- 3. Page 2. Lines 11 and 13: Insert a hyphen between the words "campaign related."
- Page 2. Line 14: Insert ending quotation marks at the end of the sentence.
- 5. Page 2, Line 15: Delete one space between the words "requirement" and "in."
- Page 2, Line 17: Insert an additional space before the word "Thus."

<u>Without objection</u>, it was agreed to make these amendments.
