Immigration records, also known as "ship passenger arrival records," can provide genealogical information including a person's nationality, place of birth, exact date and means (ship name, for example) of entry into the United States, profession, place of last residence, and more. 12/11 Finding Family: Using Naturalization Records

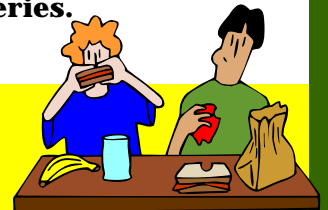
Naturalization is the process by which an immigrant becomes an American citizen. These records can provide genealogical information including a person's place and date of birth, occupation, the details of their legal entry into the U.S., information on their marital status and spouse and children, the names and addresses of witnesses, and more. Learn what resources are available to help you use naturalization records in your family research.
