This microfilm publication reproduces copies of U.S. Customs Service passenger lists filed by masters of vessels entering the port of San Francisco between January 2, 1903 and April 1, 1918. The records were used by the Immigration and Naturalization Service to supplement the lists filed with immigration officials in the same port.

The records are arranged chronologically by date of arrival. The lists were originally bound in volumes and are micro-filmed as they appeared in the volumes. At the beginning of each of the volumes is a typed list of vessels.
