1998 California Walnut Acreage Report



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RESULTS

California's 1998 walnut acreage is estimated by the California Agricultural Statistics Service at 221,000 acres, of which 193,000 was bearing and 28,000 was non-bearing.

This estimate is based on a statistical sample initiated to provide an unbiased indication of State acreage and to measure the incompleteness in the walnut data base maintained by this office. It is not comparable with past walnut acreage surveys.

Past acreage survey results were the sum of grower acreage reported to this office without adjustment for any incompleteness. Incompleteness is bound to exist with (1) a universe of approximately 6,200 walnut growers, and (2) data dependent upon voluntary cooperation.

Pages 2-3 are comparable with previous years' survey data. Of the walnut acreage in our data base, the Hartley variety accounted for 26 percent of the total acreage, followed by Chandler with 23 percent. Survey results show an increase in Chandler variety plantings, which accounted for 10 percent of the non-bearing acreage. San Joaquin County shows the largest acreage planted at 15 percent of the total, followed by Tulare County with 13 percent, and Stanislaus County with 11 percent. Data users are cautioned that varietal data for the sample incompleteness may be substantially different from that above.

OBJECTIVES

This is a continuation of a long series of annual surveys to provide walnut acreage by variety and year planted. Again, data on pages 2-3 are comparable with previous years'. However, for the first time, a probability survey was designed to estimate total bearing and non-bearing walnut acreage.

PROCEDURES

For the information on pages 2-3, 5,651 walnut growers in the fruit data base maintained by CASS were mailed a questionnaire with previously reported crop, variety, and acreage information preprinted. Recipients were asked to update the information for removals and new plantings. Existing grower names were also compared with pesticide permit and application data maintained by County Agricultural Commissioners and the Department of Pesticide Regulation (DPR). Additional growers were mailed blank questionnaires and asked to provide the specified information.

Questionnaires were mailed on December 26, 1998. Respondents were given six weeks to respond by mail. CASS personnel then conducted a telephone follow-up. Field personnel personally visited large growers who did not respond by mail or telephone.

For the sample used to measure the incompleteness in the above activity, 226 growers were selected from the 1998 DPR application file. The sample was selected based on indicated size of operation; i.e., larger growers had a much greater chance of selection than those with small acreages. Growers were contacted in early May. The sample was expanded to the State level to give acreage incompleteness for bearing and non-bearing acreage.
