




Status of Coal Working Group






Accomplishments - Continued

Accomplishments – cont.

- **Economic Modeling Study of Coal Beneficiation Benefits**
 - Study characterizes the benefits of using washed coal in terms of improved power plant efficiencies, reduced emissions and maintenance costs, reduced rail transportation costs, etc.
 - Study can contribute to needed regulatory/policy changes
