1. At page 17, line 13: replace "is" with "shall be."

2. At page 12, line 15: insert the following sentence after "51,145.":

"However, a communication must be available to 50,000 or more persons in a particular Congressional district or State in order to be an 'electioneering communication,' and it is highly unlikely the communications the commenter addressed would be so widely disseminated."
