff approval;
  - d. submitting an Operational Test and Evaluation (OT&E) Report for CGARC review and approving the OT&E Report;
  - e. participating as the CGARC member for the SBRB Project; and
  - f. directing the Chief, Office of Shore Activities (G-OCS), to serve as the Sponsor's Representative in support of the SBRB Project in accordance with reference (a).

3. Following approval of the MNS, the Assistant Commandant for Acquisition (G-A) is directed to establish a project office upon receiving the staffing resources from the Director of Resources Directorate (G-CRC).
